- 10/1/23 – 12/31/23: Ran a minimum of 8 local newscasts each weekday, and FOX news at the top of at least 7 hours daily
- 10/1/23 – 12/31/23: Ran 13 required weekly EAS tests & 6 required monthly EAS tests.
