Graham addressed why the speed with which these vaccines were developed can make people feel hesitant to get vaccinated and talked about the well-thought-out process of vaccine development. Graham also talked about the differences in the three vaccines and the new COVID-19 variants that are emerging throughout the world. He also talked about treatments on the horizon.
- Joi Gordon is the CEO of Dress for Success Worldwide. She discussed Women's History Month and how
  Dress for Success has become a globally recognized leader that has empowered more than one million women to
  become economically advanced in nearly 150 cities in more than 20 countries. In addition to expanding the
  organization's reach, Joi talked about Dress for Success programming, offering a full continuum of services that
  help women secure employment, advance in their careers, and achieve financial freedom.

In the United States, 1 in 5 people have learning and thinking differences, like dyslexia and ADHD, and 1 in 4 adults have some type of disability. Understood.org provides information, helpful resources, and chairs supportive communities so people who think differently can thrive at home, school and work. Both Yancy and Morin talked about their organization and their innovative perspectives. Their mission is to decrease friction, increase access, prioritize clarity and improve always.

- Alex Ochart, an expert in technology, talks about the great global technological crisis that the pandemic has created and that has affected even the largest companies such as Sony, Peloton and how it could affect the consumer.
- Hispanics feel ignored by beauty companies. A new study says our community spends about \$7 billion a year. Who says it? **AARP spokesperson lvone Fernández** speaks on this issue.
