III. RECRUITMENT INITIATIVES

1) Supplemental Recruitment Initiatives.

(a) Initiative: Internships

The Employment Unit has an active internship program. During this reporting period, the Employment Unit provided internship to students from Charleston Southern University, South Carolina State University, and Wando High School. Interns earn academic credit toward degrees in the fields of radio and television broadcasting.

(b) Initiative: Job Shadowing Job Fairs

Cumulus-Charleston hosts a job shadowing program designed to help expose students to the broadcast field. Students have opportunities to observe and participate in on-air broadcasts and/or decision-making process in the business department. Participants are presented information on the education and skills required for employment opportunities as broadcast and/or broadcast management personnel. During this reporting period, the Charleston Employment Unit hosted two students as job shadows – one student shadowed our Program Director and the other shadowed our On-Air Talent.

(c) Initiative: Job Fairs

- 1.) On October 24, 2013 Cumulus-Charleston participated in a job fair held at Charleston Southern University. An EU representative spoke with attendees about career opportunities in broadcasting/sales as well as job opening within the EU.
- 2.) On October 30, 2013 Cumulus-Charleston participated in a job fair held at the College of Charleston Stern Student Center Ballroom. An EU representative spoke with attendees about career opportunities in broadcasting/sales as well as job opening within the EU.
- 3.) On February 27, 2014 Cumulus-Charleston participated in a job fair held at the Citadel. An EU representative spoke with attendees about career opportunities in broadcasting/sales as well as job opening within the EU.

(d) Initiative: Events or programs sponsored by educational institutions relating to career opportunities

- 1.) On May 23, 2014 the EU Program Director attended Chicora School of Communication vehicle fair. The Program Director took the station vehicle to the school to show students how to use the equipment in the van.
- 2.) On June 10 & 11, 2014 EU participated as an externship host for a member of the Workplace Institute for Educators (WISE). The Guidance Counselor of Jerry Zucker Middle School had the opportunity to learn about the day to day operation of the radio industry for their students. They will use this information to develop their career development work for students.
- 3.) On April 21-25, 2014 EU Program Director hosted a Career Fair for Charleston Southern University at Cumulus-Charleston. Students (30) had the opportunity to produce commercials for a class project.
