IRS agents staffed telephone lines over the weekend to help taxpayers with any last-minute issues, and there are ways to obtain additional time. As of last week, the IRS had processed more than 100 million tax returns. The average refund was \$2,851 this year, up 1.9 percent from last year. About 92 percent of tax returns were submitted electronically.
