Relationship Relationship School Family	1/5/14	10P	Hour 3	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Dating A Man From Craig's List</b> Callie has been seeing a man who she has met on Craig's List, who has told her he is legally separated. However, she has recently found out that they have just started the process with the lawyers and nothing legally binding has been done yet. Callie sees that he is often still at his wife's home. She wants to know if she should believe him or if she should see these things as red flags. Dawson said this man seems to be a liar. She needs to get out of the relationship right away.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Slept With Boyfriend's Best Friend</b> Hayley turned 18 on Friday night. Her boyfriend was out of town. Her boyfriend didn't want her to be alone on her birthday, so he told her to hang out with his best friend. She went to his house and long story short, they drank a little and she ended up cheating on her boyfriend. She isn't that kind of person and doesn't want to ruin the relationship. Dawson said it is too late for that. She needs to come clean with her boyfriend and deal with it.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Follow Dreams Or Stay Local?</b> Rebecca has questions about college. She can go to a college close to home or she can go to college far away from home and follow her dreams. Dawson said to follow your dreams but use wisdom; she needs to have a support system. Rebecca said she is an artist. If she goes to college locally she can be a graphic designer or she can go away and be a comic book artist. Dawson said you should go for your dreams; the worst that can happen is to go there and end up moving back.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Scared Dad Will Choose Girl Over Her</b> Lauren's dad is seeing a woman and she is scared that he is going to choose this woman over her and her brother. Dawson said when he seems to choose the girlfriend over her, she needs to tell him she loves and respects him but that this hurts her. Dawson recommends they get back in to family counseling, and that Lauren needs someone to walk through her with this to talk through it.</p>

Stress Medical Grief Family	1/5/14	11P	Hour 4	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Was Living In Car For 8 Months</b> Nicole has been living in her car with her husband, children, and dog for the past 8 months. She called the Hope Line last week and spoke to Morgan. Since then her and her husband have put their money together and gotten to a hotel, which is warm and comfortable for her children. The show has given her hope and she knows she is not alone. Dawson said he can't imagine being in that position but he knows there is always hope and it sounds like she is beginning to turn things around.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Dad Had Seizure, Hospitalized</b> Jamie woke up last week to her mom shouting her dad's name over and over. She ran in to the room and found out her dad was having a seizure. Jamie's dad is doing well at this point- he is up, talking, and eating. When they took him to the E.R. they had to put him on a respirator. Dawson said when something like this happens it is a reminder to spend more time with your father because life is fleeting. He also said that she should tell him how much she appreciates him.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Grandmother Passed Away</b> Tayler's grandmother passed away this morning. Her grandmother taught her everything about being a woman, brought her to church, and was a big part of her life. Dawson said that God, in his grace, has taken her out of her confusion. Tayler regrets not spending as much time with her in the end. Dawson said he would let that go, comfort herself with how much she loved her and the fact that recently she wouldn't have remembered it anyway.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Father Took Out Loans In Her Name</b> Claire recently found out that that her adopted father took out \$13,000 of loans in her name that she is responsible for. Claire loves her dad but he cusses her out whenever they talk. Dawson said yes, she can and should forgive him, but stay away from him because he is a thief. Claire feels like he has written her off in his life. Dawson said you can still forgive him without letting them walk all over her.</p>

Family Family Relationship Suicide	1/12/14	10P	Hour 3	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Been Fighting Often With Father</b> Leah's father raised her, but for the past year they have fought more and more, until she ended up moving in with her mom. Since then, he has been very distant. Dawson reminded Leah that the fact he showed up shows he is making somewhat of an effort and may be capable of doing more through time. Dawson said to continue communicating with her father and thanking him for what he has done for her.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Parents Want His Daughter Adopted Out</b> Jonathan was in a loving relationship for nearly 4 years, but recently lost his fiancé to a drunk driver. He has a 4 year old daughter. Jonathan's parents are saying they would prefer that his daughter be adopted by a two-parent family rather than staying with him, and having to travel and be in day care because he is in the military. Dawson said this sounds very destructive to his daughter. Dawson recommended he look for a "support family" at his church who can help care for her while he is away in the military.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Girl He's Seeing, Needs Space</b> Paul has been seeing a girl for a few weeks. After going out for her birthday, he left and she got in to a fight with her sister and hasn't spoken to him for 48 hours. He got a text tonight apologizing for blowing him off the last few days and said she "is going through some things mentally" and "needs her space." Dawson advised Paul that it sounds like it went too fast and she is not ready to be in a serious relationship. Dawson said to let her know that he has received the message that he needs more space, and then he should walk away.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Cheated On Boyfriend, Self-Harming</b> Naomi has cheated on her boyfriend, and she turned to drugs to help her feel better. Naomi and her boyfriend have broken up, but he said he forgives her. Naomi is very hard on herself and carries a lot of guilt. Naomi is afraid she may get to a point where she may attempt suicide. Dawson said this is not something that can be solved alone. Dawson also said that she should realize that if God, and her boyfriend, can forgive her she needs to forgive herself.</p>

