

The following is a summary of Issues/Programs as presented on WTHT, Auburn, ME

From March 9-March 11, this station staged its 18<sup>th</sup> annual “Wolf Cares for Kids Radiothon” campaign, benefiting the Barbara Bush Children’s Hospital. The station annually devotes 33 hours of programming over three days to help raise funds with individual hourly goals. We hear from children and families who have benefitted from treatment at BBCH, as well as the professionals who administer care, social workers and child life specialists. The BBCH is Maine’s only full-service children’s hospital. This event in past years has helped the hospital acquire crucial items like pediatric transport units, and helped fund portions of the expansion of their Pediatric Intensive Care Unit. This year, the Cares for Kids Radiothon raised an unprecedented total of \$503,298 to directly benefit the BBCH.
