Tanner who has a five year old daughter, Amelia, wanted to know if she could ask the pod cast man, who is Dr. Anders this question. Amelia asks, after we are done being in heaven and Jesus gives us our bodies back will we still have birthdays? Dr. Anders says this is a great question. We mark our birthdays by the sequence of the years because that's how the calendar works. He says I don't have a clue on how the new heavens and earth will be. They both agreed that she gets points for coming up with a great question. Dr. Anders says maybe for a five year old the right answer will be everyday will be a birthday celebration. Tom Price says good answer.

02/02/2024 at 2:00 pm to 2:30pm...Called to Communion...60 minutes...Host is Dr. David Anders. Dr. Anders talked about the fact that God does not have emotions. He described emotions as passing from one state of consciousness to another one. He points out the God doesn't have passing states of consciousness. God is made of knowledge that he always knows everything in one instant. And we would be incompatible with the way we process information which is very temporal. God is the ultimate good from which all good flows. To encounter God is to encounter goodness.

02/14/2024 at 2:00 pm to 2:30pm...Called to Communion...60 minutes...Host is Dr. David Anders. A caller asked how does purgatory mesh with the Resurrection? Dr. Anders tells the caller that the Catholic Church says that purgatory exists. He says there is no dogmatic claim about the time one spends in purgatory or the exact nature of the conditions of the souls in Purgatory. So it is perfectly conceivable that purgatory could be all but an instantaneous event, particularly for the souls at the end of time. These are Dr. Anders words.

03/07/2024 at 2:00 pm to 2:30pm...Called to Communion...60 minutes...Host is Dr. David Anders. Dr. Anders talked about the fact that God did not punish Jesus for our sins. He

says the Resurrection is a vindication of Christ. The scriptures don't say that God punished Jesus on our behalf. They say instead that the death of Christ should be conceived of as a sacrifice of atonement. That we are now reconciled with God. This is language drawn from the old testament sacrificial system.

03/20/2024 at 2:00 pm to 2:30pm...Called to Communion...60 minutes...Host Dr. David Anders. Dr. Anders receives a call from Diane from Texas asking when do you need to admonish someone? Dr. Anders said you need three criteria to act. 1. The matter under consideration is of grave matter. He said you need to take the spec out of your own eye before you talk to your brother. 2. The person you are admonishing, you need to have some sort of good faith expectation that they are going to listen. It is important to know that sometimes when a person is admonished they have a tendency to do the opposite. This would provoke them to worse behavior. 3. Are you the best suited person to do the admonishing?

01/02/2024 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is in...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in-show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on raising children.

Dr. Ray talked about physical exercise and how good it is for us especially as we get older. He lifts weights and says one of the frustrating things about lifting for a long time is that you do get to a point where your body says you know that no matter how hard and how much you lift you can't go any higher. As a matter of fact, all you can do is slow the slide. He says that is where I am at. But here's the key, you want to be strong for your age. As you get older there's less and less people doing what you do.

Dr. Ray talked about people apologizing multiple times for the same offense. We tend not to believe that they are sorry. Dr. Ray says a person can be truly contrite and fall into sin over and over again because they do not want to sin again. It doesn't mean their apology is insincere.

Dr. Ray has an experiment for us. He wants us to predict what our children will be like at age 18 and if you already have older children, I would like you to predict what they would be like a year from now. He goes on with several other ways to predict what your children would be like at different ages of growth and maturity. Parents think if they could go back and make better decisions their children may have turned out better. But parents can't go back. Dr. Ray says the scary part of this is that when we start telling parents if you didn't do it right we can hold you accountable. This is absolutely frightening.

Anxiety can save your life. God has wired it into our systems for survival. Our senses tell us when to be afraid and they tell the brain, which tells the body and everything cascaded in this symphonic orchestration of protection. Dr. Ray said this is called fight or flight response and sometimes freeze is thrown in there. He says it mobilizes the body for action.
