Kristen Remington's report on Drug and Alcohol Addiction Local KTVN Special Report	Channel 2 News anchor Kristen Remington and photojournalist Brad Horn spent six months documenting the successes and failures of people battling drug and alcohol addiction, as they work to live clean and sober lives through The Salvation Army's Adult Rehabilitation Program. This is a 180 day work-therapy program that offers counseling, classes and the tools needed to start over as productive members of society. The program is not funded by tax-payer dollars; it's funded entirely by donations (furniture/clothing, etc.) that are re-sold through The Salvation Army Thrift Stores around Northern Nevada. The men in recovery work a full shift in the warehouse - sorting, pricing and preparing the donations for re-sale. After their shift, they will attend their classes, counseling sessions and church twice a week. Many of the participants have lived on the streets, panhandled for money and have detoxed more than once. The rate of success is shockingly low, but as the A.R.P. Director says, "If we save just one life – we won, haven't we?" We follow three men through the program. Early on we lost one of them; he found a bottle of rubbing alcohol in the distribution warehouse and "could not help himself" from opening it up and chugging it! Another recovering alcoholic just recently graduated and is now engaged to be married and about to start work for a local landscaping company. The third man we interviewed is a 23-year-old recovering meth addict. He was kicked out of the program for stealing and living back on the streets.
