Redistricting Advisory Committee Meeting

Every ten years, local governments use new census data to redraw their district lines to reflect how local populations have changed. Cities and counties are required to engage communities in the redistricting process by holding public hearings and/or workshops and doing public outreach, including to non- English-speaking communities. Every ten years, districts must be redrawn so that each district is substantially equal in population. This process, called redistricting, is important in ensuring that each City Councilmember represents about the same number of constituents.

Buy Local Kick Off – Business Development Organizations Meeting

The Small Business Division leads the City's efforts to grow and develop small businesses. Local, Small, minority and women-owned businesses are vital to San Antonio's economic health, to general business expansion and to the community at large. Nevertheless, at certain stages of development, these businesses need the support of a knowledgeable team. The Business Development Organizations Meeting was programming for "Buy Local," an event promoting shopping at locally owned small businesses.

Collective Bargaining Agreement Meeting

Texas is a right-to-work state. However, in separate elections in 1974 San Antonio voters approved collective bargaining for the City's Firefighters and Police Officers. Since that time, the City and the associations for firefighters and police officers have entered into collective bargaining agreements for addressing pay, benefits, hours and other terms of employment. Strikes are prohibited by statute.
