The number above can safely be multiplied x 3 months for a ballpark figure.**

- 4/1/23 – 6/30/23: Ran a minimum of 8 local newscasts each weekday, and FOX news at the top of at least 7 hours daily.
- 4/1/23 – 6/30/23: Ran 13 required weekly EAS tests & 6 required monthly EAS tests.
