The mantra in society today is often what we see communicated by Satan in Genesis 3:1 —"Yea hath God said?" The result is that many are turning their backs on God's Word and the result is that great efforts have been underway to remove God from the halls of government and academia. This has even impacted the church as many have gone "woke" and become soft on such issues. Ken described how this goes hand-in-hand with the generational loss in the church. Less than 9% of Generation "Z" attends church whereas if you go back to the 1700's, 75-80% of the population attended church in America. So it was December of 1993 that Answers in Genesis became legally incorporated due to the concern from Ken and his co-founders over the spiritual erosion that was taking place and the attack upon the authority of God's Word. 1/4	Critical Court Cases on the Horizon	Jim Schneider/ Mat Staver	<p>There are some very significant matters facing appellate courts as well as the U.S. Supreme Court for 2024. With a review of the past year as well as what's ahead, Crosstalk welcomed Mat Staver. He is founder & chairman of Liberty Counsel. Mat is a constitutional attorney with three landmark cases before the U.S. Supreme Court. He's an author and the host of the radio broadcasts <i>Faith & Freedom</i> and <i>Freedom's Call</i>.</p> <p>Discussion began with Mat commenting on the case of <i>Ermold v. Davis</i>. In this case, Liberty Counsel will be filing a motion to set aside the jury verdict against former Rowan County Kentucky Clerk Kim Davis who was sued by two same-sex couples for not issuing them marriage licenses. Mat believes there was insufficient evidence to award damages to the plaintiffs. If the motion is denied, Liberty Counsel will also file an appeal which would take it to the Court of Appeals. Mat believes this case could rise to the level of overturning <i>Obergefell</i>.</p> <p>Other critical cases Mat referred to involved one where the court shut down the affirmative action for college admissions. This overruled a precedent that goes back to 1978. There was also the overruling of a 1977 case (<i>Trans World Airlines</i>) regarding religious discrimination in the workplace. There was the overturning of both the 1973 <i>Roe v. Wade</i> decision and also the 1971 <i>Lemon v. Kurtzman</i> decision, the latter of which did immense damage to the First Amendment.</p> <p>Mat also sees action at the appellate and Supreme Court levels with cases that began in 2023. One is in regard to the government's coercion of private, social media entities, requiring/forcing them to censor the private speech of individuals. This involves speech concerning COVID-19 shots, the lock-downs, the withdrawal from Afghanistan, the elections, etc.</p> <p>Another big case from 2023 that will spill over into 2024 is the abortion pill decision from the Court of Appeals.</p> <p>The cases mentioned here are just some of what was discussed in the first quarter hour. 1/5	News Roundup & Comment	Jim Schneider	<p>Coast to coast and around the globe, Jim wrapped up the week by presenting key news stories, some of which are listed below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Ohio Republican Governor Mike DeWine banned transgender transition surgeries on minors today with an executive order. The move comes just a week after he vetoed a bill that would have banned the practice and required single-sex sports teams to be established at schools, colleges and universities throughout the state. -More information is coming out concerning the school shooting that took place in Perry, Iowa, yesterday morning. The alleged shooter had posted on Tik Tok. Those that were able to obtain screen shots of his online presence shows he had a pride flag in his Tik Tok bio and has allegedly participated in a transgender Reddit group. -Hamas fired at least 27 rockets at the south and center of Israel as the nation attempted to celebrate the start of the New Year. -Israeli Defense Forces announced Monday the killing of Hamas Commander Adil Mismah who took part in the October 7th invasion of Israel. -Saleh L. Arouri, Deputy Chairman of the Hamas Political Bureau, was killed in an explosion in Southern Beirut on Tuesday. -Israel began withdrawing thousands of troops from Gaza as prolonged fighting is expected to continue. -Ismail Haniyeh, the leader of the Palestinian resistance group Hamas's Political Bureau, said that they're open to the idea of a national unity government to run the Gaza Strip and the West Bank. -ISIS is claiming responsibility for the suicide bomb attacks in Iran this week. -More than a dozen nations have issued an ultimatum to Yemen's Iranian-backed Houthis after the militant group fired two anti-ship ballistic missiles in the Southern Red Sea. -The TSA is monitoring a potential terror threat against the U.S. from an affiliate of Al Qaeda known as the AQAP. -Over 100 anti-Israeli protesters shut down the California Assembly on Wednesday during its first legislative session of the year. -Hundreds of godless Marxists and pro-Palestinian protesters took over historic Boston Common on New Year's Eve chanting, "Biden, Biden, pick a side. Cease-fire or genocide." -Many Texans living at the border say they are fed up and want Congress to shut down the border. -The Justice Department is suing Texas over Governor Abbott's new law that authorizes state authorities to arrest and deport illegal immigrants, arguing the state is overstepping its bounds by implementing immigration policy which only the federal government has the authority to do. -Republicans are taking the first steps to formally impeach Homeland Security Secretary Mayorkas for his handling of the southern border crisis.

