"Beverly's Birthdays" was founded 5 years ago by Megs Yunn. Megs met a young girl named Beverly, who told Megs that she had never had a birthday party before, not even a slice of birthday cake on her birthday. Megs Yunn did some thinking and some research, "Beverly's Birthdays" was born in February of 2012. "Beverly's Birthdays" currently partners with agencies across the Pittsburgh region, many shelters and housing programs for families experiencing homelessness. They also work with group homes, residential treatment facilities, food banks and human service agencies. Again, "Beverly's Birthdays" provides birthday parties for children who otherwise wouldn't have them because of their families unfortunate circumstances. Homelessness, lack of finances, incarceration of 1 or both parents, drugs/alcohol issues with 1 or both of the parents...

The Vincentian Collaborative System (VCS) operates 3 senior care facilities here in the Pittsburgh area, the Vincentian Home in McCandless, Marian Manor in Greentree and Vincentian de Marillac in Stanton Heights. VCS is a Catholic, not for profit health care and human services organization sponsored by the Sisters of Charity of Nazareth. These 3 senior care facilities offer a continuum of care for more than 500 seniors, including independent living, personal care, short-term rehabilitation and skilled nursing. VCS also operates Vincentian Villa in the North Hills, an independent living community. Plus VCS operates 2 child care centers that provides millions of dollars of benevolent care annually. When the residents' funds are gone, the residents are not turned away. They're not turned away.
