10 05 23 at 1900 The World Over 60 minutes EWTN Lead Anchor Raymond Arroyo hosts this weekly news program from Washington DC, with newsmakers from around the world. Raymond interviews Cardinal Burke, Perfect Emeritus of the Apostolic Signatura joins Raymond to discuss the formal questions, dubia, that he and five other Cardinals submitted to Pope Francis asking for clarity on points of doctrine and discipline going into the Synod on Synodality. Next, Gerhard Cardinal Muller, perfect emeritus of the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith and voting participant at the Synod on Synodality, joins Raymond to discuss news pertaining to the Synod and church doctrine. Lastly, Edward Pentin, Senior Correspondent for *The National Catholic Register* joins Raymond to talk about his reporting from Rome at the start of the Synod. Pentin discusses the big stories of the week including the new dubia from five Catholic cardinals and Pope Francis new apostolic exhortation on the environment.
