Anger Relationship Relationship Positive	7/5/15	10P	Hour 1	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Her Anger Causes Fights With Boyfriend</b>            Ashton and her boyfriend fight all the time about money and her anger and depression issues. Ashton isn't sure where the anger has come from. Dawson said that anger can ruin a relationship, and is concerned that Ashton doesn't know why she is worried and depressed. He recommended that she work on figuring that out before trying to sustain a long-term relationship.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Fears About Ending Her Relationship</b>            Kristen isn't sure if her boyfriend is "the one." Kristen's boyfriend's mom and partner are mean and don't like her. She fears that if she ever got out of the relationship, they would use their political and government ties to cause a custody battle over her son. Dawson said the list of issues is long, and she can't live in fear of blackmail. He recommended that she get out of the relationship and start looking for a good lawyer.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Ex Is A Good Dad But Bad Boyfriend</b>            Madison's ex likes to push her away and pursue other girls then run back to her. They have a 7-month-old daughter together, and Madison says he's a good dad and loves his daughter. Dawson said that Madison is minimizing the issues to try to make her ex look and sound better. Dawson said that she is trying to convince herself to stay in a relationship even though she knows it is bad. He said that she is in a love addiction situation. He advised Madison that she needs to stop playing games with herself since there is a baby involved.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Thank You For Advice</b>            Kristen is calling to say thank you. She called in a few months ago because she was in a really bad place with family and friends, and had just gotten out of a bad relationship. After she called in her life changed drastically. She was able to graduate high school and is about to start college, she met some amazing friends, and got her first job. Kristen said that when Dawson told her that she needed to stop hanging out with the toxic people that were in her life and she took that advice to heart.</p>

Relationship Relationship Abuse Relationship	7/5/15	118	Hour 2	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Boyfriend Is Not In Love With Her</b>            Allison has been in an 8-year relationship, and this past November they bought a house together. Recently he told her that he was no longer in love with her and hadn't been for a few years. They are still living in the house together because neither can afford it on their own. Dawson said that he is gone from the relationship and that Allison needs to accept that this relationship is over and recommended selling the house.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Not Sure He's Ready To Get Engaged</b>            Shane's family is pressuring him to get engaged. Shane's girlfriend has a little boy, and they feel she needs to see that he is committed. Shane is worried about finances and wants to make sure he is secure and can provide before getting married. Shane's pastor advised him that if he waits until he is "ready" he would never get married. Dawson agreed with Shane's parents and pastor, and advised him to go ahead and give her a ring to formalize his commitment to her and her son.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Husband Has Been Abusive</b>            Christina and her husband's relationship has been physically and sexually abusive. He was put in military prison and given a restraining order which he violated. Then he was kicked out of the military and they both had to move back home. Christina has told her family she wants to leave him but her family wants them to go to counseling. She said that she was assaulted by him earlier today. Dawson said that is a crime and he and the staff need to get involved.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Her Fiancé Doesn't Treat Her Right</b>            Sarah loves her fiancé but knows the way he treats her is wrong. He will leave for the night and not respond to her messages. She knows he cheats on her and steals from her. Everyone tells her she should leave him. Dawson said this is a no-brainer. He said their souls are entangled, so to pull them apart is going to be painful. He told Sarah she is going to have to come to terms with her love addiction, and get help to get past it.</p>

Family Relationship Grief Career	7/12/15	109	Hour 1	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Mom In And Out Of Prison</b>            Kimmie's biological mom has been in and out of prison for drugs and fraud. Kimmie has a 10 month old and is wondering about if she should let her daughter be around her mom. Dawson proposed addressing the issue with her mother now while she is still in prison, and suggested letting her know about the hoops she will have to jump through to prove herself. He also recommended stages of interaction starting with very small supervised visits.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Afraid To Get Hurt, Like With Ex</b>            Joshua has been talking to a girl online for a while and also likes another girl. Josh isn't sure how to choose. Dawson said that Josh doesn't have to choose and he is jumping in to these relationships too quickly. Jessica said sometimes people can be in love with the idea of love rather than a person. Dawson advised Josh slow down and spend time getting to know them and it will all sort itself out.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Sister Died, Hard Time Going On</b>            Caitlyn's sister and her niece were killed in a car accident about 4 months ago. Caitlyn's sister was her role model and Caitlyn wanted to be that for her niece. Caitlyn knows her sister would want her to go on with life and be happy but she is struggling to do that. Dawson told Caitlyn that she needs to get her GED completed so that she doesn't sabotage her own future. He reminded Caitlyn that eventually she would be able to heal in time. Dawson told Caitlyn when she gets in a funk the key is to write or talk out what she is feeling so she doesn't sit in it.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Enlisted But Dream Is To Be Actor</b>            Alec enlisted in the army and is scheduled to leave soon, but his dream is to be an actor. Alec isn't sure if he should pursue his dream of acting or stick with his plan to go in to the military. Dawson said that he should definitely do both, and that wherever Alec finds himself there will be ways he can plug in to drama groups and acting opportunities. Jessica recommended that now that he has enlisted he should honor that commitment but remember that there will be plenty of time once he gets out.</p>

