WPNA 103.1 FM Programs Addressing Public and Community Issues

During the second quarter of 2018, WPNA's bilingual (Polish/English) locally produced programming addressed the following issues of concern to the public:

- Afternoon with 103.1 FM (April 2nd, 4:00 p.m., segment duration 4 min.) Afternoon host, Jacek Zielinski, interviewed Filip Frąckowiak, director of the General Kukliński Museum. The guest addressed the issue of political changes affecting retirement compensation of military personnel that served communistic Poland. He also summarized the mission of the General Kukliński Museum that's located in the US – where the Polish general lived for a large part of his life.
- Morning with 103.1 FM (April 9th, 8:00 a.m., segment duration 7 min.) Morning show host, Magda Marczewska, interviewed Ewa Koch, president of the Association of Polish Teachers in the US, about the Seal of Biliteracy exam and

its benefits for the bilingual students living in Chicago and attending public schools.

Grazyna Skoczen organized a charity gala in Chicago benefiting the institution.
