It's a triangle where you have a thesis, the opposite corner is an antithesis, and the corner is a synthesis. The thesis is the starting point where everyone's getting along. That becomes the new starting point. This involves looking at the various economic, religious, and social issues labeling some as victims and others as oppressors in order to pit them against each other. Once they're pitted, a group or individual usurps power. Under Communism, the original use of this was to pit the bourgeoisie or the working class vs. business owners. Eventually it became the poor against the rich and the Catholics vs. Protestants or Muslims vs. Christians. In the end, this theory is basically about introducing chaos to the body politic.</p> <p>President Lincoln recognized this problem when he talked about how a house divided against itself cannot stand. He was referring to Mark 3:24 where Jesus noted that if a kingdom is divided against itself, it cannot stand.</p> <p>Fast forward many decades later and we have a man named Saul Alinsky. He communicated that the final goal of the organization is community disorganization, rubbing raw the resentments of the people within the community. Are you beginning to see a historic pattern here? There's more to this as William also discusses the concept of "gaslighting." As you learn the rest, you'll see the connection to false flags and the consolidation of control. 12/5	Communist China’s Growing Threat	Jim Schneider/ Alex Newman	<p>Alex Newman is an award-winning international freelance journalist, author, researcher, educator and editor for The New American and contributes to other publications as well. He’s author of <i>Crimes of the State: The Invisible Government Behind the Scenes</i>. He is founder of Liberty Sentinel.</p> <p>From COVID-19 to civilian surveillance to censorship to citizen crackdowns to climate polluter, communist China is egregiously guilty. In spite of all this, it seems to get a “pass,” and at times even accolades, from those in the world government. This is in spite of the fact that they appear to be the #1 polluter in the world.</p> <p>According to Alex, this “pass” that they get shows that the “ringleaders” of the climate change (stop human-caused climate change) movement don’t believe the narrative themselves.</p> <p>What is that narrative and how is China involved? When he was at the 2015 U.N. Climate Summit in Paris, the Obama administration and other Western governments said they were going to drastically reduce their CO₂ emissions. Obama said the U.S. would reduce such emissions by about 30 percent by 2025. Under the policies he implemented, energy prices went up and our energy infrastructure was hobbled. 12/6	Fanning Flames to Worsen Border Crisis	Jim Schneider/ Todd Bensman	<p>America’s border crisis continues to be a huge issue, particularly at the southern border and as it pertains to national security. About 2.4 million encounters have taken place at the U.S./Mexico border in fiscal year 2022. Another 200,000 more and there appears to be no end in sight.</p> <p>We’re in a very dangerous time, even as it pertains to the “lame duck” session where there’s great desperation through, not only on a continuing resolution basis, but also an attempt to pass, without hearing or without a vote, called “The Equal Access to Green Cards for Legal Employment Act of 2022.” (HR3648)</p> <p>Appearing on Crosstalk to address several aspects of the border debate was Todd Bensman. Todd is senior fellow for the Center for Immigration Studies. He’s the author of <i>Overrun: How Joe Biden Unleashed a Border Crisis in U.S. History and America’s Covert Border War: The Untold Story of the Nation’s Battle to Prevent Illegal Infiltration</i>. He formerly worked at the Texas Department of Public Safety’s Intelligence and Counterterrorism Division where he managed teams of intelligence analysts that worked in concert with federal homeland security and U.S. Customs and Border Protection Community agencies to identify and mitigate terrorism threats.</p> <p>Todd began by describing how the Biden administration has discreetly begun a program along the border where Mexicans and Americans collaborate on legalizing immigrants before they cross into the U.S. This is done through governments via what’s known as “CBP-1.” This is an online, secure, DHS platform where all of the necessary information crossing individuals are entered along with their data. The Mexicans are given the secure passcode to the platform to enter that data ahead of time. From there, Mexican immigration loads the individuals onto buses, drives them to the port of entry, and hands them off to the Americans for release into the country. This “humanitarian parole” program provides work authorization for up to one year.