10/1/22	9:30 am	30 min.	<i>Parenting Today's Teens: What if You Can't Trust Your Teen?</i> Mark Gregston offers practical advice to parents who can't believe a word their teenager says due to consistent lying. Hope for rebuilding trust over time.
10/13/22	9:00 am	30 min.	<i>FamilyLife Today</i> – Dave and Ann Wilson visit with author David Eaton about the high stakes of engaging with teenagers as parents when they make big mistakes. How to love and relate to our teens without overreacting, even when they blow it.
11/2/22	7:00 pm	30 min.	<i>Open the Bible: The Glory of the Lord</i> – Pastor Colin Smith compares the calling of Godly fathers to that of other spiritual leaders. Encouragement for what Fathers can say to build up and lead their family members in a way that both offers and garners respect.
11/15/22	12:30 pm	30 min.	<i>Focus on the Family: More Effective Habits to Embrace in Parenting</i> – Dr. Randy Shroeder describes simple, bite-sized tips for being a more successful parent, and how to achieve them as a couple. How listeners can value their spouse while nurturing their children.

11/1/22	1:00 pm	30 min.	<i>Sekulow</i> : The ACLJ team discusses a recently leaked document saying Twitter and Facebook portals developed for the US Department of Homeland Security were to track and retain intellectual property and posts of legally dissenting citizens.
11/15/22	11:00 am	15 min.	<i>Discover the Word: Misreading Paul</i> – Guest historians Randy Richards and Brandon O’Brien join the panel to discuss the socio-political system of ancient Rome that included slavery, and why Jesus did not speak out specifically against such oppression in Scripture.
11/16/22	1:00 pm	30 min.	<i>Sekulow</i> : The Road to 2024 Begins Now – Jay and ACLJ team members discuss the road to the 2024 Presidential election in light of Donald Trump’s recent campaign announcement speech.

10/31/22	1:30 pm	30 min.	<i>Moneywise: The Great Millennial Sell-off</i> – Program host Rob West gives cautionary examples of Millennials selling investments unwisely due to allowing emotions about market volatility to outweigh their commitment to a long-term plan.
11/9/22	9:30 am	30 min.	<i>FamilyLife Today</i> – Hosts Dave and Ann Wilson invite author Bob Lotich to share how he went from deep financial despair to paying off \$400,000 in debt and giving away \$1 million by the age of 40. A true story to offer hope for the financially desperate listener.
11/17/22	10:00 am	30 min.	<i>Turning Point: A Life of Generosity</i> – Pastor and teacher David Jeremiah asserts that in a society where real generosity seems rare, Christians are not always the exception to this observation... but can be. How and why to develop a more giving spirit.
11/29/22	11:30 am	1 min.	<i>The Point: Generosity; Why We Give</i> – John Stonestreet points out the disparity between the number of American Evangelicals who believe in tithing 10% and the actual % of income given annually by the same group. He says many are missing out on the joys of giving that God would like his followers to experience.
12/7/22	1:30 pm	30 min.	<i>Moneywise: Wise Year-End Giving</i> – Host Rob West looks to Scripture’s call for people to be both generous and wise in their affairs. He identifies specific ways that year-end-giving can help with both goals.

10/31/22	9:15 pm	15 min.	<i>The Storyteller: Byron Sarracino (Laguna Pueblo)</i> -- When Byron Sarracino returned home to the reservation excited to share about his newfound faith in Jesus, his relatives were confused and disdainful. They encouraged him to drink and berated him for accepting “white man’s religion.” How his steadfast joy in what God had done for him eventually led to a change-of-heart for many in his family.
11/3/22	11:00 am	15 min.	<i>Discover the Word: One and Many</i> – Host panelists discuss the discomfort of confrontation and encourage listeners not to avoid or see all confrontation as relational setback, but as opportunity for God to mature and unite the members of the body of Christ.
11/14/22	9:00 am	30 min.	<i>Insight for Living:</i> Pastor Chuck Swindoll points out the growing disconnect between what he describes as the current age of narcissism and the Biblical calling to engage in relational humility rather than chase after earthly definitions of success, fame, or fortune.
11/18/22	9:30 am	30 min.	<i>FamilyLife Today</i> – Guest author Peter Mutabazi shares hope through his compelling story of early childhood abuse, living alone on the streets in Uganda, and the moment when a caring stranger asked him his name. From one person’s willingness to know him, Peter learned to know and be known by God.
12/12/22	6:30 pm	30 min.	<i>Focus on the Family: Understanding the Hot Buttons in Your Marriage</i> – Dr. Bob Paul and his wife Jenni share about a conflict-elevating pattern they identified early in marriage but seemed unable to stop. Now they help others recognize how/when insecurities are likely to be triggered and how to maintain emotional control.

10/3/22	9:15 pm	15 min.	<i>The Storyteller: Allan Jolly (Cree)</i> – As a young adult, Alan Jolly learned about Jesus’ sinless life, love and sacrifice to save him. He wanted to accept this Savior, but cigarette addiction kept him from the decision. How Allan took those feelings to the God he wanted to trust, and how God gently took cigarettes from him.
10/6/22	7:00 pm	30 min.	<i>Open the Bible: He Leads Me</i> – Pastor Colin Smith examines the prevailing Biblical metaphor of God as the Good Shepherd leading his flock in two directions simultaneously: into both rest and righteousness.
11/21/22	9:00 am	30 min.	<i>Insight for Living</i> – Pastor Chuck Swindoll observes that many people who do not accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior do often look to him as the standard for good behavior. Why acknowledging the deity and Lordship of Jesus is key to closing the gap between his comportment and our own foibles.
11/25/22	8:00 pm	30 min.	<i>In Touch: Why Do We Waver in Our Faith?</i> Dr. Charles Stanley addresses yo-yo-like faith and why many Christians confident in their eternal salvation at times find their faith wavering in the face of daily or unexpected challenges.
12/16/22	10:30 am	30 min.	<i>Truth for Life: Christ the Lord</i> – Pastor Alistair Begg says that people of varying worldviews call for “Peace on Earth” during the Christmas season. He explains how the baby announced by angels is the only way to true peace and how listeners can experience it themselves.