In spite of that, various mandates came forth along with a lot of "arm-twisting" to get people vaccinated.</p> <p>The result is growing skepticism toward government agencies and now, 3 years since the COVID vaccine was released, there are more concerns including the lack of timely transparency on the part of pharmaceutical companies.</p> <p>To bring listeners an update on these issues, Crosstalk welcomed Barbara Loe Fisher. Barbara is president of the National Vaccine Information Center (NVIC), a non-profit charity she co-founded with parents of DPT vaccine injured children in 1982. NVIC is a national, grassroots movement and public information campaign to institute vaccine safety reforms and informed consent protections in the public health system. She has researched, analyzed and publicly articulated the major issues involving the science, policy, law, ethics and politics of vaccination to become one of the world's leading non-medical, consumer advocacy experts on the subject.</p> <p>Barbara began by noting there's a lot of push-back on the mRNA vaccines. She described how last month, Texas Attorney General Ken Paxton sued Pfizer over its mRNA COVID vaccine, saying that the company misled the public by claiming that it had an efficacy rate of 95% against the SARS CoV-2 virus. Barbara and her organization knew that the FDA had only required Pfizer and Moderna to show that there was a reduction in symptoms of COVID, not actual prevention. Instead the public was told that if we got the vaccine, we wouldn't get COVID nor would we transmit the infection to others.</p> <p>So the Texas lawsuit is seeking 10 million in fines against Pfizer for willfully and unlawfully committing false, unsupported and misleading acts, practices and claims and misrepresenting the effectiveness of the COVID-19 vaccine.</p> <p>Then there's the issue of the censoring of public discussion about the vaccine that's also a part of this lawsuit. All along there's been concerns regarding the response policies by government (lock-downs, social distancing, masks, etc.). People and organizations that questioned the vaccines and these policies were basically muzzled. In fact, when the NVIC attempted to inform the public concerning the truth behind the mRNA vaccines, they were taken off of all four major social media platforms in 2021.</p> <p>Barbara conducted a 3 month investigation as to who was involved in this effort. She found that the agencies involved run much deeper than the Department of Health and Human Services. Also involved in the censorship campaign were the Department of Defense, the Department of Homeland Security, the CIA, the FBI, as well as the governments of other nations.</p> <p>Barbara shared much more on this issue, while callers had their opportunity to respond as well.</p>

That is followed by the Democratic primary in South Carolina on February 3rd. Nevada is next with their caucus and then Michigan votes on February 27th. Super Tuesday is March 5th, the Republican convention is in July, the Democrats have their convention in August and it all wraps up on election day which is November 5th.</p> <p>Jim indicated he believes that as Christians and citizens of the United States, we have been granted a stewardship. We have what many people in other nations do not have. It's the right to vote and we can either squander it or use this stewardship for the glory of God. Also, with that vote we can either uphold biblical truth or vote to work against it. So how will you use the stewardship of your vote?</p> <p>As Samuel Adams once said:</p>

			<p>“Let each citizen remember at the moment he is offering his vote that he is not making a present or a compliment to please an individual—or at least that he ought not so to do; but that he is executing one of the most solemn trusts in human society for which he is accountable to God and his country.”</p> <p>Also, consider this from Proverbs 21:1:</p> <p>“The king’s heart is in the hand of the LORD, as the rivers of water: he turneth it whithersoever he will.”</p> <p>It’s with these thoughts in mind that Jim opened the phone lines to allow listeners from across the nation to express who they’re voting for to be president and why.</p>
