

2021-2023 RETRANSMISSION CONSENT ELECTION STATEMENT  
FOR STATION KEYT

This Statement constitutes the election, pursuant to Section 76.64 and Section 76.66 of the Rules of the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”), by NPG of California, LLC, licensee of Station KEYT-TV, Santa Barbara, CA (the “Station”), to require the multichannel video programming distributors listed below to obtain the Station’s consent beginning January 1, 2021, for retransmission of its broadcast signal by, but not limited to, the multichannel video programming distribution system(s) serving the Santa Barbara – Santa Maria – San Luis Obispo, California DMA Designated Market Area (“DMA”), including, but not limited to, each and every community, county, and any unincorporated area within such communities and counties, including each community, county, and unincorporated area therein in which such system(s) are currently retransmitting the Station’s broadcast signal, any other areas within the Station’s Designated Market Area, and any other areas within the Station’s “television market” as set forth in Section 76.55(e) of the Rules of the FCC, including any modifications thereto pursuant to Section 76.59 of the Rules of the FCC.

This election is effective for the election cycle beginning January 1, 2021, and terminating as of December 31, 2023.
