4/4	Citizens Vaccine Injury Reporting System	Jim Schneider/ Dr. Elizabeth Lee Vliet	<p>Dr. Elizabeth Lee Vliet is the president and CEO of Truth for Health Foundation, a non-profit public health organization. In 2020, she has been part of the team of frontline physicians treating COVID early at home. With Dr. Peter D'Amico, co-author/editor of the <i>Guide to COVID Early Treatment: Options to Stay Out of Hospital and Save Your Health</i>, she received the 2014 Ellis Island Medal of Honor recipient for her national and international educational efforts in health care. She is an endocrine aging in men and women. She is a past director of the Association of American Physicians and Surgeons and received her M.D. degree and internship in Internal Medicine at Eastern Virginia Medical School and completed her residency at Johns Hopkins. She appeared on Crosstalk as an independent physician, not as a spokesperson for any pharmaceutical company, insurance plan or political party. She is a patient advocate.</p> <p>The program began with news of an audio clip from 2004 of Dr. Anthony Fauci. In the clip he argues that the flu doesn't need the flu vaccine because the best vaccine is getting infected yourself. Dr. Vliet responded by saying that God's design of our natural immunity is the best protection of all and we should always approached vaccination. In other words, we've never recommended vaccinating people who've never had the illness. So in 2004, Dr. Fauci was being honest with the public but in 2020 he had a different attitude and contradicted himself and medical practice.</p> <p>Fauci's name is on many of the patents related to the development of the COVID shots. He earns royalties from the agency but for himself personally based upon the patent royalties. This isn't illegal under government patent law but indicated it's still a conflict of interest that's pushing him to make false statements that the only way you can stop COVID is to get one of the vaccines.</p> <p>Dr. Vliet contends that the call for continued boosters is about control of the population, making money for pharmaceutical companies and the patent holders which includes Fauci, the NIH, CDC and all of the stakeholders that have a stake in the components of the COVID shots.</p> <p>What we're not being told is that these are gene-therapy agents and not traditional vaccines. They don't create natural immunity. They are designed with the lipid-nanoparticle coating that takes the mRNA (or DNA) across the cell membrane that the mRNA directs the body's DNA to produce the synthetic spike protein which has toxicity in the cell causing all the damage with the shots. They moved to South America where they learned to speak Spanish, and their sister were born there.</p> <p>Sam's parents then applied and were approved to come to the U.S. They came through New York City in the summer of 1950 and Sam was born in October.</p> <p>Sam's home life was very religious. He attended Hebrew school five days a week for eight years and was a practicing Jew.</p> <p>Around age 11 or 12, Sam admits he began to develop a very foul mouth. He could lie to his parents and even began to curse. He found himself praying in the morning yet swearing at school. He could be moral and very immoral when he wanted to. In other words, he was showing where his heart really was.</p>

			<p>As he grew up in his very religious home, his mother developed within him a love for classical music. He could learn to play piano. The more he practiced the better he got and the better he got, the more he loved it. At age 11, he made the decision that he wanted to be a pianist.</p> <p>At age 12-13 he began entering competitions and at age 16 he won a competition while playing with a large group of people in attendance. Then at 17 he auditioned and got into the Juilliard School of Music where, while still in high school, he obtained Bachelors and Masters degrees in piano.</p> <p>Sam was very focused on music and practicing and developed a very self-righteous attitude. He didn't want to shame his parents as they had sacrificed greatly for him so he never drank. Keep in mind, this was before the 1960s in New York City during the height of the hippie movement so there were lots of drugs. Sam refrained from using them and engaged in pre-marital sex. In spite of all that, he still knew that while he was controlling his external behavior, he was not inside.</p> <p>It was at this time that he met three born-again Christians at Juilliard. He noticed that there was something about them because whenever he'd see them outside of class, they'd be reading the Bible and all they'd talk about in class was the Bible. His classmates were patient with Sam, eventually exposing him to the New Testament.</p> <p>So how did things turn out for this very self-righteous, hard working, Jewish boy, both musically and spiritually? The conclusion to this fascinating testimony when you review this edition of Crosstalk.</p>