1/10	Globalist Agenda: Looking Back, Looking Forward	Jim Schneider/ Gary Kah	<p>The globalist agenda never gives up. It backs off for a while only to be repackaged in another wrapper. However, its goals always remain the same because it strikes at national sovereignty, taking every opportunity to gain central power in its desire to dominate the lives and liberties of people around the world.</p> <p>To prove this point via the latest news on this subject, Jim welcomed back Gary Kah. Gary is founder and director of Hope for the World. Gary is Editor of <i>Hope for the World Update</i>. He’s an author and former Europe & Middle East Trade Specialist for the Indiana State Government.</p> <p>Gary began with comments concerning Israel’s war with Hamas. He believes that the timing of this war is not coincidental and that it’s intended to set the stage, through fear and panic, for a lunge into a more globalist system.</p> <p>This war has a lot of “moving pieces” and Gary shared what they’re up to as he noted that 10 top Iranian generals took up positions in Syria, so Iran is basically running things there. Also, unlike Hamas, Hezbollah has over 120,000 precision guided rockets and missiles to launch at Israel. So right now all the weapons are coming from Iran, through Syria, and into southern Lebanon and if Hezbollah ramps up their efforts, Israel is going to have to respond and that might mean going after Syria.</p> <p>Complicating matters are the Russian advisers that Gary indicated have been there all along. This means that if Russia and Iran become part of the war, while simultaneously you have the Russia/Ukraine war taking place, this could grow into something much larger than a regional conflict.</p> <p>Another major point of conversation concerned COP28 that was held in Dubai in November/December. The name comes from the fact that it was the 28th meeting of the “Conference of the Parties.” This dealt with the environment which is part of the larger one-world agenda.</p> <p>Gary explained that many people aren’t aware of the fact that the UK played a major role in this and that King Charles is seen as the de-facto leader of the global environmental movement.</p> <p>The official COP28 global mandates were to go into effect on December 13, the day after the Dubai meeting ended. That launched a 7 year plan for full implementation by the end of 2030 in line with the U.N.’s 2030 agenda.</p> <p>Gary shared much more including details on the U.N. Summit of the Future, slated for September, that seeks to put forth a stronger international response to global shocks. They want emergency powers to become a governing global body and any member nation of the World Health Organization would be obliged to go along with whatever the U.N. does.</p> <p>Stay on the cutting edge as Gary brings you the latest news concerning U.N. world health, environment and world government activities.</p>
1/11	The Border: Trafficking, Terrorism, and Trauma	Jim Schneider/ Mark Krikorian	<p>Last week, Speaker of the House Mike Johnson led the largest congressional delegation ever to the border. It consisted of 64 House Republicans representing 26 states and one U.S. territory. He said that there’s no order at the border. It’s completely open and what was seen was so alarming, it would break the hearts of every American and infuriate them as well.</p> <p>Returning to Crosstalk with an update on this vital issue was Mark Krikorian. Mark is a nationally recognized expert on immigration issues serving as the executive director of the Center for Immigration Studies. They are an independent, non-partisan research organization examining and critiquing the impact of immigration on the United States. He’s testified numerous times before Congress and has published articles in many outlets.</p> <p>How bad is the immigration problem? According to Mark it’s really bad. In terms of numbers, he indicated it’s at almost 300,000 illegals entering the U.S. per month. This has occurred because both during the campaign and through almost 3 years of his policies, President Biden basically invited people who have no right to come here to cross the border and turn themselves in, at which point they’re let go.