After being elected, he went to work on these things, pulling away from such efforts as the Paris Climate Accords, the World Health Organization and the push toward globalism. As he did this, there was constant push-back with virtually every agency and department taking action to slow or stop his efforts. 2/22/21	"Equality" Act Introduced	Jim Schneider / Matt Staver	Late last Thursday afternoon we received word that the so-called 'Equality Act' was formally introduced. In the House it is H.R. 5. The Senate Bill, though drafted, is waiting for a bill number. Some have called this 'The Criminalization of Christianity Act' for the impact it would have upon churches and Christian ministries across the country. As Joe Biden ran for President he promised this as a top legislative agenda point to be passed in his first 100 days. It is moving like greased lightning in the House of Representatives. Joining Jim to look at this critical issue was constitutional attorney Mat Staver. Mat is the founder and chairman of Liberty Counsel. Before weighing in on the main topic, Jim had Mat comment on a number of other issues including: Today the U.S. Supreme Court decided it won't be resolving disputes arising from the 2020 elections where state officials violated their own state laws. 3 justices, including Thomas, Gorsuch and Alito, have warned that failing to bring a conclusion to this issue could result in catastrophic consequences. Justice Thomas said that for the high court to refuse to address this is a concern in itself. Today was the beginning of confirmation hearings for Merrick Garland who was nominated by President Biden to be the U.S. Attorney General. Tomorrow (Tuesday) morning at 10am Eastern Time, the Senate Committee on Health, Education, Labor and Pensions will meet in a hearing in consideration of Xavier Beccera to be the next Secretary of Health and Human Services. Back on February 18th, H.R. 5, the so-called 'Equality Act' was introduced. It was immediately sent to five separate committees for hearings. On Friday morning, President Biden 'tweeted' the following: 'The Equality Act provides long overdue federal civil rights protections for LGBTQ+ Americans, preventing discrimination in our housing, education, public services and
			lending systems. I urge Congress to swiftly pass this historic legislation.' According to Mat, this is the most radical bill to ever come out of Congress and if passed, it will affect the following: Employers, online retailers and service providers, religious and non-profit organizations, contractors, houses of worship, churches, schools (public, private and religious), colleges, universities, sports, hiring, curriculum, restroom usage, daycare providers, shelters, hospitals, adoption and foster care, and even places of gathering with no numerical limit as to what that would be. As this broadcast progressed, Jim had Mat look at a number of other factors related to this issue, especially as it pertains to churches and religious freedom:
			 How does the Religious Freedom Restoration Act affect this? What is the standard that determines a cause of action so that this legislation doesn't become a haven for harassing lawsuits? Is conversion therapy affected by this legislation? There's much more to this issue and you can hear it all when you review this critical

While some say that global warming experts were too busy predicting warmer winters for Texas to see the snow, others like Senator Chuck Schumer are blaming the power outage on the state's failure to address climate change. While some say the Green New Deal needs to be more actively pursued, the governor of Texas is warning that this is what the entire country will go through if we accept the Green New Deal. Tom DeWeese is the president of American Policy Center. He's one of the nation's leading advocates of individual liberty, free enterprise, private property rights, personal privacy, back-to-basics education and American sovereignty and independence, and protecting our Constitutionally-guaranteed rights. Tom is author of Sustainable: The War on Free Enterprise, Private Property and Individuals and Erase, a political novel. Chuck Schumer communicated that Texas thought they could 'go it alone' while building a system that ignored climate change. Tom called that 'incredible spin' because Texas has put a large amount of their energy on the grid through solar and wind power which is what the Green New Deal calls for. It's been proven time and again that these two power sources do not provide enough energy to rely completely upon them alone. With wind turbines frozen and solar panels covered in snow, they couldn't provide the needed energy. President Biden has the U.S. back in the Paris Climate Accord. Jim provided audio of climate czar John Kerry as he addressed the Munich Security Conference and told them that largely because of President Trump, 3 of the 12 years that scientists said the earth had left to mitigate this problem, were wasted. With its passage in the House of Representatives, the next step is the U.S. Senate. When did this start? Bob named some historic presidents and key years in American history, but in the end he prefers to go back to the Garden of Eden. 3/10	Vaccination Issues	Jim Schneider / Barbara Loe Fisher	Many people are wondering whether they should get a COVID-19 vaccine or not. While this program provided no personalized medical advice in that regard, there are some things worth considering. Joining Jim to take a closer look at the latest news concerning vaccines and vaccine legislation Barbara Loe Fisher. Barbara is president of the National Vaccine Information Center (NVIC), a non-profit charity she co-founded with parents of DPT vaccine injured children in 1982. For nearly four decades she has led a national, grassroots movement and public information campaign to institute vaccine safety reforms and informed consent protections in the public health system. She has researched, analyzed and publicly articulated the major issues involving the science, policy, law, ethics and politics of vaccination to become one of the world's leading non-medical, consumer advocacy experts on the subject. She is co-author of DPT: A Shot in the Dark and author of The Consumer's Guide to Childhood Vaccines, as well as Vaccines, Autism and Chronic Inflammation: The New Epidemic, and Reforming Vaccine Policy and Law: A Guide. Discussion began with what's taking place in Washington, D.C. Through their city council, they passed The Minor Consent for Vaccinations Act of 2020 (DC 23-171). This legislation basically says that any child as young as 11 can consent to vaccination after being convinced by a physician to get one or more vaccines. This can be done without the knowledge or consent of the child's parents. It actually prohibits telling the parents the type of vaccines the child received. This obviously doesn't give parents the opportunity to monitor the child after the fact for symptoms of a serious or fatal vaccine reaction. In essence, it doesn't allow parents to be the proper guardians of their children. Barbara noted that if it passes, it's actually in violation of federal law that was passed in 1986, so she doesn't understand why anyone would pass dangerous legislation that puts a child in physical danger. The fate of

