Mil Mujeres is a non-profit organization that was founded in 2007 to address the growing need for bilingual services for the Latino community in the United States with an emphasis on helping survivors of violent crimes including domestic violence, sexual assault, and assault. In the last fourteen years, they have helped more than five thousand people with our legal services and more than twenty thousand people without information services throughout the national territory. This organization also helps men who are going through domestic violence as they are just as important to voice. Usually, in the Latino community, they aren't aware of the legal services that are available to them and that is why they want to push out this information regardless of their citizen status. Everyone has rights and that is why in this program they are discussing the first step you need to do, like have a police report, to break silence and voice what you are going through. Tatiana, is dedicated to helping people like her, she came from Colombia and has been here for 16 years and didn't know about all the information available to help people in these situations.

Awareness of not leaving a child inside the car during the hot months of May, June, and July the national administration of traffic safety urges every parent to be more careful. Make sure you put your bag, briefcase, or something in the backseat to remind you of the child seating there. Every child under 14 years old may run the risk of being left behind. The temperature raises quickly inside an automobile, and it could cause death. It is our responsibility as adults to look out for the safety of children.

According to the new legislation once a fetal heartbeat has been detected (typically around the 6th week of pregnancy) abortion is not allowed, it's prohibited. No exceptions are made for cases of rape or incest. Some exceptions can be made in cases where the pregnancy is endangering the mother's life or long-term health. As of September 1, 2021, abortion is illegal. They are trying to raise awareness to be able to avoid this procedure.

The guest is speaking about events that have been canceled due to COVID and Dallas Casa is usually very connected to the community, and they are trying to work around that. Dallas Casa protects children, restores childhoods, and helps child victims of abuse and neglect achieve their full potential. Dallas CASA was impacted a lot by COVID, so they tried to find ways to still be able to work and help these children, usually, they can meet with the kids in person but because of COVID, they were able to use ZOOM to conduct interviews. It was very difficult because behind a screen abuse can be hidden very well vs. in person, you get more of a feel if there is or isn't any abuse. Now they are really pushing for Bilingual volunteers to sign up to be able to go to court and translate for the parents who may not speak English. There is also an event taking place in July. It is called the "parade of playhouses" usually big companies take part in this event and donate playhouses for children, then Dallas Casa puts them up in a raffle and tickets are usually \$5 to enter that way kids can win a playhouse to take home! It is usually done at the North Park

Mall. These houses can really make a kid happy and change their life. Which is the mission for Dallas Casa.
