

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE ANNUAL RACE FOR THE CURE IN THE LOW COUNTRY. IT HAPPENS ON OCTOBER 19TH AND THE LOCAL EVENT GROWS EVERY YEAR.

ALSO DISCUSSED WAS GENERAL LIFESTYLE CHOICES AND HOW THOSE CHOICES CAN LEAD TO GENERALLY BETTER HEALTH AND BETTER BREAST HEALTH. ITS ALL ABOUT FOOD CHOICES AND EXERCISE.

MITCHELL SAYS THE WORST THING WE CAN DO IS MINDLESS EATING. THAT IS....JUST CHOWING DOWN ON ANYTHING ANYTIME. SHE SAYS BAD FOOD CHOICES WILL TAKE THEIR TOLL ON US.

ONE SEGMENT WAS CALLED ' HOW TO PREVENT THE HUNGER GAMES'. IF DIETING....NO STARVATION. YOU WILL LOSE VERY LITTLE WEIGHT AND KEEP IT OFF. SHE SAYS THE AIM IS TO MAKE SENSIBLE CHOICES...NO STARVATION....AND YOU WILL NOT ONLY LOSE EXCESS POUNDS....BUT YOU WON'T DEAL WITH HUNGER GAMES. FADS WON'T GET YOU FAR....AND YOU WILL ONLY GAIN BACK THE WEIGHT. IT CAN'T GET ANY MORE FRUSTRATING.

FOOD CAN ALSO HELP YOU GET BETTER SLEEP. WE LOSE SLEEP THRU STRESS....HORMONAL CHANGES....AND BAD FOOD. STUDIES FIND SLEEP DEPRIVED ADULTS OFTEN CONSUME MORE CALORIES THAN IS NECESSARY. THE FEWER Zzzzzzz's...THE GREATER THE APPETITE. IT MAKES FOR EXTRA POUNDS.

RESULTING STRESS.

OR AT RISK STUDENTS CAN BE THOSE FROM AVERAGE
FAMILIES WITH AVERAGE INCOMES BUT WHO ARE GOING THRU
UNUSUAL TRAUMAS....SUCH AS THE DEATH OF A PARENT OR
PERSONAL TRAUMA.

COMMUNITIES IN SCHOOLS WORKS TO IDENTIFY THESE
STUDENTS ARE HELP THEM GET THRU THE SCHOOL
EXPERIENCE. THE EFFORT HAS ALWAYS WORKED TO PREVENT
STUDENTS FROM DROPPING OUT OF SCHOOL. IT'S BEEN A
HUGE PROBLEM IN SOUTH CAROLINA.

THE COMMUNITIES IN SCHOOLS EFFORT HAS BEEN KNOWN TO
HAVE A GOOD TRACK RECORD FOR HELPING STUDENTS
DISCOVER THE IMPORTANCE OF THEIR SCHOOL YEARS. THE
EFFORT WORKS TO KEEP STUDENTS FOCUSED ON THEIR
EDUCATION WHILE ALSO WORKING THRU THE SITUATIONS

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE....THE UPCOMING 15TH ANNUAL JAMES ISLAND CONNECTOR RUN....BENEFITING THIS WORTHWHILE FOUNDATION.

THE FOUNDATION WORKS TO FUND THE COLLEGE EDUCATIONS OF THOSE DESERVING STUDENTS WHO ALSO HAVE A PHYSICAL DISABILITY. THE FOUNDATION HAS BEEN ABLE TO SEND STUDENTS TO COLLEGE....WHO HAVE A VARIETY OF CHALLENGES....INCLUDING BLINDNESS....PHYSICAL DISABILITIES....AND MORE.

ALL SAY IT IS IMPORTANT FOR THESE STUDENTS TO GO TO COLLEGE....NOT ONLY FOR THE EDUCATION FOR TO LEARN HOW TO MOVE IN THE WORLD WITH SO MANY OTHERS. THE STUDENTS DO WELL IN THIS PROGRAM.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE WORK THIS HOME-GROWN
ORGANIZATION HAS BEEN DOING FOR MORE THAN 10 YEARS.
WATER MISSIONS SWINGS INTO ACTION WHEN THERE IS A
NATURAL DISASTER.....SHIPPING STAFF AND WATER
PURIFICATION DEVICES TO THOSE FAR FLUNG AREAS. THEIR
PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS SAY THIS FAITH-BASED
ORGANIZATION ALSO BRING WITH IT THE LIVING WATER
MESSAGE WHICH IS BIBLE BASED. BUT THAT ASPECT IS NEVER
FORCED.

WHITCROFT SAYS HE GOT INVOLVED WITH WATER MISSIONS
BY BEING A VOLUNTEER THAT ACTUALLY TRAVELED TO
AFRICA TO BRING A WATER PURIFICATION DEVICE TO THE
PEOPLE OF A SECLUDED VILLAGE.