4/12	<b>Border Crisis to Get Worse?</b>	<b>Jim Schneider/ Jessica Vaughn</b>	<p>Jessica Vaughn is the director of policy studies for the Center for Immigration Studies. Her expertise is in immigration enforcement and public safety. She's an instructor for senior law enforcement officer training seminars at the University's Center for Public Safety in Illinois.</p> <p>What is Title 42 that the Centers for Disease Control is terminating? How does this relate to immigration and what the DHS secretary is referencing?</p> <p>According to Jessica, Title 42 is a provision in the federal statutes that enables President Biden to block entry of anyone he deems poses a threat to public health. This could be one individual with a contagious disease, a group of people, or everyone as we saw with the Trump administration during the early portion of the COVID pandemic.</p> <p>This means that the Border Patrol and Customs and Border Protection at the legal ports of entry can expel anyone from the U.S. or prevent them from entering instead of having to process them through a formal removal procedure which is more time consuming. This is what allowed President Trump to shut the border down during the pandemic. Not only helped slow the spread of the coronavirus, it also put a stop to the immigration surge.</p> <p>The Biden administration has announced that it will end use of Title 42 on May 23<sup>rd</sup> and instead begin to enforce actually our immigration law, the law that Congress passed that sets out what they want the federal government to do when someone who attempt to enter the U.S. illegally.</p> <p>Have we actually been following Title 8? Title 8 says that illegal arrivals are to be detained until they can be processed, their asylum claim can be completed or they need to be returned to Mexico. Jessica sees this as a rather lenient part of the Biden administration because they haven't been doing much with Title 8 at all. In fact, they've relaxed the limits on the Border Patrol, but also on Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE). They've been to the most egregious cases such as those concerning illegal aliens that commit horrible crimes.</p> <p>The soon termination of Title 42 could be sparking a new wave of illegal immigration into the U.S. Under the Obama administration, 1,000 illegal immigrants per day was considered a problem. Now they're talking about a potential for 18,000 illegals crossing every day. She indicated the plan is not to stop this influx, but to try to accommodate it, processing them so that most of them can be let into the country.</p> <p>This program has much more to offer on the immigration situation including views from Crosstalk listeners.</p>
4/13	<b>Transhumanism</b>	<b>Jim Schneider/ Alex Newman</b>	<p>One of the components of the Great Reset agenda involves the merging of machines/technology with humans, called transhumanism. Although we've alluded to this in past programs, this entire program looks at this issue in detail because transhumanism seeks to take surveillance, which up until now has been outside the body, and control it from the skin.</p> <p>Returning to Crosstalk to discuss this issue was Alex Newman. Alex is an award-winning international author, researcher, educator and consultant. He is senior editor for <i>The New American</i> and contributes to <i>Liberty Sentinel</i>.</p> <p>Transhumanism may sound like bad science fiction but it's not. Many of the most powerful people on the planet are proponents of this movement. That includes Klaus Schwab of the World Economic Forum, Microsoft CEO Satya Nadella, and Ray Kurzweil who is the director of engineering at Google.</p> <p>Why does Alex believe this issue is so significant? It's because what's at stake is the future existence of humanity. A homosexual activist Yuval Noah Harari, who's deeply connected to the World Economic Forum and author of <i>Sapiens</i>, Schwab. Harari's material isn't well known among the general public, but at the level of the elites, politicians, and Angela Merkel read his books.</p> <p>Harari believes that in the next 100 or so years, humans may not exist at all as we'll become deities ourselves and masters of evolution. The new transhuman-human will be so different from current humans that they won't be the same species.</p> <p>Some individuals have been dreaming about this for decades but we lacked the technology for anyone to do it seriously. Alex believes we're quickly entering the "marketing phase" where we'll start hearing more about it in our culture. It'll probably be marketed within the contexts of convenience and security, perhaps even fun.</p> <p>There's a range of technologies involved in this, one of them being technological upgrades to human beings, allowing the human brain to interact with computer systems. Another involves biological engineering and genetic modification. Combine this with the surveillance digital identity systems and digital currencies and for Alex, it's a concerning picture for our future.</p> <p>5G is connected to this as well because you need to be able to have numerous devices communicating with each other at high speeds. This is why you may have heard the phrase, "The Internet of things" which can include "smart" appliances like a refrigerator, home alarm system and more. However, the next step is the "Internet of bodies" and that means implants implanted in the body. This might include taking a pill that monitors your health or microchips implanted in your body. There's much more to take in from this broadcast including audio clips from Yuval Noah Harari and interviews with Alex Newman.</p>