Relationship Relationship Stress Depression	7/12/15	11P	Hour 2	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Boyfriend Got Really Angry</b>            Jessi's boyfriend got really angry with her and left her some mean text messages and voicemails. The next day he apologized for everything and said he didn't mean anything he said. Jessi is very confused. Dawson said that Jessi shouldn't put up with anyone who is going to trash her or mess with her reputation. He told Jessi that jealousy is toxic. Dawson feels that Jessi needs to get out of this relationship because this guy has now shown her his true self and he has a lot of growing up to do.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Heart Is Hurting, Guy Moving On</b>            Rene met a guy a year ago. They instantly hit it off and got in to a "friends with benefits" situation. They had a mutual understanding that they would never be more than that, but Rene always had a secret hope that it would become something more. Now he is talking to another girl and is very open about it. Dawson said that he has already given her up, now it is up to Rene how long she will allow her heart to stay involved and how much more hurt she will be. He said she needs to stop now.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Hit And Killed A Pedestrian</b>            Raina was driving and hit a pedestrian who died instantly. The cops have told her it was not her fault and she was not charged with the accident. Raina said that now she has a lot of fears. Dawson told Raina that these things are going to take time, because it is a process of healing. He told Raina to make sure she doesn't make the healing longer by sabotaging the process and telling herself negative things. Dawson said in time this can help her grow in to a better person.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Can't Seem To Get Family's Support</b>            Alex has been dealing with depression and having suicidal thoughts. Alex lost his job of 7 years about a month ago. Alex's mom said he is old enough to deal with this on his own and said she can't help him. Alex isn't sure what to do because he can't seem to get his families support. Dawson said that what his mother said is a statement of abandonment, and he feels that Alex's deep-rooted issues likely come from these issues of trauma with his family. He recommended that Alex find another "family" to connect with for support.</p>

<p>Relationship Self-Harm Family Stress</p>	<p>7/19/15</p>	<p>108</p>	<p>Hour 1</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Wants To Make Things Right With Ex</b> Caitlyn is dating someone else, but wants to get back with her ex and make things right with him before he leaves for boot camp this fall. Dawson told Caitlyn that she needs to admit the confusion in her heart to the guys in her life, and recommended taking several months for her head to clear and take a break from this revolving door of relationships. He told Caitlyn that she is dealing with love addiction and needs to make a change.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Friend Is Self-Harming</b> Zoe's friend was cutting herself. When Zoe noticed it she talked to her about it and it hasn't happened in a while, but recently Zoe noticed she started cutting again. When Zoe asked her about it, she said that she was depressed. Zoe's friend says she is going to counseling. Dawson told Zoe that this situation is way more than she can handle. He also recommended being there for her friend but still encouraging her friend to be honest about what is happening.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Man Who Raised Him Is His Step Dad</b> John recently found out that the man that raised him is really his step dad. John now knows that his biological dad is a different man, who was abusive to his mom. John is wondering if he should try to connect with his biological dad. Dawson said that John knows upfront that his biological dad is very troubled, and if he decides to meet him, he needs to prepare for the worst. He also advised that John not do this alone, but bring someone with him when he does this. Dawson told John not to rush in to this decision, and to take some time to talk it over with his mom and think through if this is something he wants to do.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Concerned About Youth Group</b> Ted is a dedicated member of his church youth group. He is concerned because the other students in his youth group will get high, drink, and have sex. Ted doesn't feel they belong there. Ted says that spiritually he is getting something out of it, but this activity bothers him. He said that the youth minister also gets drunk. Dawson recommended that Ted go to the Senior Pastor of the church and let him know about these issues that are happening. If that doesn't work, Dawson recommends that Ted find another youth group to go to.</p>
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<p>Family Abuse Grief Grief</p>	<p>7/19/15</p>	<p>118</p>	<p>Hour 2</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Dad Was Cheating, Parents Divorcing</b> Chrislyn's parents are getting divorced. Her dad has been cheating but her mom has always been there for her. Now she is trying to figure out which parent she should live with. Dawson said that Chrislyn needs to be in a situation where she is stable and familiar, and will not be uprooted from her life. Dawson told Chrislyn that this is not her fault, and this is something her dad is going to have to come to terms with.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Date Raped During Finals</b> Amanda was date raped a few months ago when she was finishing college. Amanda was in the middle of finals and brushed it off at the time, but now realizes what happened to her. Amanda specifically told him she did not want to have intercourse, but he started getting physically aggressive and she finally stopped fighting him. Dawson said that filing a police report doesn't hurt, and they could give her advice on next steps to take as well as a lawyer who could help her decide if she should take it further.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Friend Showing Off And Wrecked</b> Samuel was in a car wreck a few weeks ago. He says the driver was showing off and ended up rolling the truck that they were in. Of the 5 in the truck, one died and one person has to learn to walk all over again. Although Samuel isn't physically hurt, he feels emotionally unable to discuss it when people bring it up. Samuel feels very angry with the guy who was driving. Dawson encouraged Samuel that he will get through this, and that it will take time. Dawson told Samuel there is no rush in this, and this was a major lesson for him in the brevity of life.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Saw Best Friend Murdered By Brother</b> Samuel witnessed his best friend get murdered by his brother. They were playing a card game and all of a sudden Samuel's brother got up and put a sword through his best friend's heart. Samuel just ran from the apartment. Samuel has to go to court because he witnessed this. Samuel says he is not a religious man but says he believes in the power of prayer. Dawson told Samuel that prayer does work and Samuel has nothing to lose. He told Samuel to tell the truth about what he saw in court. And take this one-day at a time.</p>

