

## STATE WEEK IN REVIEW THIRD QUARTER 2014

July 4-Brian Mackey, WUIS; Charlie Wheeler, Dir. Of the Public Affairs Reporting Program, UIS;; Jamey Dunn, Illinois Issues Magazine & Kurt Erickson, Lee Enterprises newspapers. Topics-1. Illinois Supreme Court ruling in *Kanerva v. Weems*, the state retiree health insurance lawsuit. 2) Gov. Quinn signs the budget and claims credit for vetoing \$250 for Capitol renovations -- except there were no immediate plans to spend that money anyway. 3) IDOT Director Ann Schneider resigns; she's replaced by Veterans Affairs Director Erica Borggren.

July 11, Bill Wheelhouse, Brian Mackey & Amanda Vinicky, WUIS; Ray Long, Chicago Tribune. Topics- 1.Private Legislative Inspector General Document on House Speaker Michael Madigan's influence, Feds ask State Committee to hold off on investigating Governor Quinn's Neighborhood Recovery Initiative as there is a federal investigation. 3-Passing of former US Senator Alan Dixon.

July 18 Bill Wheelhouse, Brian Mackey and Amanda Vinicky WUIS & Dave McKinney, Chicago Sun Times. Topics: Neighborhood Recovery Initiative hearings result in partisan arguments as Federal prosecutor wants Legislative committee to hold off calling witnesses. Discuss the politics of the hearings. Bruce Rauner releases details of budget plan.

July 25- Bill Wheelhouse, Brian Mackey and Amanda Vinicky WUIS , Kurt Erickson, Lee Enterprises newspapers. Illinois Executive Inspector General has taken an unusual step and is asking to be part of a lawsuit accusing Governor Quinn's administration of patronage hiring. Also businesses and well connected lobbyists begin working toward the licenses and permits to be in the medical marijuana business.

August 1-Bill Wheelhouse & Brian Mackey-WUIS, Charlie Wheeler, Director of the Public Affairs Reporting Program UIS, & John O'Connor Associated Press. Topics: Governor Quinn signs measure allowing question on Illinois ballots as to whether millionaires should pay more in taxes. State Fair managers fined for improperly accepting beer tickets from vendors.

August 8- Bill Wheelhouse, Amanda Vinicky & Brian Mackey-WUIS, Charlie Wheeler, Director of the Public Affairs Reporting Program UIS, & Dave McKinney of the Chicago Sun Times. Topics include publicity surrounding Bruce Rauner's private equity firm holding accounts in the Cayman Islands. Quinn administration not releasing details of IDOT hiring fixes. State Representative LeShawn Ford gets charges reduced to misdemeanor, which will allow him to remain in the legislature.

August 15-Bill Wheelhouse & Amanda Vinicky-WUIS, Mike Riopell, political editor of the Daily Herald Bernie Schoenburg, political Columnist for the State Journal Register in Springfield & Charlie Wheeler, Director of the Public Affairs Reporting Program UIS. Topics discussed politics and political days surrounding the Illinois State Fair.

August 22- Bill Wheelhouse & Amanda Vinicky -WUIS, Charlie Wheeler, Director of the Public Affairs Reporting Program UIS, & Ray Long of the Chicago Tribune. Extended conversation on the inspector general's report on political hiring at IDOT & Failed attempts to get term limits constitutional amendment on the November ballot.

August 29- Bill Wheelhouse & Amanda Vinicky -WUIS, Charlie Wheeler, Director of the Public Affairs Reporting Program UIS, & John Byrne, Reporter, Chicago Tribune. Discussed the appearances of the Republican and Democratic gubernatorial candidates at the Metropolitan Planning Council in Chicago including discussion of infrastructure issues, both candidates spoke on Ag issues this week before the Illinois Farm Bureau, a judge issued injunction stopping state retirees from being forced to pay premiums for their health insurance & The governor's veto of legislation which would have regulated ride sharing services.

September 5 Bill Wheelhouse & Amanda Vinicky -WUIS, Charlie Wheeler, Director of the Public Affairs Reporting Program UIS & John O'Connor of the Associated Press. The politics of the Governor's race this week including the minimum wage debate, pass comments by Rauner and Quinn taking minimum wage challenge and Paul Vallas' assertion is Rauner too rich to be governor. The issue of Governor candidates talking property tax freezes when the property tax is under local control.

September 12- Bill Wheelhouse & Amanda Vinicky -WUIS, Charlie Wheeler, Director of the Public Affairs Reporting Program UIS, & Kristen McQueary of the Chicago Tribune. Discussion of the candidates' for governor appearance before the Chicago Tribune Editorial board and of a legislative proposal to add body and dash cameras around the state for police officers, funded by an increase in fines.

Of the Public Affairs Reporting Program, University of Illinois, Springfield; Guest – Kerry Lester, Statehouse Bureau Chief for the Associated Press Topics: Republican candidate for governor Bruce Rauner unveils ethics blueprint; governor's race gets increasingly nasty; Quinn says NFL and team owners – like Rauner – need to step it up in addressing domestic violence following the Ray Rice videotape; Libertarian Party slate makes it onto Nov. 4 election ballot.