Positive Abuse Pregnancy Positive	1/12/14	11P	Hour 4	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Thank You For Helping</b> Tessa got in a fight with her family a few years ago due to some changes in medication and health challenges, and shortly after she found Dawson's show for the first time. Things in her life continued to spiral downward to the point that she began using meth and attempted suicide. She was able to contact someone from the Hope Line using chat, and shortly after she was admitted to a hospital where she was able to recover and her health issues were resolved. Tessa was calling to thank Dawson.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Celibate, Boyfriend Raped Her</b> Tina was sexually abused for four years, and this stopped about eight years ago. As a result she has been celibate for the last couple of years. Tina thought her boyfriend understood why, but he ended up raping her. Tina wonders how she cannot allow the abuse of her past impact her future relationships. Dawson said she does not need to let the past define her. Tina needs to recover and needs to find people who have "been there" to help her deal with this.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Girlfriend Pregnant, Has Scholarship</b> Brantley's girlfriend got pregnant unexpectedly. His girlfriend's parents are insisting that she go to college and take advantage of her scholarship. As of now: she, Brantley and the baby plan to move to Florida together and Brantley will work to support them while she goes to college. Dawson believes that what is best for the baby long term is for her to get an education. Dawson recommended that Brantley speak to her parents and apologize for the situation and submit to them as the authority in their daughter's life. Dawson said until they get married, Brantley is the third priority, with the first being the baby and the second being his girlfriend.</p> <p><b>TITLE: From Homeless To Enrolling In College</b> Chelsey said that listening to Dawson's show has helped to impact her life in the past year. Chelsey went from being homeless to now enrolling in college and wanted to thank Dawson for the show that encouraged her to believe in herself and not give up.</p>

Positive Relationship Family	1/19/14	108	Hour 3	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Was Suicidal But Life Getting Better</b>  Rebecca's parents got divorced when she was 15. It turned her world upside down and she began to turn to her last resort, which was suicide. Her grandfather stepped in and saved the day. She wants people listening to know that things get better, and suicide doesn't have to be their answer. Rebecca said her life has gotten better, she is graduated high school and started college and life is getting better.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Insecure, Boyfriend Acting Standoffish</b>  Shanna has had several bad relationships in the past. Shanna said she is a very insecure person when it comes to relationships. Shanna currently has a wonderful man who just got out of the service and has PTSD. Shanna said he has been standoffish for the last few days. She isn't sure how to handle this. Dawson recommended he needs to get professional help, and she needs to let him know that she loves him and is there for him. Shanna wants to know how she gets past her insecurity and not allow this to affect her. Dawson said she needs to get help because she is suffering as well, and she can take this time to work on herself.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Discovered Bitterness Towards Mom</b>  Maya is a Human Services major in college. In class, they were discussing personal wellness and Maya realized that she has a lot of bitterness toward her mother from things that happened in her childhood. Maya feels it is affecting her current relationships. Dawson said bitterness can be carried from relationship to relationship. Maya says that when she tells her fiancé about her past with her mother, he becomes bitter toward her mother as well. Dawson said he is getting angry because he wants peace, and she doesn't need to tell him every issue that she has with her mother. Dawson said first, Maya needs to work on herself. Dawson recommended that she get help in dealing with her bitterness with her mother. Dawson said she is an adult now and has gained some insights in to herself and can work with a counselor on these issues.</p>

