DIRECTV will continue carriage of WMFP-TV in the Boston, Massachusetts local market on January 1, 2009 in accordance with Section 338 of the Communications Act of 1934 and the Federal Communications Commission's Rules.

In connection with the pending digital transition, DIRECTV has already converted the signals in the Boston, Massachusetts local market area from analog to standard definition digital. As such, DIRECTV will continue to carry a standard definition version of WMFP-TV's digital signal until such time as DIRECTV offers local signals in Boston, Massachusetts on an "HD carry-one, carry-all" basis, as contemplated in the Commission's recent *Digital Carriage Order*.