Dawson feels that Jessi needs to get out of this relationship because this guy has now shown her his true self.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Friends With Benefits Situation</b> Rene met a guy a year ago. They instantly hit it off and got in to a "friends with benefits" situation. Rene always had a secret hope that it would become something more. Now he is talking to another girl and is very open about it. Dawson said that he has already given her up, and now it is up to Rene how long she will allow her heart to stay involved and how much more hurt she will be. He said she needs to stop now and count her blessings that there is not a child in the mix.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Thinks Boyfriend Found Someone Else</b> Brittany and her ex dated and after the first six months of their relationship he moved to Florida for graduate school. He started not responding to her texts and calls on the weekends. Brittany asked him for an explanation but he isn't giving her one. She feels she needs some closure in order to move on. Dawson said that he agrees that he has found someone else, and he feels that Brittany's boyfriend is gone. He recommended that Brittany get closure by taking a sabbatical from dating to get really healed before she moves on.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Mom Stolen Money From Him</b> Nick's mom has made some bad financial decisions. She has stolen money from Nick and used his credit cards without his permission. Nick says that this has really hurt their relationship. He recently moved out on his own and his mom was recently evicted, but he recently found out that she used his credit card again. Nick wants to still have a relationship with her but isn't sure he can. Dawson told Nick that he can still love her, pray for her, and start going through the process of forgiving her.</p>
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<p>Spiritual Relationship Relationship Abuse</p>	<p>7/26/15</p>	<p>118</p>	<p>Hour 2</p>	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Tries To Be A Good Person</b> Hunter isn't religious but he does try to be a good person. Because of this he has lost many relationships with friends, family, and even girls he likes. Hunter went to Christian school his whole life, and he is afraid that because he doesn't believe in God it makes him a bad person. Dawson said that when you measure yourself up against God's standard we are all bad people. He advised Hunter to pray and ask God to show Him if He is really there.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Been in Relationships Based On Lies</b> Seth was in a relationship that was based on lies. This trend has continued. Seth's friends have been really supportive, and one girl in particular has been reaching out. Seth is supposed to go visit her tonight but he has a panic attack thinking about what her intentions could be. He told Landon that it is a blessing that he found out that she was like this before they got married. He advised Landon to move on and to talk it out with the people close to him.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Listening To The Show Helped Him</b> Brett's best friend committed suicide about three years ago. He listens to the show every week and he said that listening to the show helped to see him through this time. He encourages many friends who are struggling to listen to the show.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Feels He Can't Get His Life Together</b> Ryan owns and runs his own construction company at 20 years old. Ryan said construction is a difficult industry and when deadlines aren't met it impacts your payment. He has 40 guys who depend on him for her livelihood but he can't even seem to get his own life together. He is only getting 3 or 4 hours of sleep at night, and he can't seem to stop drinking. Dawson said that he needs to go to AA and get help, which will be hard for Ryan to do. He told Ryan that if he doesn't get his own life in order, everything else will come tumbling down. Dawson also told Ryan that he needs to find a mentor, not only to help with the business, but for accountability with his alcohol addiction.</p>