4/15	In Defense of Easter	Jim Schneider/ Tim Chaffey	<p>Tim Chaffey is the director of Midwest Apologetics. He’s also the content manager for attractions at the Creation Museum. He is both a researcher and an apologist. Tim has served in the positions of a pastor and is the author of numerous books including ‘Old Earth Creationism on Trial’, ‘God and Cancer: Finding Hope in the Face of God’s Trials,’ and the book we’re discussing today ‘In Defense of Easter: Answering Critical Challenges to the Resurrection of Jesus.’</p> <p>Jim came right out with a tough accusation often tossed at Christians concerning Easter. It claims that Easter is a pagan holiday with connections to Ishtar or Ashtoreth.</p> <p>Tim began by explaining that it’s not wrong to celebrate the fact that Jesus rose from the dead. In fact, he said, he was celebrating it every day.</p> <p>The term ‘Easter’ most likely has a German origin (Ostern) which has to do with the rising of the sun. He said that while eggs and bunnies have become attached to the holiday, at the beginning God considered those things as symbols of themselves, rabbits and eggs aren’t pagan. For Tim this means there really isn’t much basis for the idea of connections to the celebration Christians call Easter.</p> <p>Why does Tim believe the matter of the resurrection is so critical? He referred to 1 Corinthians 15 where he said that if there is no resurrection from the dead, Christ is not risen and our faith is futile. This means we’re still in a state of being forgiven and we’ll suffer eternally for them. So if Christ hasn’t risen, there is no Christian faith.</p> <p>Tim described the resurrection as God’s stamp of approval regarding what Jesus did. Had Jesus only died and been buried in a grave, that would have made him a false prophet because he said he would rise.</p> <p>The Bible uses the phrase, ‘many infallible proofs’ concerning the resurrection. Much of this hinges on the fact of eyewitness appearances in the gospels.</p> <p>So why is there continued doubt by so many people today? Tim believes either people haven’t looked at the evidence or don’t want to believe. That’s an interesting point because as Tim’s book points out, Jesus not only appeared to his disciples but also appeared to skeptics as well.</p> <p>As this program moved along, Jim had Tim address the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>–Change in the disciples as proof of the resurrection.</li> <li>–The 2 classes of arguments skeptics use to try and explain away the resurrection.</li> <li>–The existence of the church as proof of the resurrection.</li> <li>–What is the ‘principle of embarrassment’?</li> <li>–Did Jesus arise physically or did he arise spiritually?</li> <li>–Does the Bible text contradict itself regarding the resurrection?</li> </ul>
4/18	Striking at the 2 <sup>nd</sup> Amendment	Jim Schneider/ Mike Hammond	<p>It seems that every time there’s a shooting of some kind, there’s a call for new gun laws. This often takes the form of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment of our constitution. Interestingly, the vast majority of mass shootings take place in gun friendly states. The Biden administration hasn’t been friendly to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment and this program looked at some of the ways they are trying to chip away at gun rights.</p> <p>Joining Jim for the latest news on this issue was Mike Hammond. Mike is the legislative counsel for Gun Rights. The program began by looking at mass shootings, with one having taken place as recently as this past week. Mike said that mass shootings, doesn’t that signal the need for gun control?</p> <p>Mike responded by saying that the reason these shootings are happening is due to the amount of attention given to the shooter with the desire for the 15 minutes of fame that the shooters are seeking. He went on to note that we began to see this in Sacramento, two of the most heavily regulated, biggest gun control jurisdictions in America. Gun control laws in California and what we’re seeing is a replication by disturbed people who are watching what’s taking place in other states and want in on the action.</p> <p>Conversation then moved to the mall shooting in Columbia, South Carolina. It’s been reported that the shooter had to post a \$25,000 bond and can return to his day job as long as he wears a monitoring bracelet.