</p> <p>Last week, Homeland Security Secretary Alejandro Mayorkas admitted that over 85% of those who show up at the border are let go. Mark believes it’s almost certainly over 90%. They’re here, they’re not going to leave on their own, and Mark feels this administration isn’t going to make sure that they do leave. The result is historically unprecedented numbers of individuals crossing the border. They’re not fleeing war, prosecution or climate change as the administration tries to say. Instead, they’re trekking through up to five different countries to arrive here because they know they can get away with it.</p> <p>Mark explained that we need to have a combination of physical barriers along with legal and policy barriers. This means that the people that do get through don’t succeed and don’t get away with it. In other words, under bad policies, all the walls in the world don’t matter. This is why he believes the root cause of this is President Biden and not some exterior force that’s happening to the U.S. His administration is unwilling to enforce immigration law because it believes that such law is immoral.</p> <p>Then there’s the issue of drug cartels and smugglers who rent out children because under President Biden’s policies, if someone has a child with them, while not 100% certain, it’s very likely that they’ll be let go.</p> <p>They’re also trafficking kids. While there will always be some activity of this kind, certain immigration policies make this possible. Biden’s policies are particularly problematic because there’s no DNA testing to make certain that if you bring a child with you it can be shown that you’re telling the truth. This and other things under the Biden administration have facilitated what Mark described as, “large scale human trafficking, especially of children; sometimes sex trafficking, sometimes labor trafficking.”</p> <p>This is an overview of just the first quarter hour of information. Mark presented much more, and listeners added their thoughts, on this edition of Crosstalk.</p>

Here’s a sample of what Jim presented this week from the news desk:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> —Tomorrow, in Washington, D.C., Hamas supporters are planning a big jihad jamboree at the National Mall called, “The March on Washington for Gaza.” It’s being sponsored by every jihadi partner of the Muslim Brotherhood in America. —325 pro-Palestinian protestors were arrested after blocking 3 bridges and a tunnel in New York City on Monday, blocking lanes bound for New Jersey on the Holland Tunnel along with blocking traffic on the Brooklyn, Manhattan and Williamsburg bridges. —Wednesday was the first day of a new session of the Colorado State House and immediately, pro-Hamas demonstrators set the tone by disrupting the proceedings as Colorado House Speaker Julie McCluskie did nothing. —Over the weekend, pro-Palestinian demonstrators defaced the Los Angeles National Cemetery. —The Justice Department has effectively issued a stand-down order to federal law enforcement and U.S. attorneys to stop them from investigating incitement, violence and vandalism committed by Hamas supporters who hold U.S. visas, according to a complaint filed with the Justice Department. —A member of Congress investigating the January 6th, 2021, protests at the Capitol estimates that the FBI had 200 undercover assets both inside and outside the building. —Matthew Graves, the U.S. attorney for the District of Columbia, suggested that law enforcement will soon target those who merely stood outside the Capitol on January 6th. —The United States and Britain carried out a series of air strikes on military locations belonging to Iran-backed Houthis in Yemen earlier today. —President Biden said he authorized the strikes in direct response to unprecedented Houthi attacks against international maritime vessels in the Red Sea, including the use of anti-ship ballistic missiles for the first time in history.

