1. Family conflicts

Buenas Nuevas para la Familia with host Pastor Netz Gomez. Call-in talk show with live listener Q&A. 60 min., live at 11:00 a.m.

7/1	Q&A (2) Palmdale - My husband accuses me of infidelity. How can I show him I am innocent?;
7/8	Q&A - (1) Beverly Hills - My wife says she feels <i>stuck</i> with me. What do you think she means?
8/1	Marriage Restoration - P I - Marriage was designed by God. He had a plan for the family and was through marriage. He created a couple to love and support each other, and reproduces, giving them authority over everything that lives on earth. And the restoration of marriage has always been God's priority.
8/2	Marriage Restoration - P II - Admitting that there is a problem in the marriage is the first step towards restoration. It all starts with small problems, and if we leave them unattended, it can turn into chaos. The only one who can make a deep and true restoration is the One who <i>created</i> marriage.

8/8	Understanding the Purpose of Marriage -P I - God created marriage for himself, before creating it for us or for our delight. Colossians 1:16 says:"for in him all things in heaven and on earth were created, things visible and invisible...'
8/9	Understanding the Purpose of Marriage -P II - In marriage, everything is not about you first. If you are going to have a great marriage, you should get out of your small individual purposes and enter the greater purposes that God has established in His Word.
8/10	Understanding the Purpose of Marriage - P III - A good marriage is always based on positive words. Husband and wife cannot know each other well unless they develop the ability to communicate - ads this is how conflicts and frustrations are resolved.
8/11	Understanding the Purpose of Marriage - P IV - "I don't trust you, I don't like you"... The number one factor to <i>predict</i> a divorce, is <i>critics</i> . It is a negative tone that is set in the relationship, as a filter through which you can see it all - both internally and externally.

8/15	Preventing Domestic Violence - Domestic violence manifests itself in different ways - but the goal is always the same - control their victims through fear. It should be spoken from the pulpit the different forms of domestic violence and initiate programs to meet the needs of the victims.
8/16	Ten Ways to Grow Your Marriage While Taking Care of Your Small Children - Having children changes the marriage permanently. Being a parent, despite all the stress it may cause, allows marriage to grow deeper and be more enriched. In my walk with Christ, nothing should have a higher priority in our lives to cultivate intimacy and friendship with our wife - even being a parent.