</p> <p>Mike asked if a monitoring bracelet will pick up whether he’s holding a gun or not? As he put it, “... the fact that a criminal matters has a direct impact on the extent to which crime occurs.” As an example, he cited New York where the crime rate is up 40%. Why? It’s not because there isn’t enough gun control. It’s, “...because people are not being held accountable for their transgressions and people are not specifically being removed from society when they’re dangerous.”</p> <p>Concerning some of the gang wars, the members are using fully automatic firearms. A typical citizen would have to pass a background check and pay a large fee in order to own one. The gangs have no problem getting them because they buy them on the black market and nothing you do in terms of limiting access to firearms by legal gun owners will prevent them from getting such lethal weaponry.</p> <p>Jim noted Chicago Mayor Lori Lightfoot who’s been an advocate of defunding the police yet it’s been reported that she has a unit of 70 police officers protecting her and a 20 officer body guard detail.</p> <p>Mike mentioned senators and representatives who have no problem spending billions of dollars on armaments for their capitol offices yet at the same time they have a problem with you having access to firearms to protect yourself.</p> <p>Mike also commented on the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What should we know about President Biden’s pick to head the ATF, Steve Dettelbach?</li> <li>• What is a “ghost gun”?</li> <li>• Alabama lawmakers passed legislation to block federal gun laws and become a sanctuary state.</li> </ul>

4/19	The 50 Final Events in World History	Jim Schneider/ Robert Morgan	<p>Worldwide pandemics, weapons of mass destruction, the push for globalization, worldwide conflict, the world...all of this is part of our world today and foretold in the book of Revelation. You know with all the globe, it's hard not to wonder: Is this the end times? The book of Revelation tells us about the world, find it too intimidating to understand and so they may bypass what it has to say. The guest on this edition released a book that demystifies Revelation so that you can embrace the hope and assurance it offers. Robert Morgan is a writer, speaker and pastor. He has more than 35 books in print with around 5 million in circulation. 3 volumes of <i>Then Sings My Soul</i> provide us hymn history. We've also interviewed him re <i>Bible Verses That Made America: Defining Moments That Shaped Our Enduring Foundation of Faith, Jordan River Rules</i> and this broadcast concerning his latest book, <i>The 50 Final Events in World History on Earth's Final Days</i>.</p> <p>Why do so many shy away from the book of Revelation? Robert admitted it can be a intimidating book that it's actually quite simple if you look at it in a linear sequence concerning the things that will happen. The symbols tend to be interpreted as we read it. Also, the name of the book is not obscurity or confusion the first verse says, "This is the revelation of Jesus Christ which he gave to his servants to show them where he will place." So it stands to reason that God would want us to understand the Bible's last book, and if there were needs to understand it, it's ours.</p> <p>Robert also noted that the other 65 books of the Bible lead to Revelation and all 22 chapters of Revelation is a wonderful book to study.</p> <p>What about those who believe prophecy doesn't matter? Robert responded that if it doesn't matter, then the Bible made up of prophecy? There's the prophecy in the Old Testament books. Jesus himself devoted time telling us what would happen in the future, Paul devoted 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Thessalonians to prophecy, Peter devoted time to prophecy and then there's the entire book of Revelation. So the Bible contains literally thousands of pages of information. All of this is to communicate that things will end up right where he wants them as he has promised eternity what for you and me. 4/20	Pending SCOTUS Decision on Abortion & The Faces of Roe	Jim Schneider/ Brad Mattes	<p>The numbers are hard to fathom, but it's being reported that since the Roe v Wade Supreme Court decision there have been over 63.7 million abortions. That's more than 63.7 million babies who received a death sentence if they existed. We cannot forget what God told Jeremiah as recorded in <a href="#">Jeremiah 1:5</a>, "Before I formed thee in the womb, and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto me; and thou shalt say, I have rebelled against my Creator, 7 of the 9 sitting justices on the Supreme Court in 1973 invented a right to abortion for an innocent human being without a penalty.</p> <p>The tide is turning in our nation and very soon we are awaiting another decision of the U.S. Supreme Court on a case that has been going on for nearly 50 years.</p> <p>Joining Jim to discuss the latest aspect of this battle was Brad Mattes. Brad is the president of Life Issues Institute, a grassroots partner of the Susan B. Anthony List Education Fund. Life Issues Institute was founded in 1991 to address the educational needs of the pro-life movement. Brad is the host of Life Issues, a daily radio commentary and a radio special: The Faces of Roe.