Bullying Anger Pregnancy Positive	1/19/14	11P	Hour 4	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Bullied And Called Obese In School</b>  Shannon has been called horrible names in school. She has been bullied and called obese. Shannon said she has tried everything and it's in her families genes. Dawson said we do want to work on the obesity but there is deep low self-esteem. Shannon feels like it is her fault. Dawson said you are lovable; you are articulate and kind so for you to go around shaming yourself then that's not what God wants for you.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Dad Beat His Mom, Angry For 7 Years</b>  Douglas said when he was 16 years old; he was doing the teenager thing and ran away. His mom called him and told him that her dad had beat and raped her and she wanted him to come home. Douglas went home to see his dad punching his mom. He has been so angry at his dad. Dawson said we are not going to make excuses for this man but we are not going to nurse along this hatred anymore. On your part, you need to get to the point where you can say I want you to have a good life to your dad and mean it.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Pregnant But Boyfriend Acting Distant</b>  Paige has been dating her boyfriend for 3 years and he is in the Marines. She recently found out she was pregnant and she felt happy about it. Paige hasn't told her boyfriend that she is pregnant yet, and he has been acting distant to her. Paige has been hearing that he has been cheating on her. Dawson told Paige to ask herself what is best for the baby. Paige fears that he will break up with her. Dawson said that could happen, and it is painful, but we have to find out where he stands because there is a baby to support.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Calling Into Show Was Best Decision</b>  Jonathan is in the military, and his fiancé passed away and his parents wanted him to give his 4 year old daughter up for adoption, but Jonathan did not want to. Last week, Dawson advised him to go to his pastor with the situation. Jonathan went to church the following week and within 10 minutes after the service a family volunteered to help him with his daughter when he has to travel. Jonathan said he feels wonderful and can sleep better now that he doesn't have to make the decision to give up his daughter. Jonathan said that calling last week and getting Dawson's advice was the best decision of his life.</p>

Addiction Relationship Suicidal Pregnancy	1/26/14	10P	Hour 3	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Trying To Get Clean From Drugs</b> Sarah was recently put in the hospital because she had a cyst rupture and they were able to save her. She has been clean from drug abuse for about three weeks now. Sarah said it is getting hard because of the ex-boyfriend that she was with while she was on drugs. He has been contacting her even though she moved away from him. Dawson said that if she gets back with him, she will get back on drugs. He recommends changing her phone number or whatever she needs to do to keep him from getting back in her life.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Girlfriend Using Drugs, Drinking</b> Justus tried to stop his girlfriend from drinking and using drugs with her friends. Justus' girlfriend tried to play it off like it wasn't a big deal, and when he tried to prevent her from doing it, she broke up with him. Dawson said that she sees Justus and is reminded that she is doing wrong. Justus told her that even though things are over that if she ever finds herself drunk and needs a way home to call him. Dawson said that is fine, but don't do it too many times or he could become an enabler.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Tried To Kill Himself By Flipping Car</b> Austin recently tried to kill himself by flipping his car, but he walked away from that incident without a scratch. Austin doesn't know what to do, and has started cutting. Austin's parents have been fighting a lot and then began getting angry with him. He and his sister have also been arguing. Dawson said none of these things are reasons to kill yourself. Dawson said it sounds like someone was looking out after him, but he is running out of chances, and he doesn't know if the next time might be the last time.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Pregnant, Boyfriend Uses Drugs</b> Emily found out she was pregnant 3 months ago. She was excited at first because she wasn't sure she could have children. Her boyfriend knows. He smoked pot for the first bit that we were together but then she found out he was in heavier drugs. He lost his mom and it sent him into a downward spiral. She is worried that with her hormones going crazy and the stress of the pregnancy he may go back to drugs. Dawson said, what about the baby? The negativity could affect the baby. Dawson said you are focusing on him and not focusing on being healthy with the baby.</p>

