Emma L. Bowen Scholarship Recipient -WAGA-TV/FOX 5 is currently sponsoring Faith Lucas through the Emma L. Bowen Foundation for Minority Interests in Media, Inc. Established in 1989, the Emma L. Bowen Foundation for Minority Interests in Media is a non-profit organization whose mission is to create career opportunities in the media industry for minority youth through a program that focuses on scholastic achievement, direct work experience and professional development. Students in the program work in media companies each summer and during school breaks, from high school through college. The students earn both wages and matching scholarship funds to be used for college tuition and related expenses. Over a period of up to five (5) years, the students experience numerous aspects of Company operations and develop professional and practical skills that will help prepare them for their careers, many of which begin at the companies where the students interned. Fox Television Stations have been a corporate partner in this program since its inception and two of the Company's executives are on the Foundation's Board.
