KHTS-FM provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **A NEW PATH SAN DIEGO:** Since the death of music legend Prince there's been a lot of discussion surrounding the topic of addiction. There are reports that he had issues with painkillers and was attempting to get help. A New Path is a San Diego organization that works to help people who are addicted to get access to the services they need and to educate people about the disease of addiction. It advocates for therapeutic treatment over punitive drug policies.
- **AMER DIABETES ASSN:** A new study finds that an alarming rate of Americans either has diabetes or will be diagnosed in the future with the dangerous condition. The ADA in San Diego is working to educate people on the dangers of diabetes and the ways people can prevent it or keep it under control.
- **CA OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY:** April is recognized as National Distracted Driving Awareness Month. In California law enforcement has joined with the California Office for Traffic Safety and other organizations to educate people on the dangers of distracted driving. We discussed the issue and ways to stay safe on the road.
- **CHULA'S MISSION:** CHULA'S MISSION. THE GROUP PROVIDES SUPPORT AND MENTORSHIP FOR MOTHER-LESS GIRLS.
- **ELDERHELP SAN DIEGO:** Life can sometimes be difficult for everyone to navigate but if you're a senior, it can be even more challenging. There are the bigger decisions like deciding when living alone is no longer a safe option but...there are also the day to day basics. Getting to medical appointments, grocery shopping, getting things fixed around the home. Here in San Diego, ElderHelp is a non-profit organization that is assisting our aging population with a number of services and programs.
- **GOODWILL INDUSTRIES OF SD:** Most of us are familiar with Goodwill because either we (tm)ve donated or shopped there but, the organization is much more than its stores. In addition to providing employment training and paid work experience to people with disabilities Goodwill Industries of San Diego County has a

number of programs to help young people and Veterans in our community.

- **HATE CRIMES IN SD:** In the aftermath of the club shooting in Orlando we discussed the issue of hate crimes, in particular in the LGBT and Muslim communities. The District Attorney's office joined us to discuss its education and enforcement.
- **Mental Health:** There's been a big increase in the number of calls made to law enforcement for mental health related issues. We discussed the why and explored solutions.
- **MS SOCIETY:** We discussed Multiple Sclerosis, what is known about the disease and how to live and manage it with Christine Wiley senior manager for marketing with the National Multiple Sclerosis Society (tm)s Pacific South Coast Chapter here in San Diego, Doctor Charles Smith, a neurologist with Scripps Health, who treats people who have been diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis and Singer-songwriter and Broadway performer David Osmond, a member of the entertaining Osmond family and a nephew of Donny and Marie Osmond who was diagnosed with MS in 2006 at age 26.
- **SAY SAN DIEGO:** There are a lot of problems out there that can take people off the track of success in life. Drugs, family issues, economics. Say San Diego is a local non-profit organization that works to give individuals and families the tools needed to conquer many of those problems. It uses a holistic approach to empower people. Among the services offered by Say San Diego are access to healthcare, substance abuse, before and after school programs.
- **SD COASTKEEPER:** San Diego Coastkeeper is a local group that works to educate people on the importance of keeping our oceans and other waterways clean. The group launched a new curriculum for teachers that will allow them to meet state education mandates by teaching kids about the environments unique to San Diego.
- **TEEN DATING ABUSE:** The San Diego Domestic Violence Council along with the San Diego District Attorney's office, The San Diego Chargers other agencies have teamed up on a new campaign to get the word out to educate young people about healthy relationships and the warning signs of an abusive relationship.
- **TRAUMA INTERVENTION PROGRAM:** Getting through an emergency situation can be very traumatic. Whether it's a death, a crime or some other situation, you can be confused, in shock and in need of emotional support. TIP San Diego is a volunteer based program that offers emotional and practical support in times of need.