</p> <p>Jim responded that this makes the Biden administration appear to be the smuggler as illegal entry is now being legalized. Todd agreed and noted that while we don’t know the numbers, they must be large because the sheer volume of Mexican side are having to expand under pressure due to so many people from around the world that are seeking refuge on the advantage of this. Some are even sleeping in the streets waiting for bed space.</p> <p>Todd described how this program is unfolding all along the land border from the Pacific coast to the Gulf of Mexico being handed off at nearly every port of entry, every day. Randy began by noting that NBC News asked the following question 205 times from 1995 to 2022: Are we on the right track or the wrong track? 93% said that no, things are not on the right track.</p> <p>Looking at this from a generational perspective, "Gen-Z" tends to be the most pessimistic group. Why? Well, the stress as the challenges noted earlier are not simply external issues but issues that are having an effect internally. Randy referenced an American Bible Society survey on stress. The elders (the "Greatest" or "Silent" Generation) ranked highest in stress ranking in the survey. The younger the participants were ("Boomers," "Gen-X," "Millennials," & "Gen-Z") the less stress they communicated. In fact, 1 out of 4 "Gen-Z" members is identified as having a mental disorder. They're self-identifying as having an inability to cope with the world internally.</p> <p>Should we be surprised? Perhaps not when you consider this: The group least likely to read the Bible on a daily basis are white men, only 1 out of 5 church-going people read the Bible daily, and of those that do read it, 17% said they read it and read where their eyes land. Additionally, less than half of all church-going evangelicals have read the Bible even once.</p> <p>Clearly we can and must do better, not just for ourselves but for future generations. God wants us to have a relationship with Him on a daily basis through His Word. It's truth for today, sufficient for every area of life, and we need it. He is a constitutional attorney with three law firms and has argued before the U.S. Supreme Court. He's an author and the host of the radio broadcasts <i>Faith & Freedom</i> and <i>Freedom Daily</i>. The first quarter hour involved Mat's views concerning the latest on the so-called "Respect for Marriage Act" which all 219 Democrats in the House of Representatives wasted no time passing this act which is now on its way to the White House for Biden for his signature.</p> <p>Mat noted that while this has the same-sex portion, it originally opened up the door for polygamy. Marriage is the exclusive union of one man and one woman. It would allow individuals to sue Christians who refuse to participate in same-sex ceremonies. It would jeopardize the ability of Christian adoption agencies to care for children with so-called "married," same-sex couples. It would force all 50 states to recognize any marriage from another state, repeal the Defense of Marriage Act, and endanger the tax exempt status of faith-based nonprofits. -President Biden who has promised to promptly and proudly sign it into law. -Raphael Warnock was declared the winner of the run-off election in Georgia to give Democrats a 51% majority in the Senate. -Arizona Senator Kyrsten Sinema has left the Democratic Party citing increasingly partisan interests and the influence of political parties. She is now registered as an independent. -Elon Musk announced that former FBI attorney James Baker, who came to Twitter to serve as a deputy attorney general, had been fired after vetting recently released evidence of Twitter's election interference unbeknownst to Musk. -Twitter boss Elon Musk has revealed that the most important data from the social media platform's internal records, including free speech suppression, known as the "Twitter Files," was hidden and some may have even been deleted. -"We've never had a family that has influence-pedaled to this degree." That's a remark from Congresswoman Nancy Pelosi in Kentucky. 