</p> <p>On December 1, The U.S. Supreme Court heard oral arguments in what was called the biggest abortion case since Roe v. Wade. That case is <i>Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization</i>. This was legislation passed in Mississippi in 2019 in a fashion that would end abortion once the unborn child reached the age of 15 weeks in the womb. This is a direct challenge to the Roe and Wade decisions.</p> <p>An appellate court deemed it unconstitutional but the Supreme Court decided to hear this case. According to Brad, a clear indication that they had something else to say about this law. As Brad listened to the oral arguments, he became confident that he'd see the court uphold this law. In fact, he's cautiously optimistic that this could end Roe.</p> <p>Brad's optimism is based upon Supreme Court Justice Brett Kavanaugh who came prepared for the oral arguments and decisions from that court that had been reversed. They partnered with the Munich Security Conference to conduct a tabletop exercise that concerned reducing high-consequence biological threats. On page 10 of the report, they discussed a possible monkeypox outbreak on May 15<sup>th</sup> of 2022 in the fictional country of Brinia. This is interesting when you consider that the first case of monkeypox was reported around May 2022 in Belgium. This was the first nation to introduce a compulsory monkeypox quarantine. In other words, anyone with a suspected case of monkeypox needs to isolate for 21 days. By May 26<sup>th</sup> at least 200 confirmed cases and over 100 suspected cases were reported in Australia and the U.S.</p> <p>Then on May 20<sup>th</sup>, the Biden administration had ordered 13 million additional doses of the monkeypox vaccine. This was something all of us should be concerned about. Was the tabletop exercise and what followed a mere coincidence?</p> <p>Returning to Crosstalk to provide answers was Barbara Loe Fisher. Barbara is the president of the National Vaccine Information Center (NVIC), a non-profit charity she co-founded with parents of DPT vaccine injured children. She is a national, grassroots movement and public information campaign to institute vaccine safety reforms and strengthen protections in the public health system. She has researched, analyzed and publicly articulated the major issues in vaccine science, policy, law, ethics and politics of vaccination to become one of the world's leading non-medical experts on the subject.</p> <p>According to Barbara, one of the reasons people are talking about monkeypox is because there are rumors that the current strain is genetically altered in bio-hazard labs in China and elsewhere. Health officials deny this and they point to the current strain that link this disease to past outbreaks. However, we all know about the controversy surrounding the use of SARS CoV-2 and that it was potentially genetically engineered in Wuhan, China.</p> <p>Barbara reported that currently there are about 600 cases of monkeypox reported in 30 countries. About 90% are in the U.S.</p> <p>Monkeypox is an orthopox virus like smallpox. It causes open lesions and blisters on the skin. It can be transmitted through close, personal contact with open lesions or body fluids. The symptoms are milder than smallpox and include fever, chickenpox, shingles or other diseases that cause skin lesions. There have been no reported deaths in the U.S. As this program moved along, Barbara shared more on what she knows about this strange new disease. She also spoke to the World Health Organization and how they might affect U.S. health policies, the latest on the COVID-19 pandemic, approximately 10,000 adverse events been removed from the Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System (VAERS) and much more.</p>
6/2	WHO & New Pandemic Treaty... There's More to Come	Jim Schneider / Mat Staver	<p>Mat Staver is the founder and chairman of Liberty Counsel. Mat is a constitutional attorney with hundreds of published opinions. He's authored a number of scholarly law review publications and numerous books. He's also been argued in many federal and state courts and before the U.S. Supreme Court.</p> <p>Last week at the World Health Assembly, there was a resounding defeat for President Joe Biden. He proposed amendments to the WHO's international health regulations. These are additional amendments that he hoped to add to the 1968 International Health Regulations. All 13 of those failed. If they had passed, they would have given the World Health Organization the authority to declare global public health emergencies.</p> <p>The battle, however, is not over. Here's a brief description from Mat of what's to come concerning WHO. The World Health Assembly will have a meeting this month where they will be pursuing two tracks at the meeting. On 16-17 they will discuss a new pandemic treaty that is in the process of being drafted. This is being pursued by the WHO. On 19. They reason that if the WHO had greater international enforcement authority, they would have been able to manage the management of the pandemic.