Quarterly List of Programming Responsive to Issues of Community Concern Third Quarter 2013 October 8, 2013

In our ongoing effort to serve the public interest, WXMA-FM broadcasts programming responsive to issues of concern to Louisville and its listening public. The following is a brief description of those issues and of the station's most significant programming treatment of them:

Issues of importance this quarter included the following:

Health: Health issues receive major emphasis on WXMA. The station promoted a major far-reaching cancer study being conducted in our community, the importance of regular fitness with several family runs and walks, and supported heart health through a monthlong promotion with the American Heart Association. As a station primarily targeting women, WXMA also supported events to raise awareness of early detection and treatments for breast cancer.

Family Issues: The families of our community are always a strong focus of WXMA's programming. From promoting fundraisers in support of our local children's hospital to participating in events to show parents how to properly install carseats to initiatives to help inner city kids stay physically active, WXMA continues to focus on issues facing the families of our community.

The Arts: Educating both children and adults about the arts is an important priority for WXMA. From promoting local plays and concerts to major Broadway shows, the station conducted interviews with artist and performers from ballets and musicals and helped promote the family entertainment values of these shows.

Education: WXMA worked to highlight the strengths of our local schools with morning show broadcasts giving helpful information about the start of the school year, attended galas to honor community support in the schools and guest lectured in classrooms for elementary and college students on good communication skills and the events of the day.