12/12	The Myth of Settled Science	Jim Schneider/ Jay Seegert	<p>How many times have you heard the phrase: settled science. It’s been used in regard to man-caused climate change, COVID masks, social distancing, and more. We’re told that the debate is over and we must act now because if we will be grave consequences. If you resist or even dare to ask probing questions, you’re labeled a science denier. How should a Christian respond when confronted like this? Joining Jim for discussion on this issue was Jay Seegert, keynote speaker and managing director of The Starting Point Project. He is the author of <i>Creation to Culture</i>, <i>Evolution</i>, and <i>Faith is Not a Four-Letter Word</i>. He also has produced numerous videos. He holds degrees in Mechanical Engineering Technology. He’s a former president of the Creation Science Society of Milwaukee.</p> <p>First of all, what is science? Jay explained that in the Bible, science means knowledge, but it doesn’t mean just knowledge. It is to note that most major areas of science were birthed out of the Christian community. For example: mathematics, calculus, chemistry, computer science, electrodynamics, fluid mechanics, galactic astronomy, gas dynamics, hydraulics, hydrostatics, oceanography, optical mineralogy, paleontology, physical astronomy, thermodynamics, and the scientific method, and many more were founded by Bible-believing Christians.</p> <p>The founders of these fields of study took it for granted that God created everything and since God is a God who is expected to see order in His creation. So a simplistic definition of science would be the search for explanation of the world around us to see how it functions. In other words, what did God do to get these things to work. Since then, the definition has been hijacked. Ruling out the supernatural from the beginning, now it’s been reduced to “natural” explanations for the world around us.</p> <p>With this definition changed, some are misled on their science in sincere efforts to accomplish something good. Others use it as a “club” and an opportunity to beat others into submission to get them to do what you want. Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • They will purposely engage in that which is overly technical in order to avoid push-back. • Elephant Hurling—This involves the use of large, vacuous statements like, “Evolution is an unproven theory proven from every area of science!” These are simply large statements thrown out without evidence. • Appeal to Authority—This is when someone says something must be true because the world says it’s so. • Shaming—This is where people will state that if you don’t believe something or do what you want, you’re obviously a science denier. <p>As you can see, the idea of “settled science” can have a lot of misleading elements attached to it. 12/13	Failure to Treat: Allen Gahl v. Aurora Health Care Inc.	Jim Schneider/ Karen Mueller	<p>According to Worldometer, there have been more than 1.1 million deaths in the U.S. due to COVID-19. How many people have died from COVID vs. how many have died due to the hospital protocols instituted for the treatment of COVID? Also, while people are hospitalized, what role does a healthcare power of attorney play? Hospitals that have denied treatment through drugs such as Ivermectin? Can a hospital be ordered to administer Ivermectin at the request of the family or the person acting as medical power of attorney? On January 17, Karen Mueller will be arguing before the Wisconsin Supreme Court in the case of Allen Gahl v. Aurora Health Care, Inc. Karen is the founder and general counsel for the Amos Center for Justice and Liberty. Allen Gahl is the nephew of, and medical power of attorney for, John Zingsheim. John became the focus of the case in 2021. He was admitted to Aurora Summit Hospital in Waukesha County where he was diagnosed with COVID-19 and to be given Ivermectin, so Allen began requesting that from the hospital, however, they refused. In a two day conference hearing with lawyers, a judge decided that John had a right to get Ivermectin as prescribed by an outside doctor that the family found that could be credentialed, enter the hospital, and administer the Ivermectin. Before the order could be fulfilled, the appellate court intervened and stayed the order on the granting of a writ of habeas corpus. Karen then appealed to the Wisconsin Supreme Court on a bypass request. 