We also have USA and local news, weather, and traffic updates on an hourly basis.

Eagle Forum airs Monday thru Friday at 3:15 PM and is a three minute program. Since 1983, The Phyllis Schlafly Report has delivered a thoughtful and clear voice on behalf of the family, traditional values, and America. Mrs. Schlafly equips listeners with insights and solutions on a variety of issues that affect the family, the community, and the nation. Attached are the programs which aired this quarter.

Homeschool Heartbeat is a 2 minute broadcast which airs Monday thru Friday at 4:15 PM. It is produced by Home School Legal Defense Association and provides information on the homeschooling movement. The broadcast was started in May of 1991 and addresses a variety of topics that are educational, legal, and spiritual for parents whether they already homeschool or are considering moving in that direction.

Prayer and Issues is a program that runs from approximately 5:15 PM to 5:45 PM Monday through Friday. During this time issues facing Western North Carolina and important events happening in the area are addressed by Bro. Tony Maynor, Station Manager. When addressing these issues or events Bro. Maynor will bring in certain guests to help discuss it on air either in person or by phone.
