Quarterly List of Programming Responsive to Issues of Community Concern Second Quarter 2013 July 8, 2013

In our ongoing effort to serve the public interest, WXMA-FM broadcasts programming responsive to issues of concern to Louisville and its listening public. The following is a brief description of those issues and of the station's most significant programming treatment of them:

Issues of importance this quarter included the following:

Women's Issues: Because WXMA's target demographic is women, primarily ages 25-54, the station is a strong proponent of all issues relating to women. From breast cancer awareness to forums that empower women as they juggle home and career demands to elementary education, WXMA tries to provide women with valuable information about the issues that regularly concern and affect them.

Adopt-A-Pet: The Louisville community is populated by a large number of abandoned and available cats and dogs. Metro Animal Services and The Kentucky Humane Society are some of the local shelters that collect these animals and then offer them for adoption, while also promoting responsible pet ownership. These efforts are part of an on-going feature during the Lambert and Lindsey Morning Show. WXMA also was a sponsor of The Kentucky Humane Society's Waggin Trail 5-K Walk to promote pet adoption.

Family Issues: The families of our community are always a strong focus of WXMA's programming. From biking events and family runs/walks to city-wide events to promote healthy lifestyles, WXMA sponsored events to raise money for our local children's hospital and supported a club for families affected by cancer, The Multiple Sclerosis Society and local drives to feed needy families.

Arts and Entertainment: WXMA always strives to make the Arts and important part of station programming and has spend significant time this quarter promoting our local "Broadway Series" as an excellent way for families to embrace and enjoy the arts. The station hopes that with cut-backs in local school funding for the arts, this may be one opportunity to expose young people to the beauty of music and theatre.
