Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of WatchTV, Inc., this is to request an extension of time until April 22, 2013, to respond to the Video Division's letters of March 12, 2013, requesting completion of the online public inspection file and documentation of Class A compliance by the above-listed Class A television stations.

The letters did not arrive in Southlake until several days after they were mailed, and it is not clear that the letters were mailed on the date shown on the letters. The letters request a great deal of information for several stations licensed to the same entity. It is not feasible to prepare a



full response by 10 days after the date of the letter, which would be tomorrow, March 22, particularly for a rural station with small staff resources.

This office must also assist multiple clients with their responses. Each client's circumstances are different, requiring individualized attention. In terms of completing the responses, both attorneys from this firm and the President of the licensee will be attending the National Association of Broadcasters convention April 7-10, which will interrupt the process of preparing responses.

WatchTV, Inc. intends to respond to the substantive questions in the letter and has no interest in relinquishing the Class A status of any of its stations.