THE PLAN IS ALWAYS TO SET UP AND LET THE PEOPLE RUN
THESE WATER PURIFICATION DEVICES. IT ENABLES THE
VILLAGES TO HAVE BETTER HEALTH AND FEWER
ILLNESSES....AND TO GENERALLY PROSPER. THE DEVICE ALSO
TEACHES MANAGEMENT SKILLS FOR THOSE PUT IN CHARGE OF
THE CLEAN-WATER-MAKER.

WHEN WATER MISSIONS ARRIVES IN A FOREIGN VILLAGE
RACKED BY SOME DISASTER....ONLY POSITIVE THINGS HAPPEN

ON THE JOB 24/7....THE AMERICAN RED CROSS OF THE LOW COUNTRY

GUEST: LISA QUICK....PUBLIC INFORMATION EXPERT WITH THE AMERICAN RED CROSS OF THE LOW COUNTRY

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE WORK THE AMERICAN RED CROSS DOES LOCALLY. THE JOB IS MORE THAN JUST ASKING FOR BLOOD DONATIONS....THOUGH THOSE BLOOD DRIVES ARE ALWAYS UNDERWAY IN THE LOW COUNTRY. BLOOD COLLECTION IS ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT JOBS THE RED CROSS DOES,

THE LOW COUNTRY AND SOUTH CAROLINA IN GENERAL EXPERIENCES FAR TOO MANY HOUSE FIRES. THEY HAPPEN ANY TIME OF DAY OR NIGHT. STILL THE AMERICAN RED CROSS SWINGS INTO ACTION TO HELP THOSE DISPLACED BY FLAMES. THE RED CROSS IS AT THE READY WITH VOUCHERS FOR TEMPORARY SHELTER....FOOD...AND NECESSITIES FOR A FAMILY VICTIMIZED BY FIRE.

THE AMERICAN RED CROSS IS ALSO READY TO HELP THE PUBLIC IN TIMES OF DISASTER....NATURAL OR OTHERWISE. IT OFFERS CLASSES FOR THOSE WHO ALSO WANT TO BE INVOLVED FOLLOWING A FIRE OR HURRICANE.

THE AMERICAN RED CROSS HAS BEEN ASKING FOR THE PUBLIC'S HELP LATELY. DONATIONS HELP THE RED CROSS HELP FAMILIES IN THE EVENT OF FIRE OR OTHER DISASTER. BLOOD AND MONEY....TWO THINGS THE RED CROSS PUTS TO GOOD USE.

GIVING THE BLIND A CLEARER PICTURE

GUESTS: MARY MORRISON...EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE ASSOCIATION FOR THE BLIND AND VISUALLY IMPAIRED OF CHARLESTON.....AND KIMBERLY TAYLOR....MANAGER OF THE 'LOOK FORWARD' CLIENT PROGRAM WITH THE ASSOCIATION

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE WORK THE ASSOCIATION DOES FOR THOSE WHO ARE LOSING THEIR VISION...HAVE LOW VISION OR ARE TOTALLY BLIND. THE ORGANIZATION HAS BEEN AROUND FOR DECADES AND HAS PROVEN TO BE A GREAT COMFORT....ESPECIALLY FOR THOSE WHO ARE IN THE PROCESS OF LOSING THEIR SENSE OF SIGHT.

MOST FEEL THAT OF THE 5 SENSES....LOSING SIGHT WOULD BE THE WORST. HOWEVER THE ASSOCIATION WORKS TO HELP THOSE GOING THRU VISION LOSS DEAL EFFECTIVELY WITH THAT CHANGE. IT HAS PROGRAMS THAT CAN ENABLE SOMEONE TO LEARN HOW TO ADJUST TO SUCH A DRASTIC CHANGE. IT CAN EVEN HELP ONE LEARN TO USE A COMPUTER OR AN i-PAD.

THE ASSOCIATION WORKS TO PROVIDE A SAFE AND SECURE PLACE FOR THE BLIND TO LEARN TO COPE WITH THEIR SIGHT LOSS.....AND IT ALSO WORKS TO EMPOWER THE SIGHT-IMPAIRED.

THE ASSOCIATION TEACHES THOSE WITH THIS CHALLENGE LIVE SAFE AND SELF-SUFFICIENT LIVES.

BIG BROTHERS AND BIG SISTERS OF THE LOW COUNTRY

AIR DATE: NOVEMBER 24, 2013

GUESTS: MANDY SCHERER....LOCAL BIG BROTHERS/BIG SISTERS PROGRAM DIRECTOR-CAROLINA YOUTH DEVELOPMENT CENTER AND LEWIS KINES...PROGRAM CO-ORDINATOR

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE LONG-RUNNING BIG BROTHERS AND BIG SISTERS PROGRAM AND ITS IMPORTANCE TO KIDS IN NEED.