Relationship Stress Relationship Family	1/26/14	118	Hour 4	<p>Dawson spoke to the following young people about their issues:</p> <p><b>TITLE: Ex Rather Stay With Mom Than Get Job</b> Amanda has been depressed because she broke up with her boyfriend. Dawson said she has done the right thing, but doing the right thing isn't always the easiest thing. Amanda said he would rather stay with his mother for the rest of his life than get a job. Dawson said she will look back in a few years and remember this night as the beginning of healing.to guard her heart.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Panic Attacks Have Increased</b> Mariah's father committed suicide when she was 13. Mariah was diagnosed with depression and PTSD which manifests in panic attacks. Mariah's mom is battling liver failure and she is her mom's primary care giver. This has caused her anxiety to increase and her panic attacks are becoming more frequent. Dawson recommended that she find a counselor who can help her deal with all of this.</p> <p>Dawson said that she has to come up with a plan to find someone to help her watch for the triggers so she can prevent the panic attacks.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Ex Promised He Has Changed</b> Elizabeth ended up having a miscarriage. Shortly after that she found out her boyfriend was cheating on her, and the broke up. Now her ex-boyfriend has gotten back in touch with her and is apologizing and promising not to make the same mistakes again. Elizabeth believes he is sincere in his apology but is concerned that he will eventually go back to his old ways. Dawson said that only time will tell, and she needs to guard her heart. Dawson recommends she tell him she is still healing and needs more time.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Might Cut Mom Out Of Her Life</b> Morgan believes her mom is schizophrenic and she has been contemplating cutting her out of her life. Morgan has begged and pleaded with her mother to stop doing these hurtful things and asked her to be truthful with them. Dawson recommended that Morgan go to a counselor as well. Dawson relayed the story of his son's car accident and that he has traumatic brain injury and is paralyzed. Dawson said he can no more ask his son to run around the block than she can ask her mother to get better. Dawson said that Morgan needs to make her mother a part of her life, but not all of her life, and that she needs to learn to talk to her mother where she is at.</p>

Lauren doesn't know how she is going to explain this to her daughter. Dawson said to call the guy "birth" daddy, and say that he has problems that are not about you. Lauren needs to make it clear that he left both of them, not just her, but that there are many people who love her.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Might Get Brother Out of State Custody</b> Nicole was in foster care and her 12-year-old half-brother is in a treatment facility right now. Nicole would like to get him out of state custody, and it would be a huge commitment for her to care for him. Dawson said this is going to be very all consuming for her, and she will need to count the cost of doing this. Dawson said she needs to get a lot of advice from people and that she probably can't anticipate all that will go in to caring for him.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Dad Physically Abusive To Her Mom</b> Cianna's dad is physically abusive to her mother to the point where she has had to be hospitalized multiple times. Cianna is concerned about her younger brothers who are still living at home. Dawson said since her mom and dad are adults she has to ask what can she realistically do. He said her dad needs to experience tough love. Moving home at this point would be a mistake, but see if she can encourage him to go to AA. Dawson also suggested she contact child protective services and see if they will give advice or get involved.</p>

Dawson said not to make a commitment at this point, but to buy some time by getting both of them an opportunity to talk to someone like a counselor or a chaplain.</p> <p><b>TITLE: New Step-Mom Intruding On Her Life</b> Kaylee's dad recently got remarried to a woman she doesn't know at all. Kaylee said her new step mom is trying to intrude on her personal life. Dawson said it sounds like her new step mom is trying too hard and not giving her the time she needs to adjust. Dawson recommends that Kaylee sit down and talk with her about how she is feeling. He also suggested meeting with a counselor or minister to talk through her feelings.</p> <p><b>TITLE: He Has Changed From Party Lifestyle</b> Grant said throughout high school and into college he took all different type of drugs and was living the party lifestyle. There was a point in college that he was considering suicide. Grant has been listening to the show and one night he started "really listening" to what Dawson had to say. Grant has now been clean for 9 months and his life is turned around. Grant said that a lot of it is due to listening to Dawson's show, and because of his relationship with Jesus.</p>

