Section I. Issues.

WSIC has identified the following issues as significant for the broadcast area:

- A. Local Government: Citizens need to be informed of the actions and organization of their local government.
- B. Local Business: Pertaining to knowledge of the operations, organization and offerings of businesses in our broadcast area.
- C. Law Enforcement: Information provided to the broadcast audience pertaining to law enforcement related topics in our communities.
- D. Community Life: Wanting to help listeners live an engaged and active community life, this information from the station informs about community events and community groups.
- E. Political: Matters relating to local and national government that are of interest and importance to the listening audience.

Section II. Responsive Programs

A. Local Government:

- A. **“Around the City”** - Broadcast weekly on Mondays at 8:30 AM. 30 minutes. 04-14-2014 “Events in Statesville” Today on Around the City Nancy Davis describes the art crawl and other things that happened in Statesville this past. The quiz bowl was also this weekend and Nancy explains how this was the 20th year that the quiz bowl has taken place. Nancy also describes other events that will be coming up soon in Statesville.
- B. **“Around the City”** - Broadcast weekly on Mondays at 8:30 AM. 30 minutes. 04-28-2014 “Mayor Costi Kutteh” Today on Around the City Mayor Costi Kutteh joins the show to talk about things going on around the Statesville area. Mayor Kutteh describes things such as student government day that has taken place in Statesville for the past 9 years. Kutteh describes how positive this event is for 5th graders and how much they enjoy it.

- C. **“Around the City”** - Broadcast weekly on Mondays at 8:30 AM. 30 minutes. 05-05-2014 “Chief Tom Anderson” Today on Around the City Nancy Davis is joined by Chief Tom Anderson to get an update on the Love truck stop. Chief Anderson explains how there will be a vote soon to decide on whether or not to have the truck stop. Nancy also explains the city council meeting that will take place tonight.
- D. **“Around the City”** - Broadcast weekly on Mondays at 8:30 AM. 30 minutes. 05-19-2014 “Mayor Costi Kutteh” Today on Around the City Statesville Mayor Costi Kutteh joins the show to describe some summer events that will be taking place in Statesville. Nancy and Mayor Kutteh describe the Statesville leisure pool that will be opening this Saturday and what their hours will be. Nancy also describes the Firewroks event that will be taking place on the 4th of July.
- E. **“Around the City”** - Broadcast weekly on Mondays at 8:30 AM. 30 minutes. 06-02-2014 “Chief Anderson” Chief Tom Anderson joins the around the City show once again to discuss different things going on within the Statesville Police Department. Chief Anderson describes what changes are taking place as well as what the crime rate has been in Statesville. Anderson also goes into detail on how much he loves working here in Statesville and how he hopes to one day retire here.

B. Local Business:

- A. **“Local Biz Now”** - Broadcast weekly on Fridays at 8:00 AM. 60 minutes. 04-11-2014 “RNB Games” Beverly from RNB Games joins Local Biz to discuss her business and what types of games they have. Beverly describes how they have cards games, electronic games, plus much more. She also describes how you can bring your own games into RNB Games and also buy games from them too.

C. Law Enforcement:

- A. **“The Good, the Bad, and the Guilty”** - Broadcast weekly on Wednesdays at 8:30 AM. 04-16-2014 “How to keep kids safe” Today on the Sheriff Show Captain Rick Eades joins the show to describes the best ways to keep your children safe. With a lot of stuff going on in the news about children being kidnapped and other things, Eades describes the importance of teaching children right from wrong when they are at a young age. Eades also says they are seeing more of this in Iredell County and it needs to be stopped.
- B. **“The Good, the Bad, and the Guilty”** - Broadcast weekly on Wednesdays at 8:30 AM. 04-30-2014 “Sheriff Darren Campbell” Today on the Sheriff Show Darren Campbell talks about the recent crimes in Iredell County. He describes the crimes that take place on camera and how helpful that is to officers. He talks about how having video evidence is great in court and he thinks every business needs to have cameras covering all parts of their property.

Eades discusses how great officers have been doing of taking down the bad guys and keeping drugs off the streets. Eades also goes into detail on different crimes and where they stand as of now.
- D. **“The Good, the Bad, and the Guilty”** - Broadcast weekly on Wednesdays at 8:30 AM. 05-21-2014 “Undercover Work” Today on the Sheriff Show Rick Eades joins the show to discuss the undercover work that the Sheriff’s Office has been doing. He doesn’t go into too much detail obviously, but he talks about the recent cases that have had undercover officers involved. Eades says how important it is to have undercover officers because criminals do not see them coming.
- E. **“The Good, the Bad, and the Guilty”** - Broadcast weekly on Wednesdays at 8:30 AM. 06-11-2014 “Summer activities in Iredell County” Today on the Sheriff Show Captain Rick Eades describes what activities are good to keep young children busy with summer getting started. Eades also describes how there are various water parks and other fun things to do around the Charlotte and Iredell County areas. Eades says the Sheriff’s Office always sees more crimes during the summer time, so everyone needs to be safe as well.

D. Community Life:

- A. **“Live Local”** - Broadcast weekly on Mondays at 11:00 AM. 60 minutes. 04-14-2014 “Martha Hazelton” Martha Hazelton from the Iredell Cooperative Extension service joins the Live Local show to describe what she does. Martha explains to Scott an event called the garden fair that will be taking place the Saturday after Easter. She also explains where it will be located and how many years this fair has been taking place.
- B. **“Live Local”** - Broadcast weekly on Mondays at 11:00 AM. 60 minutes. 04-28-2014 “Tornadoes” Today on the Live Local show Scott goes into detail on the Tornos taking place in Arkansas. Scott describes how many people have lost their lives and their homes. He describes how