3/11	2 nd Amendment Attack Advances	Jim Schneider / Michael Hammond	As promised, during the run-up to the 2020 elections, it was warned that gun control was going to be in the sights of a Biden administration. They had their sights on the 2nd Amendment with the enabling of a House of Representatives under Pelosi and the Senate under Schumer. Just hours ago that promise was fulfilled, in part, with legislation that passed the House of Representatives. Joining Jim for discussion regarding this critical issue was Michael Hammond. Michael is the legislative counsel for Gun Owners of America. The bills referred to are HR-8 and HR-1446. HR-8 is called the Bipartisan Background Checks Act of 2021. It passed by a vote of 227 to 203. 8 Republicans voted for it with one Democrat voting against it. Michael described HR-8 as basically a universal gun registry. It would create a registry of every gun, gun owner and their addresses. In addition, it would create a set of complex rules that no one could comply with. Michael described the rules as being similar to a minefield. Make the wrong step and you go to prison. In other words, the complex nature of the rules amounts to intimidation. He cited examples to prove his point. HR-1446 had 165 co-sponsors, all Democrats. It's called the Enhanced Background Checks Act. The final vote was 219-210. 2 Republicans joined the Democrats while 2 Democrats joined the Republicans. In 1993 there was a compromise. There would be a 'Brady check' but the government wouldn't allow you to hold up a gun transaction indefinitely. Instead, after 3 days, without violating the law, you'd be able to take possession of the gun from the seller. That's assuming the government has been going around to gun sellers (particularly 'box' stores) and has been telling them that unless they give the go-ahead, don't transfer the gun in spite of the fact that they know the law allows the gun to be transferred at the end of 3 days. Michael noted that they've received probably more complaints on this one issue than any other. Now the FBI is saying that 3 days is not enough and

	Becerra Nomination Protested	Brase	government officials. Of great concern to many is the nomination of Xavier Becerra for the position of Secretary of Health and Human Services. Joining Jim to discuss this nomination was Twila Brase. Twila is the president and co-founder of Citizens' Council for Health Freedom. Twila is a registered nurse, a certified public health nurse, and author of Big Brother in the Exam Room: The Dangerous Truth About Electronic Health Records. She's the speaker on the daily Health Freedom Minute heard on stations across the nation. Earlier this month, Twila sent a letter to the leadership of the U.S. Senate to oppose the confirmation of Xavier Becerra who is currently the Attorney General of California. 3/31	Boulder Shooting: Is Gun Control the Answer	Jim Schneider / Michael Hammond	Monday of last week, a very tragic mass murder claimed the lives of many, including a police officer, at a King's Super Store in Boulder, Colorado. It didn't take long for some legislators to announce their belief that we need gun control; that if we had common sense gun control, incidents like this would not happen. In the wake of the shooting, the Biden administration is poised to use the incident as a springboard to issue executive orders on the matter of gun control. Joining Jim to discuss this and related issues was Michael Hammond. Michael is the legislative counsel for Gun Owners of America. Michael laid out how in 2013, Colorado had enacted gun control. They had not banned semi-automatic weapons, but they had banned high capacity magazines for such weapons. The gun control measures included red flag gun confiscation laws as well as universal gun registration/universal background checks. This is important because now President Biden is claiming that the Boulder shooting tells us that we have to enact universal background checks at the federal level. Michael contends that since such checks were in effect in Boulder 8 years before the shooting, and they did no good, why would enacting them at the federal level have any impact? He believes that what the shooting really shows is that gun control (that the House and Senate are trying to pass right now) has proven to be demonstrably ineffective. Michael then noted that Gabby Giffords, one of the gun control leaders in America, spent a lot of time badgering Kroger (owner of King's Super Stores) into making its stores gun-free zones. Kroger ultimately gave-in to that idea. Michael believes that since King's Super Store is a gun-free zone, not only didn't that fact prohibit this shooting from taking place, it encouraged it to happen. More can be gleaned from this broadcast such as:
