Interestingly, in the last 5 months, 20 food and fertilizer plants and storage facilities across the U.S. have closed. Breitbart reported that the prices of U.S. farm products continued to rise in March reflecting the inflationary pressure on our economy and fears that the war in Ukraine and sanctions on Russia could lead to food shortages around the world.</p> <p>Joining Jim to examine what's behind all of this was William F. Jasper. He's senior editor at The New American and he's an author, journalist and commentator as well as a top investigative reporter and documentary producer. For three decades he served as an accredited correspondent at the United Nations in New York and UN summits. William believes that famine in America is a real possibility due to the vulnerabilities in our food chain. | | | | <p>In addition, the Biden administration’s Department of Health and Human Services is attempting to alter S redefine sex discrimination so broadly that it’s threatening the ability of doctors to practice medicine according to evidences and their own principles of faith.</p> <p>Helping bring clarity to this issue, Crosstalk welcomed Dr. Jeffrey Barrows. He’s the Senior Vice President of Public Policy for Christian Medical & Dental Associations. Dr. Barrows is an obstetrician/gynecologist, medical ethicist and speaker. He completed his medical degree at the Des Moines College of Osteopathic Medicine in 1978 and his residency training in obstetrics and gynecology at Doctors Hospital in Columbus, Ohio. He is active in the fight against human trafficking.</p> <p>Why is this issue of gender identity dysphoria exploding today and what does this have to do with Section 1557? To understand the connection properly, Dr. Barrows provided listeners with some background information. Up until 2013, this issue was called gender identity disorder. It was viewed by the mental health profession as a problem in the person experiencing it. Then in 2013, the American Psychiatric Association changed their name. He described gender dysphoria as a term that simply refers to bad or negative feelings concerning their biological sex away from the mental health component and almost legitimized the feelings of dysphoria in a way that has altered the problem.</p> <p>Then around 2015-2016 came rapid onset gender dysphoria. Historically gender dysphoria and gender identity disorder has been a problem within far less than 1% of children yet typically more common in biological males beginning in adolescence. However, rapid onset gender dysphoria is very different. This phenomenon happens during the teenage years common in biological females and is associated with peer groups. This has been seen with the advent of social media. Dr. Barrows also noted that transgender ideology believes that a child is born with a certain sense of what gender they are and also believe that it doesn’t have to align with their biological sex. Transgender ideology also doesn’t believe in the influence of experts or the best influence. This is why there’s such a big push to have their ideology included into the law and why they’re making efforts to hide this from parents.</p> <p>Originally Section 1557 of the Affordable Care Act defined that which constituted discrimination. It used the legal definitions of discrimination on the basis of ethnicity, origin and interpreting sex as biological sex. During 2016, within the last year of the Obama administration, it was decided that they would change the definition of discrimination to include gender identity and pregnancy. The other thing they did was make it clear that it would apply for routine care for all patients regardless of sexual orientation or whether they identify as transgender. He has spoken on a variety of topics at Christian conferences. He’s author of <i>The Middle East Meltdown</i>, <i>The Fall of the West</i>, and other books. He appeared with Jim to discuss, <i>Babylon: The Bookends of Prophetic History</i>.</p> <p>In Zechariah, after Babylon fell to the Persians, it talks about a woman who’s put in a basket. In the time of the end, she will build a house (temple) and she builds it in the land of Shinar.</p> <p>Is this an event that is still in the future for us or did this already take place?</p> <p>First of all we need to look back to see when we’re first introduced to Babylon. Babylon comes into the picture in Genesis 10 and 11. Chapter 11 in particular is where Shinar (Mesopotamia—modern day Iraq) is mentioned. The Tower of Babel project took shape and was man’s attempt at world government.</p> <p>Dr. Woods believes that Satan has always wanted the Tower of Babel project back. | | | | <p>–California’s Sixth District Court of Appeals decided Monday to free a church in San Jose from well over breaking COVID-19 rules.</p> <p>–When the COVID-19 vaccine was rolled out, the CEO of Pfizer touted a South Africa trial he said was effective would be 100% effective in preventing infection. On Monday, however, he tested positive for COVID-19 doses of the Pfizer/BioNTech vaccine.</p> <p>–Also on Monday, Lloyd Austin, Secretary of the Department of Defense, tested positive for COVID as he Biden.</p> <p>–U.S. life insurance companies have reported an overwhelming and unexplainable increase in all deaths of individuals. This is the first case of human to pet transmission of Monkeypox according to the medical journal, The Lancet.</p> <p>–At a news conference, CDC Director Rochelle Walensky communicated that as of August 17th, over 39,000 cases of Monkeypox have been detected globally in 94 countries. Here in the U.S. there’ve been over 13,500 cases identified across 49 states as well as Washington, DC, and Puerto Rico. Monkeypox case data shows that it’s occurring in men. 93% are among men who reported recent sexual contact with other men. So they’re being encouraged to get vaccinated through a program that will provide additional vaccines to state and local health departments whose jurisdictions have a majority of people within the MSM (men having sex with men) community. Since church services were shut down during COVID, why aren’t events within the MSM community being shut down as well to prevent the spread of Monkeypox?</p> <p>–The top rated pediatric medical institution, Boston Children’s Hospital, has come under fire for a viral video (the doctor has been removed) in which a cheerful obstetrician glibly promoted the surgical mutilation of young women who want genital surgery.</p> <p>–A magistrate judge will unseal further Justice Department records related to the FBI’s unprecedented raid on Donald Trump’s Mar-a-Lago home. | 8/23 | Fentanyl | Jim Schneider / Mark Shaw | <p>The number of fentanyl overdose deaths is skyrocketing. According to Families Against Fentanyl, fentanyl has caused more deaths since 2019. They report that fentanyl poisoning is now the number one cause of death in adults 18-45 with a 100% fatality rate for the year ending in April 2021.</p> <p>As a whole, drug overdose deaths surpassed 100,000 per year for the first time in 2021.</p> <p>According to a press release from Congressman Glenn Grothman, during April through June of this year, 100 pounds of fentanyl was seized at the southern border. That 3 month apprehension was more than the total amount of fentanyl consumed in the year 2019 and equivalent to over 750 million lethal doses, enough to kill the entire American population ten times over.</p> <p>Appearing on Crosstalk to discuss this issue was Mark Shaw. Mark is the director of counseling at Grace Community Church in Florence, Kentucky, and is the founder of The Addiction Connection. He is a certified alcohol and drug counselor. He’s an ordained pastor, speaker, teacher and author of multiple books such as <i>The Heart of Addiction</i>, <i>How to Stop Being an Addict</i> and many others including the recently released booklet entitled, <i>Fentanyl</i>.</p> <p>Fentanyl is a very powerful, synthetic opioid drug. While perhaps not as widely known as marijuana, heroin, or cocaine, it’s been around since the ’60’s. People typically add it to whatever they’re currently taking while still not knowing it’s fentanyl that gets placed into drugs without their knowing about it.</p> <p>According to Mark, fentanyl is 50 times stronger than heroin and 100 times stronger than morphine. As little as 2 milligrams can cause an overdose.</p> <p>Why would God create the plants that would allow certain harmful substances to be made? Mark brought up the fact that we see sin enter into the world and the consequences of sin which brought death. So some plants have toxins that can have a good purpose in that they keep certain insects from eating them. Man, on the other hand, has found ways to extract those toxins and consume them.</p> <p>However, what must be noted is that such toxins can be beneficial to mankind. In the case of fentanyl, it’s been used and administered at times for physical pain management.</p> |

Jane's Revenge took responsibility and gave pro-life pregnancy centers 30 days to shut down consequences of continued violence.</p> <p>After 30 days, the Buffalo, N.Y., CompassCare facility was attacked with multiple incendiary devices resulting in gutted and rebuilt. Jane's Revenge graffiti was painted on the side of the building. A couple of days later, the facility released another communique taking responsibility for the firebombing while also communicating that if the facility was shut down, things wouldn't be so easily cleaned up as fire and graffiti. Undaunted, CompassCare continued to help women in the moment of their crisis and 52 days later, their facility was up and running.</p> <p>Planned Parenthood had a site in Kalamazoo, Michigan, that was attacked at the end of July. Ken was asked by Jim that if he could give a letter grade to the issue of election security and integrity in a state that grade be? He said he'd give a C or possibly a C+ in some parts of the country. Then again, he noted that in some parts of the nation less than a C as well.</p> <p>He explained his answer based upon the following: There are 51 election systems in our country. Of course, they are run down by states and has been this way since the Constitution was ratified. There have been some exceptions where appropriate implementation of civil rights in states where blacks were denied the opportunity to vote.</p> <p>This works to our advantage in terms of election security where someone from the outside might attempt to hack a state, there's an effort to hack one state, then they've hacked one state. So if the efforts to nationalize our election system, you immediately lose that insulation that comes from having the diversification via 51 different election systems. In 2001, he left INS to become a member of the House Judiciary Committee where he performed oversight of immigration issues. After 5 years there, he returned to immigration bench serving for eight years as an Immigration Judge at the York Immigration Court in York, PA at the beginning of the 114th Congress. Judge Arthur left the bench and came back to Capitol Hill, where he served as the Director of the National Security Subcommittee at House Oversight and Government Reform before taking a leave of federal service in 2016.</p> <p>Illegal immigration is continuing at an incredible rate. Early in his administration, President Biden had fears about our southwest border. That fear has become reality. States have had enough with some transporting these individuals to areas that have declared themselves to be sanctuary for illegal aliens. This includes places like Washington (D.C.), Chicago, New York City and Martha’s Vineyard. Many are outraged, claiming that in doing this, red state governors are using these individuals as political pawns. President Biden’s administration blames the Trump administration for what’s going on at the border. That’s not true. When candidate Biden was running in 2008, he indicated he was in favor of a border wall. In fact, in the 2006 election, 2006, then Senator Biden, Senator Obama and Senator Hillary Clinton, all voted in favor, not just for wall but also mandated that a wall be erected.</p> <p>According to Andrew, the Biden administration believes that the border is closed and secure. They established a policy based upon the idea that most individuals that cross the border are put into removal proceedings in the U.S. The law says, what Congress says, nor what the American people say should be going on as well. | 9/22 | No Reason to Hide | Jim Schneider/ Dr. Erwin Lutzer | <p>Our culture is becoming increasingly hostile toward Christianity. We’re told to “get with the times” or to conform within the four walls of our churches.</p> <p>The guest on this Crosstalk indicated that as the intolerance toward Christianity increases, this is not a time to hide. In fact, he believes it’s imperative that we stand up for biblical truth and expose the works of darkness. To guide listeners in that effort, Crosstalk welcomed back Dr. Erwin Lutzer. Dr. Lutzer is Pastor Emeritus of the Church where he served as the senior pastor for 36 years. He’s the speaker on the radio programs <i>Running with the Night</i>. He is a speaker and an award winning author of several books with titles including: <i>The Cross and the Crescent</i>, <i>Life Changing Bible Verses You Should Know</i>, <i>We Will Not Be Silenced</i>, and the newly released <i>Expose the Greatest Lie That is Our Nation’s Most Cherished Delusion</i>. This war is on our doorstep. Dr. Lutzer began by noting that we as Christians didn’t go looking for a culture war. This war is on our doorstep. We avoid it. Both books address the culture but this latest one has new chapters not covered in the previous book. According to the Life Chain mission statement: “A Life Chain is a peaceful, prayerful, public witness of pro-life Americans (and Canadians) standing in a million lives lost to abortion, praying for our nation, for people in crisis situations and for a permanent and visual statement of solidarity by the Christian community that abortion kills children, hurts women and supports the sanctity of human life from the moment of conception to natural death.”</p> <p>Those participating hold a professionally printed sign that is provided at the site. Participants stand by for a period of time chosen by the group holding the event. While most are held on the first Sunday in October (some may be on the third or even the last Sunday of October. In other instances, some may be on Friday when people are out traveling to football games, while still others may be on Saturday morning while more people are out for a good day to stand up for life!</p> <p>You can make a difference and affect the hearts of passing motorists as you support life. So find out how to you by reviewing the contact information listed below.</p> <p>This broadcast also dealt with several accounts concerning the story of Mark Houck, a well known pro-life counselor and father who was allegedly the latest victim of a U.S. Department of Justice sponsored raid on a home. There is some dispute among news sources concerning some facts of the case, such as whether a S.W.A.T. team was involved. | 9/29 | Long Haul COVID-19 | Jim Schneider/ Dr. Elizabeth Lee Vliet | <p>Dr. Elizabeth Lee Vliet is the president and CEO of Truth for Health Foundation, a non-profit public charity. In 2020, she has been part of the team of frontline physicians treating COVID early at home. With Dr. Peter D’Amico, she is co-author/editor of the <i>Guide to COVID Early Treatment: Options to Stay Out of Hospital and Save Your Health</i>. She is a 2014 Ellis Island Medal of Honor recipient for her national and international educational efforts in health care. She is an expert in endocrine aging in men and women. She is a past director of the Association of American Physicians and Surgeons and received her M.D. degree and internship in Internal Medicine at Eastern Virginia Medical School and completed her residency at Johns Hopkins. She spoke as an independent physician, not as a spokesperson for any healthcare system, insurance company, insurance plans or political party. She is a patient advocate.</p> <p>According to Worldometers, there have been over 98.1 million coronavirus cases in the U.S. From that total, there have been 1,083,798 deaths. Then according to the October 2022 Consumer Reports magazine, anywhere from 10% to 20% of individuals who got COVID-19 had symptoms long after they first became ill. Also, they report that according to the American Academy of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, as many as 27 million or more people are being affected by Long COVID-19.</p> <p>Dr. Vliet takes issue with these numbers partly because she believes that what many doctors are telling the public is that they claim is Long COVID is actually complications and side effects from the inflammation, micro blood clots, and immune suppression from the COVID shots. She also indicated that these 3 factors were engineered into the COVID shots. She noted that there are those who’ve died after the shot having had strokes, heart attacks, the flaring of autoimmune diseases, and cancers that are getting out of control. All of these are known complications of the COVID shots.