Dawson recommended that Ayah go to the police and the first thing she needs to do is to be removed from the situation. Dawson said he is going to help her find people in her area who will help her.</p> <p><b>TITLE: No One Takes Him Seriously</b>  Jacob feels alone. Jacob has an eating disorder, as well as alcohol and drug addiction, and no one has taken him seriously about it. Jacob is starting to experience some serious medical symptoms he believes are related to these issues. Jacob went to a doctor Friday afternoon and said that due to bulimia he will not survive much longer. Jacob is going to try to talk to his parents but is afraid they won't take him seriously. Dawson sent him to the hope coaches for further counseling.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Girlfriend Cut Her Wrists</b>  Nathaniel's girlfriend lives in Texas who has been having trouble with her family, and after one night of arguing with her mother she tried to cut her wrist. Nathaniel's girlfriend recently got out of a mental hospital following this incident. Dawson said he has to be loving, kind, a good listener, and gently and firmly confront her.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Friends Or More Than Friends?</b>  Jessica was dating a guy for about a month and they made a mutual decision to break up, but Jessica still had feelings for him. He keeps going back and forth with saying he likes her as a friend or more than a friend. Dawson said the fact that he is trying to keep her confused while he continues to explore the options of other girls. Natalie said that eating is an area of her life that she can control and make decisions. Dawson said it sounds like she is looking for control in an area. He also said that many counselors tie eating disorders to relationships with a mother. He recommended that it is time for Natalie to talk to a minister or counselor, because not taking care of herself physically will eventually catch up with her.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Parents Didn't Know She Was Dating</b> Kristina broke up with her boyfriend earlier this week. However, Kelly is concerned that her fiancé is not being truthful with her and she isn't sure if their relationship is going to last. Kelly feels the story changes and grows all the time. Dawson said this story sounds fishy and that it sounds like if he is a liar, he needs some help to figure out why he made up this story.</p>

After going out for her birthday, he left and she got in to a fight with her sister and hasn't spoken to him for 48 hours. He got a text tonight apologizing for blowing him off the last few days and said she "is going through some things mentally" and "needs her space." Dawson advised Paul that it sounds like it went too fast and she is not ready to be in a serious relationship.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Cheated On Boyfriend, Self-Harming</b> Naomi has cheated on her boyfriend and turned to drugs to help her feel better. Naomi and her boyfriend have broken up, but he said he forgives her. Naomi carries a lot of guilt. Naomi is afraid she may get to a point where she may attempt suicide. Dawson said this is not something that can be solved alone. Dawson also said that she should to realize that if God, and her boyfriend, can forgive her she needs to forgive herself.</p>

Paige hasn't told her boyfriend that she is pregnant yet, and he has been acting distant to her. Paige has been hearing that he has been cheating on her. Dawson told Paige to ask herself what is best for the baby. Paige fears that he will break up with her. Dawson said that could happen, and it is painful, but we have to find out where he stands because there is a baby to support.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Calling Into Show Was Best Decision</b> Jonathan is in the military, and his fiancé passed away and his parents wanted him to give his 4 year old daughter up for adoption. Last week, Dawson advised him to go to his pastor with the situation. Jonathan went to church the following week and within 10 minutes after the service a family volunteered to help him with his daughter when he has to travel. She does not want to bring the pain that her friends brought to her to other people in her life. Dawson said you have not been able to uncouple it; the cloud is hanging over your head and raining every day. We need to work one on one on each of these crises.</p>

They broke up the other day. She accused him of cheating on her. She has been physically and verbally abusive to Devon. He fails every time he tries to fix the relationship. Dawson said first fight for the kids, next time she hits you then call the cops so there will be a record of it. She sounds very troubled and extremely angry. Dawson said I doubt you will be able to rescue her.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Abuse From Mom And Brother</b> Kris is experiencing physical abuse from his brother and verbal abuse from his mother. He talked to his dad about leaving the house and his mom found out. He has tried talking to counselors but his mom always finds a way to explain away his claims. Dawson said wherever there is abuse you should cut yourself loose. I don't know all the plans it would take to get out of there and get to your dads but you need to get to a counselor and make plans and go to your dad's house.</p> <p><b>TITLE: Dragged Into The Middle Of Fights</b> Rebecca's mom and dad have been getting in really bad arguments and they drag Rebecca into the middle of it. Her brother went into the Navy about a 1 ½ years ago and the rest of her siblings have disabilities so her family has put a lot of pressure on her. She feels like she is not able to dig out of the hole she's in. Dawson said you are not a counselor; you are not an adult. Dawson said you need to go to your pastor and tell him you need his help with your parents. Tell him everything and let him be the referee and the counselor at the same time.</p>

Phoenix recently told her mom she is cutting herself. She has been cutting for 2 years. Dawson says you should stay with your mom until you all move.
