- RACHEL'S CHALLENGE: Campus violence is a major issue today and bullying, whether it's in person or online a challenge faced by a lot of young people.
- REALITY CHANGERS: The prospect of attending college is not a given for a lot of young people. There are a number of reasons, could be financial, could be it just wasn't part of a family's plans.