12/19	Covid Shot Changing Human Genome	Jim Schneider / Dr. Peter McCullough	<p>It was December 7th, 2022, when Senator Ron Johnson hosted a symposium called, <i>COVID-19 Vaccines: How They Work, and Possible Causes of Injuries</i>. Those that participated in that round-table discussion included scientists and medical professionals who discussed the background of the coronavirus, functionality of the vaccine, the pandemic response, early treatment drugs, adverse reactions, vaccine injuries, and plans for future research. One of the participants at that symposium was Dr. Peter McCullough, a man considered to be among the best in the world on COVID-19. Dr. McCullough is an internist, cardiologist, and epidemiologist managing the cardiovascular complications of the viral infection and the injuries developing after the COVID-19 vaccine. Since the outset of the pandemic, he has been in the medical response to the COVID-19 disaster and published <i>Pathophysiological Basis and Rational Treatment of SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) Infection</i>. This was the first synthesis of sequenced multi-drug treatments for COVID-19 patients infected with COVID-19 in the American Journal of Medicine. He has nearly 700 scientific publications and numerous peer-reviewed publications on the infection and has commented extensively on the media during the COVID-19 crisis. He's testified before numerous legislative bodies and is the Chief Medical Advisor for the American Medical Foundation.</p> <p>This was an information-packed broadcast that opened with Dr. McCullough noting that the current COVID-19 vaccine is not sufficiently safe and effective. In other words, the vaccines have exceeded all boundaries of safety.</p> <p>Dr. McCullough went on to discuss other aspects of this topic as well including how the vaccines appear to be altering the human genome, blood clotting, whether there are any transfusion related complications, vaccine induced deaths, how a person can get the shot out of their body, his recommendations for early COVID intervention, and much more.</p>

12;21	From Islam to Christ	Jim Schneider / Michael Germi	<p>Michael Germi (Gear-me) was born in Iran into a Shia Muslim family, found faith in Jesus Christ and moved to Islamic nations.</p> <p>Michael grew up a year after the revolution in Iran. Under the Shah, Iran was a rich nation, but not long after Khomeini came in 1979, war started breaking out with Iraq. This brought destruction and poverty with that enemies would be coming to Iran.</p> <p>When Michael was six years old, his mother taught him her perspective regarding heaven and hell. She told Michael so that he would start praying. Part of her explanation involved a bridge made up of one thin plank in order to get to heaven. Underneath that bridge is hell-fire. She then told him that if he would pray 5 times a day in Mecca in Arabic, fast at Ramadan, do self-harming, remain committed to Shariah law and follow the strict regulation of Islam, he'd be able to cross that bridge.</p> <p>Then in 2005-2006, the Iranian government contracted with the Australian government to send educated people to Australia. Over one-million people applied for this visa but only 2,000 people obtained one and Michael was one of them. It's during this time he began to notice things wrong with Islam. He wondered why in Iran, Iraq, Afghanistan there's always fighting and killing and no freedom. He also wondered why Christians in Europe and America didn't know God, seem to have freedom and blessings. He began to wonder if perhaps their God is the same as the God of the Review this edition of Crosstalk and you'll discover how God used a Persian 'infidel' to help Michael grow up. He had concerns about his soon to be expired visa, and how this expression of Christian hospitality helped someone would change his life forever.</p>

So do the days of Noah really parallel what we're seeing today? That's the overarching question that Jim answered by Jeff Kinley. Jeff is a graduate of Dallas Theological Seminary and has previously served as a pastor. He has a passion for sharing biblical truth and speaks across the country equipping churches and Christians to discern and live with confidence. He's the author of 38 books including, <i>Wake the Bride</i>, <i>Aftershocks</i>, and others in his new released book, <i>As It Was in the Days of Noah: Warnings from Bible Prophecy about the Coming Global Catastrophe</i>. Jeff's desire with this book was to bring to the current generation the relevance of what Christ said in Matthew 24: the coming of the Son of Man will be just like the days of Noah. In other words, that generation will mirror our generation up to the second coming.</p> <p>So as the "Revelation generation" where are we time-wise? 12/27	Chaos at Southwest Border	Jim Schneider / Mark Krikorian	<p>As we approached Christmas, unprecedented numbers of immigrants were making their way toward the U.S. for the anticipation of the lifting of Title 42. Yuma county declared a state of emergency, not only for the border but also regarding the vast number of illegal immigrants using the key word, "asylum," to gain entrance. The numbers are off the charts and the courts have stopped the lifting of Title 42, but for how long? Will the U.S. continue to operate unhindered as we enter the new year?