</p> <p>Then on August 1, the working draft of the pandemic treaty will be submitted. It's at that time that we'll see if it passes. At this point we do know that they've been calling for increased global enforcement authority. This will be discussed at the next World Health Assembly meeting in May of 2023.</p> <p>September 30<sup>th</sup> is the deadline for presenting amendments to the international health regulations. On October 1, the WHO General Dr. Tedros Ghebreyesus will convene a committee to make technical recommendations to the WHO. She also served as molecular pathology inspector for the College of American Pathologists and scientific consultant, including the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner, Children's Hospital of Wisconsin, and The University of Wisconsin. The U.S. Supreme Court will soon be releasing their decision on <i>Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization</i>. According to a leaked draft, will also reverse the 1973 <i>Roe v. Wade</i> decision.</p> <p>There have been massive intimidation tactics employed to somehow persuade a justice to switch their vote. There has been vandalism, and violence have been unleashed by pro-abortion extremists against pro-life organizations across the country.</p> <p>Some feel the nation is at a boiling point. House Speaker Nancy Pelosi has said, pertaining to abortion, that the country has changed since the <i>Roe v. Wade</i> decision, but politics have changed. Today's guest, with her scientific background, is against this statement.</p>

This broadcast discusses his most current release, a very fascinating book, <i>Foreshadows: 12 Months Before the Return is Nearer Than Ever</i>.</p> <p>Steve explained that he used the term <i>Foreshadows</i> in the title because the book looks at trends indicating the end-times. So while he believes we're not currently in the end-times (that's kicked off when Israel signed a 7 year peace treaty), the events that will take place during that time are casting their shadow into the present. He uses the analogy of a wedding. For example, he noted that a wedding doesn't just happen spontaneously. A lot of preparation goes into making it happen. So each activity that takes place prior to the wedding is of the wedding that's yet to come. In a similar sense, there are a lot of things that the Bible says will take place before the return of Christ.</p> <p>What's different about today? After all, people for many generations have anticipated the Lord's return. We're seeing a great convergence. 6/22	Day of the Christian Martyr: John Chau	Jim Schneider / Todd Nettleton	<p>Todd Nettleton is the Chief of Media Relations and Message Integration for the Voice of the Martyrs-USA. He serves as a voice for persecuted Christians, inspiring Christians and Christ's followers in over 70 nations where they face persecution for being a follower of Jesus Christ. He is the author of <i>Forbidden: 40 Days on the Frontlines with Persecuted Christians</i>.</p> <p>What is the significance of June 29<sup>th</sup>? Todd indicated that according to church history it's the day that John the Baptist was beheaded outside Rome. For those at the Voice of the Martyrs it's a day to think about those who've sacrificed for the cause of Christ and to get us to think what it's worth to see the advance of the Gospel. What would you do to see that happen?</p> <p>This year, Voice of the Martyrs is retelling the story of John Chau. John was a young man who was called to go to North Sentinel Island which he eventually did in 2018. This is an island outside of India known as North Sentinel Island. John went there to get acquainted with the Sentinelese people who had been completely unreachable for decades. John was "all in" concerning this effort. For example, through college he took cold showers because he didn't have hot water on the island. He got lasik surgery on his eyes because he knew he wouldn't be able to properly see without lenses. He received linguistics training as well as becoming certified as an EMT to hopefully serve the Sentinelese. The examples show that for John, every decision was part of his focus toward being obedient to God's call to go to that island.</p> <p>John had a "Plan A" and a "Plan B". What were those plans and what did this attempt cost him? Review the story and then consider what the Lord may be calling you to do to help spread the Gospel of Christ.</p> <p>This Crosstalk also included discussion concerning Christian persecution in Nigeria, Eritrea and Vietnam. It also touched on the conversion of an Imam in Bangladesh.</p>