Dawson also recommended that Eric get some counseling, and reminded him to not let the shame of what he has done derail him.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Having Some Issues With Loved Ones</b>  Steven was recently diagnosed with PTSD. He is a full time fireman, and is having some issues with his family, as well as his girlfriend. Steven doesn't feel like himself anymore, he lashes out in anger and doesn't sleep at night. Last year he was hurt in a fire and hospitalized and she was by his side. Tonight they had a big argument and Steven stormed out of the house. Dawson said his relationships with God and family have to be #1 and #2 in his life. He advised Steven to reassure her of his love for her, and that he knows that he needs to do something to fix what has been going on.</p>

He said that Kylee's dad needs to jump through some hoops.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Single Mom To A One Year Old Son</b>          Sarah is a single mom to a one-year-old son. Before she got pregnant she had a whole bunch of friends but now she doesn't. Sarah says that she gets lonely sometimes. Sarah's first daughter was taken by DHS when she was 9 months old. Sarah says that she learns from her mistakes, and she even gets to talk to her daughter occasionally. Sarah wants to encourage the single moms out there to not try being popular but to remember that their children are looking up to them. Dawson said it sounds like she has grown and like she is headed down the right path at this point.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Husband Is Abusive To Her</b>          Kristina's husband got kicked out of the military for domestic violence. He is physically and sexually abusive to her. Kristina says that he gets on top of her and covering her mouth so she can't breathe. Kristina says that everything she has tried doesn't work, and her family is telling her that they need to go to counseling. She said that he assaulted her earlier today. Dawson said at this point him and the staff would need to get involved because a crime had been committed.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Battling Depression For Years</b>          James has been battling depression for a few years. He was in a relationship that ended and was very traumatic. She broke up with him via text message while he was out of the country. James birth mother left him when he was three. Dawson said she probably didn't cause the depression but maybe triggered it. He feels that James' birth mother left him feeling rejected and that may be the root issue. Dawson said until he can deal with the deep abandonment issues, James should not pursue finding a relationship, because he will continue to bring his wounds into any relationship.</p>

He advised Anita that the best thing she can do for her marriage and her son is to completely break off any ties with her ex.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Hit And Killed A Pedestrian</b> Raina was driving and hit a pedestrian who died instantly. The cops have told her it was not her fault and she was not charged with the accident or anything like that. Raina said that now she has a lot of fear when driving, and is trying to get past the fear and the nightmares. Dawson told Raina that these things are going to take time, because it is a process of healing. He told Raina to make sure she doesn't make the healing longer by sabotaging the process and telling herself negative things.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Lost His Job, Dealing With Depression</b> Alex has been dealing with depression and having suicidal thoughts. Alex lost his job of 7 years about a month ago. Alex's mom said he is old enough to deal with this on his own and said she can't help him. Dawson said that what his mother said is a statement of abandonment, and he feels that Alex's deep-rooted issues likely come from these issues of trauma with his family. He recommended that Alex find another "family" to connect with for support.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Husband Overdosed In Front Of Kids</b> Derrica husband's sister died and he coped with it by taking pills and overdosing in front of her and their children. They took him to the hospital and he survived. Derrica made him move in with his dad after that. At this point he isn't trying to get any help with his grief, personality disorder, or chemical imbalance. Dawson told Derrica that when you get together so young, after six years you are not the same person you were at first. He said it also sounds like he is mentally disturbed. Dawson said that he has to really want to help himself and deal with his issues before Derrica could let him back in the house..</p>

Her mom and her mom's boyfriend are separated but he's still around. Tiffany has to practically hide to not start an argument with him. Dawson advised her to move out. He told Tiffany she is not responsible for her mom's life. He told her to tell her mom she still loves her and wants to be part of her life; but, she is 20 and needs to get on with her life. Dawson stated that mom should have stepped up and took up for her.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Wife Cheated, Wants A Divorce</b> Joe's wife cheated on him twice. He felt committed to her and she said she was sorry and it would never happen again. Joe decided he couldn't stay with his wife due to trust issues. He filed for divorce and she will be getting served the papers tomorrow morning and he is feeling guilty. Joe wants to feel like it is not his fault and Dawson told him it was everyone's fault. Dawson advised that they just stay separated and the timing for the divorce was not good with a new baby and he felt Joe might not be sure if he is guilty.</p>