</p> <p>Back on Crosstalk to discuss this critical issue was Mark Krikorian. Mark is a nationally recognized expert on immigration issues serving as the executive director of the Center for Immigration Studies. They are an independent think tank organization examining and critiquing the impact of immigration on the United States. He's testified numerous times before Congress and has published articles in many outlets.</p> <p>How would Mark describe President Biden's border plan? The Biden administration doesn't see the migration as a problem. They believe these individuals have a right to cross. In fact, he indicated that Biden's plan is to get more immigrants even faster into the U.S. His administration sees immigrants backing up into border communities, clogging streets in cities like El Paso, burdening them and other towns. So for them, the solution is to move immigrants into the interior of the country.</p> <p>The president should be doing everything necessary to stop all illegal border crossings because that's what the Biden administration is simply ignoring it. They know that, but they consider immigration law to be immoral. Mark said that Biden's administration is simply ignoring it. They know that, but they consider immigration law to be immoral. Biden's administration sees it as an immoral law. They may do something cosmetic to limit the public relations fallout, but they don't believe they're going to do anything else.</p> <p>While there are those who are caught or turn themselves in, what about the thousands who don't want to be caught? Last year alone we caught 98 people that were on the terrorist watch list. Mark wondered how many of those were caught. Then there's the issue of drugs and the diversions that smugglers can create. They do this by telling grocers to close the border at certain times. This requires border patrol agents to move away from their patrolled areas to allow for openings for drugs to be taken across the border.</p> <p>How do the numbers look? In fiscal 2021, there were about 1.6 million border patrol apprehensions. In fiscal 2020, ended September 30, that involved about 2.2 million apprehensions. Although some were sent back to their home countries, Mark noted that this administration has let in approximately 1.5 million illegal aliens since taking office.</p>

12/28	Spending Out of Control	Jim Schneider	<p>Many of you are familiar with the biblical instruction in Proverbs 22:7 that says: "The rich ruleth over the poor because he is servant to the lender."</p> <p>The problem is that when it comes to debt, the U.S. is sinking fast as our debt is out of control. How bad is it? Jim was on the National Debt Clock and the current debt is just below 31.5 trillion dollars and the total debt of nearly \$249,000.</p> <p>Jim then went back to 1980. According to the National Debt Clock, the U.S. national debt was 934 billion dollars in 1980. By 2008 it was 11.1 trillion. In 2016 it had risen to 20.2 trillion. Today it is estimated that it will be over 42 trillion dollars.</p> <p>Along with that there's the internal borrowing for other funds such as Social Security, the military retirement funds, etc.</p> <p>According to the Department of the Treasury, the largest foreign holder of our national debt is Japan. The next largest holders of our debt are communist China and the UK.</p> <p>Here's the reason why we need this sobering reminder. Last week, while most people were getting ready for the U.S. House and Senate were hard at work attempting to pass a massive, 4,155 page omnibus spending bill. Last Thursday, Senate Minority Leader Mitch McConnell and 17 other Republicans, joined Democrats in passing a 1.85 trillion dollar omnibus bill by a vote of 68-29. This bill basically sets federal spending for all of fiscal year 2023. It began October 1st. This "kneecaps" the new Congress, not just on issues related to the budget, but also on issues related to the administration, and more.</p> <p>Why did Republicans "cave in" on this? Senator Ron Johnson of Wisconsin has serious fiscal concerns. Mitch McConnell sees things quite differently.</p> <p>Form your own opinion as you hear Jim go through some of what this bill addresses and then hear what he has to say about it.</p>
