
**SUBJECTS AND/OR TOPICS COVERED:**

PA One Call's "Call Before You Dig," The 811 Hotline, "Know What's Below." PA residents must call 811 at least 3 days prior to excavation before any sort of digging is done with powered equipment or even non-powered equipment. And it doesn't matter how deep you are digging, no project is too small or too large. "Call Before You Dig" in order to have buried infrastructure properly marked. "One nation, One Number, The 811 Program, it provides Columbia gas of PA and all the other gas companies and power companies and cable companies, "the facility owners," calling 811 gives everyone a chance to mark their lines with colored paint, flags or chalk and prevent a potentially dangerous situation. "Know What's Below." PA One Call's Call Before You Dig Hotline operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year. Its convenient, its free and it's the law. Even if you're planning on planting shrubs or building a deck or even installing a mailbox, they ALL require a call to 811.