BIG BROTHERS AND BIG SISTERS PROGRAM IS THE ORIGINAL MENTORING PROGRAM FOR KIDS WHO DON'T HAVE ENOUGH GOOD GUIDANCE AT HOME. IT IS ALSO LEGENDARY FOR KEEPING KIDS OCCUPIED WITH GOOD ACTIVITIES....SO THEY DO NOT GET PULLED OVER TO THE BAD SIDE.

THE PROBLEM IS THERE ARE NOT ENOUGH BIG BROTHERS AND BIG SISTERS FOR THE NUMBER OF YOUTH ASKING FOR THE HELP.

THE BIGS (as the adults are called) ARE OVERRUN BY THE NUMBER OF LITTLES (the kids in the program)...IN NEED AND WANT A BIG BROTHER OR SISTER.

THE ORGANIZATION ALSO NEEDS MONETARY DONATIONS....TO FUND ACTIVITIES FOR THE BIGS AND LITTLES. THE DEMAND IS HIGH...ESPECIALLY FOR YOUNG BOYS.

LEWIS KINES CAME ON WITH BIG BROS/BIG SISTERS AFTER BEING A 'BIG' FOR YEARS WHEN HE LIVED IN ATLANTA. HE RECENTLY MOVED TO THE LOW COUNTRY BUT HE HAS STILL KEPT UP THE RELATIONSHIP WITH HIS LITTLE BROTHER. HE SAYS ITS VERY IMPORTANT...AND HE IS DEDICATED TO IT.

LIFE WITHOUT LIMITS....EVEN IF ONE IS WITHOUT LIMBS

AIR DATE: DECEMBER 1, 2013

GUEST: EMILY KNOWLAND....EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AND CO-FOUNDER OF THE ORGANIZATION 'LIMBS WITHOUT LIMITS'.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE START OF THIS ORGANIZATION. KNOWLAND STARTED THE ORGANIZATION BECAUSE OF HER HUSBAND.

WHILE ON THE JOB....HE WAS INJURED WHEN SOMETHING FELL ON HIS LEG. IT WAS ABLE TO BE PATCHED UP....BUT THE LEG DID NOT WORK AT 100% . THEN....THE UNTHINKABLE. 'LIMBS WITHOUT LIMITS' IS YOUNG. BUT IT IS ALREADY WORKING TO HELP THOSE WHO HAVE LOST ARMS OR LEGS LIVE AS NORMAL AS POSSIBLE.

ITS GENERAL MESSAGE IS THAT LIFE IS NOT OVER JUST BECAUSE OF THE LOSS OF A LIMB. ACTIVITIESFROM WALKS TO GOLF TO MARATHONS...ARE STILL POSSIBLE. KNOWLAND SAYS THE WORST THING THAT CAN HAPPEN IS FOR SOMEONE IN THIS SITUATION TO GIVE UP...AND SIT IN A CHAIR AND NOT MOVE.

THE MESSAGE OF 'LIMBS WITHOUT LIMITS' IS YOU CAN STILL DO MOST OF WHAT YOU WANT TO DO. YOU JUST NEED TO TRY AND STAY OPTIMISTIC. THERE IS HELP AND SUPPORT.

THE GUESTS WERE ALL SUBMARINERS AND ALL WANT TO SAVE THE CLAMAGORE FROM ITS REEF FATE. RIGHT NOW...THE CLAMAGORE IS ON DISPLAY AT PATRIOTS POINT. BUT THE SUB NEEDS A LOT OF WORK. IT WOULD BE EASIER AND CHEAPER FOR THE SUB TO BE SUNK AS A REEF. BUT THE 'SAVE THE CLAMAGORE' EFFORT WANTS TO TAKE IT OUT OF THE WATER....FIX IT UP....AND MOVE IT TO NORTH CHARLESTON WHERE IT CAN EVENTUALLY GO ON DISPLAY WITH THE CIVIL WAR SUBMARINE HUNLEY.

THE SAVE THE CLAMAGORE ORGANIZATION IS NOW IN THE MIDDLE OF A HUGE FUNDRAISER. THE RESULTING FUNDS WOULD BE USED TO RENOVATE THE OLD SUB.....AND HOUSE IT IN A DISPLAY.

THE CLAMAGORE WAS BUILT TOO LATE TO SERVE DURING WORLD WAR-2. IT SERVED DURING THE COLD WAR. ITS BEEN PART OF PATRIOTS POINT SINCE 1981. THE CLAMAGORE IS THE ONLY GUPPY-3 SUBMARINE PRESERVED IN THE UNITED STATES. IN 1989 THE CLAMAGORE WAS DESIGNATED A NATIONAL HISTORIC LANDMARK. THE GUESTS SAY THAT FACT IS ALL THE MORE REASON FOR THE SUB TO BE SAVED.