12/29	Bible Reading Challenge 2023	Jim Schneider / Randy Melchert	<p>Violent crime is off the charts in our nation. There's a spirit of division and anger, we're seeing severed relationships, lawlessness abounds, and when you couple this with issues such as depression, suicide, and drug use, it all seems so overwhelming.</p> <p>Where or to what do we turn to in such times? As a Christian ministry we know that we are in a spiritual battle and that battle requires a spiritual solution. So be honest. When was the last time you turned to the God of the universe for help and not some societal/secular/government solution? Even if you do look to God's Word, are you doing it on a daily basis?</p> <p>To help you in this regard, Crosstalk welcomed back Randy Melchert. Randy is a school administrator, a speaker, and a consultant. He's a member of the VCY America Board of Directors and is administering the 2023 Bible Reading Challenge. Randy began by noting that NBC News asked the following question 205 times from 1995 to 2022: Are we on the right track or the wrong track? 93% said that no, things are not on the right track.</p> <p>Looking at this from a generational perspective, "Gen-Z" tends to be the most pessimistic group. Why? The challenges as the challenges noted earlier are not simply external issues but issues that are having an effect internally. Randy referenced an American Bible Society survey on stress. The elders (the "Greatest" or "Silent" Generation) ranked stress in the survey. The younger the participants were ("Boomers," "Gen-X," "Millennials," & "Gen-Z") the more stress they communicated. In fact, 1 out of 4 "Gen-Z" members is identified as having a mental disorder. They're self-identifying as having an inability to cope with the world internally.</p> <p>Should we be surprised? Perhaps not when you consider this: The group least likely to read the Bible on a daily basis are white men, only 1 out of 5 church-going people read the Bible daily, and of those that do read it, 17% said they read where their eyes land. Additionally, less than half of all church-going evangelicals have read the Bible even once.</p> <p>Clearly we can and must do better, not just for ourselves but for future generations. God wants us to have His Word on a daily basis through His Word. It's truth for today, sufficient for every area of life, and we need it. To help people in this regard, VCY America is launching the Bible Reading Challenge for 2023. In just 365 days you can read through the entire Bible in one year. Find out how you can get started by reviewing this exciting challenge.</p>
12/30	News Roundup Comment	Jim Schneider	<p>These stories and more made up this edition of the Round-Up for this final week of 2022:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Russian President Vladimir Putin is threatening to destroy the Patriot missile system if the U.S. follows through on its commitment to supply them to Ukraine. -Russia is reported to have lost hundreds of troops and at least five tanks over Christmas. -Ukraine's foreign minister is calling for a peace summit to be held at the end of February but says Russia must first be held in a war crimes tribunal before they directly engage with Moscow. -Russia fired scores of missiles into Ukraine early on Thursday in a massive aerial bombardment that destroyed schools, shelters and knocked out power. -Thousands of U.S. trained Afghan troops are reportedly considering joining Russian forces as mercenaries as they face a life of poverty in Iran. -Senator Lindsey Graham repeated his call for Vladimir Putin to be assassinated. -Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky announced a continuation of a partnership with the investment firm BlackRock for the rebuilding of Ukraine from war. -Russia and China have completed naval drills in the East China Sea after a week of joint exercises. -China's military sent about 71 planes and 7 ships toward Taiwan in a 24 hour display of force. -President Joe Biden may have made a Christmas gift to Taiwan by signing into law a defense bill in which the U.S. will provide the island 2 billion dollars to bolster its capabilities against threats from China. -South Korea fired warning shots, scrambled fighter jets and flew surveillance assets across the heavily militarized border with North Korea Monday after North Korean drones violated its air space for the first time in 5 years. -Sudan and Yemen defense ministers signed a military cooperation agreement on peace operations and arms supplies. -The U.S. military equipment from Afghanistan is now for sale on Ebay. -In response to Western price caps on Russian oil, President Vladimir Putin banned the export of oil to the United States and European Union Nations. -Former President Donald Trump hosted a gala for homosexual Republicans at Mar-a-Lago just two days before Christmas and signed the so-called Respect for Marriage Act.