6/23	SCOTUS, Uvalde & Other Gun Issues	Jim Schneider / Michael Letts	<p>Michael Letts is the founder, president &amp; CEO of In-Vest USA, a national grassroots non-profit organization that provides hundreds of communities with thousands of bulletproof vests for their police forces through education, training, sponsorship and fundraising programs.</p> <p>A 6-3 decision came down today from the Supreme Court in the case of <i>New York State Rifle &amp; Pistol Association v. Bruen</i>. The court said that the state's law for carrying firearms violates the 14<sup>th</sup> amendment.</p> <p>Michael expressed his appreciation for the court's interpretation that makes sure American's have the right to own a firearm which is exactly what our founding fathers intended.</p> <p>He also pointed to the fact that President Biden's administration, among others, argue that you shouldn't have certain types of weapons. Michael believes this goes against the purpose of the Second Amendment which is to ensure citizens have the ability to fulfill their duty to oppose tyranny and oppressive government.</p> <p>This makes America unique. For example, Jim noted recent comments from Justin Trudeau, the Prime Minister of Canada, indicated that guns are only for hunting and they may not be used for self-defense.</p>

			<p>So what impact will this ruling have beyond New York? Michael believes this shows citizens are beginning to realize that they have the ability to determine America's future and that we will, by God's grace, prevail. Michael also commented on the "red flag" aspect of gun legislation coming up for a vote in Congress, the at Uvalde, George Soros, the defund-the-police movement and more. Mat is a constitutional attorney with three law firms in the U.S. Supreme Court.</p> <p>This morning a landmark decision was handed down from the Supreme Court. With Justice Alito writing the majority opinion and joined by Thomas, Gorsuch, Kavanaugh and Barrett, the court overturned Roe v. Wade as well as the precedent set by the Parenthood of Southeastern Pennsylvania v. Robert P. Casey decision.</p> <p>In less than 60 minutes following the court's decision, Missouri, which had a "trigger law" on the books, immediately went into effect as Attorney General Eric Schmidt, signed such a statement.</p> <p>Others states have laws on the books that were never repealed when Roe went into effect. So while they were put on "temporary" hiatus by Roe, since they were never removed from the books, those are coming back into effect today's repealing of Roe.</p> <p>Mat explained that there are those who want to pass federal legislation that would impose abortion on the states. He believes we'll see crazy things from the Biden administration to try and force states to include abortion in Medicaid or Medicare. Then there's also the battle at the state level.</p> <p>This single news story has many aspects to pay attention to. Wade, at least 12 states which began protecting lives with more to come on July 24th when the statutory 30-day waiting period has been fulfilled. Also <i>LifeNews.com</i> is reporting that at least 40 abortion facilities have halted abortions, including scheduling appointments.</p> <p>On today's program, we'll have discussion on the aftermath of last Friday's decision, and we'll take a look at the Supreme Court decisions this month. We are also going to look at the Biden Administration's attempt to force states to destroy girls sports when it was originally crafted to save girls sports.</p>
6/29	Adult Death Surge, Shots for Babies: What's Happening?	Jim Schneider / Dr. Elizabeth Lee Vliet	<p>Dr. Elizabeth Lee Vliet is the president and CEO of Truth for Health Foundation, a non-profit public health organization. In 2020, she's been part of the team of frontline physicians treating COVID early at home. With Dr. Peter Dinkov, co-author/editor of the <i>Guide to COVID Early Treatment: Options to Stay Out of Hospital and Save Your Life</i>, she received her 2014 Ellis Island Medal of Honor recipient for her national and international educational efforts in health care. She is a past director of the Association of American Physicians and Surgeons. She received her M.D. degree and internship in Internal Medicine at Eastern Virginia Medical School and completed her residency at Johns Hopkins. She appeared on Crosstalk as an independent physician, not as a spokesperson for any pharmaceutical company, insurance plans or political party. She is a patient advocate.</p> <p>After giving her views on the recent repealing of Roe v. Wade, Dr. Vliet exposed listeners to some interesting statistics concerning COVID shots. She described a drop of 8-11% in the range of live births in the first quarter of 2022 in Germany, Norway and several U.S. states. This means the COVID shots are resulting in the prevention of live births and infertility.</p> <p>Then there's the death rate for millennials (those ages 18-44). There were 61,000 deaths in 9 months of 2022. That's compared to 58,000 deaths in the 10 years of the Vietnam War in the same age group. Jim also noted some interesting statistics from Dr. Joseph Mercola. In looking at data from the International Olympic Committee, he showed that there were 1,101 sudden deaths in athletes under the age of 35 between 1960 and 2020, an average annual rate of 29 deaths across all sports. However, from March of 2021 to March of 2022, at least 100 athletes suffered cardiac arrest, collapsed or just died on the field worldwide.</p>