			<p>—The Houthi leader Abdul-Malik al-Houthi vowed in a televised speech that any U.S. attack on Yemen’s Houthis would not go without a response.</p> <p>—U.S. officials said there’s an escalating risk that Lebanese Hezbollah militants will strike Americans in the Middle East, but more concerning is that they could hit inside the United States.</p> <p>—Secretary of Defense Lloyd Austin went missing for 4 days this month, apparently for hospitalization, and most of Washington, including President Biden, had no idea who was running the Pentagon. In addition, his deputy who’s required to step in was at a beach in Puerto Rico where she was on vacation.</p> <p>—Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu of Israel said he has no intention of permanently occupying Gaza or displacing its civilian population.</p> <p>—The Israel Defense Forces admitted that damage was caused to a sensitive air traffic control base in northern Israel following a Hezbollah missile attack a day earlier which the terror group said was a response to the alleged Israeli killing of senior Hamas official Saleh al-Arouri in Lebanon last week.</p> <p>—Yesterday, Hunter Biden pleaded not guilty to federal tax charges brought by Special Counsel David Weiss. Biden entered the plea during his arraignment at a Los Angeles courthouse on 9 felony and misdemeanor tax charges that Weiss filed in December.</p> <p>Jim presented other stories looking at the Russia/Ukraine war, President Trump, China and more!</p>
1/15	Christian Persecution Abounds	Jim Schneider/ Todd Nettleton	<p>From Stephen to the Apostle Paul to a man named Jason who assisted Paul, for 2,000 years, followers of Jesus Christ have been persecuted. Paul told Timothy that those who live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.</p> <p>What we must realize is that persecution isn’t simply something that happened during biblical times. Right now, in 2024, there are those who are suffering on account of their faith, but often we become so caught up in the activities and concerns of our everyday life that we lose sight of this reality.</p> <p>Returning to Crosstalk to once again open our eyes to the reality of Christian persecution, Jim welcomed Todd Nettleton. Todd is the Chief of Media Relations and Message Integration for the Voice of the Martyrs-USA and is also the host of <i>The Voice of the Martyrs Radio</i>. He serves as a voice for persecuted Christians, inspiring Christians with the faithfulness of Christ’s followers in over 70 nations where they face persecution for being a follower of Jesus Christ. Todd is author of <i>Forbidden: 40 Days on the Frontlines with Persecuted Christians</i>.</p> <p>Todd presented much information during this update dealing with numerous nations. Particularly notable are those that for some reason failed to make the State Department’s list of nations of particular concern. Review this program and you’ll hear the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The nation of India has been reclassified to “restricted nation” status. • The attacks against Christians in Nigeria. • The Taliban and their persecution of Christians as they rule Afghanistan. • Todd communicated that North Korea is probably the most closed nation on earth where Christians are singled out for the greatest persecution. • Why Chinese pastors are being accused of crimes unrelated to religion. • Should we be concerned about Europe? <p>Listeners were given an opportunity to air their questions/concerns as well.</p>
1/16	Foundational Truths	Jim Schneider/ Israel Wayne	<p>It’s not unusual to hear about entire homes that have collapsed due to an insufficient foundation. So here’s a question: As it applies to your life, how strong is your spiritual foundation? What about the spiritual foundation of your family? Sadly, there have been tragedies due to a lack of a sure foundation even in Christian homes.</p> <p>Joining Jim to discuss a resource that can help you develop a strong foundation was Israel Wayne. Israel and his wife Brook are homeschooling parents to eleven children. He is also an author and conference speaker who has a passion for defending the Christian faith and promoting a biblical worldview. He’s the author of several books including: <i>Education: Does God Have an Opinion?</i>; <i>Pitchin’ A Fit! He noted how he had the chance to interview Dr. George Barna, the leading researcher on all things related to the church in the U.S. Barna’s latest research shows that only 1% of people under the age of 29 in the U.S. have a basic, foundational, biblical worldview. This shows that Christian families and churches have not been effective when it comes to passing on the Christian faith and its values to the next generation.</p> <p>So why all the biblical illiteracy when copies of the Bible are plentiful and we’re inundated with Christian literature, Christian broadcasting, podcasts, etc? Israel believes it’s because parents have not taken their biblical mandate to disciple their children seriously. They’ve left it up to the church to do that for them and that hasn’t worked. For some, this is all about liberating "Palestine," giving them title to the land. In Genesis 12 we see how God called Abraham and told him about a very specific area of land that He was going to give to the Jewish people. Genesis 15 gives the actual borders and that land includes 90% more land than the Jewish people have today. Then you can see the land covenant that God gave to Israel in Deuteronomy 30:1-5. So the premise that this land belongs to the Palestinians is false. According to the Bible it never was and never will be their land. • The atrocity-denying, 16 page publication that gives the Hamas narrative and claims that Palestinians are the ones that have been exploited in all of this. • The plan by Hamas to stop production of red heifers for the cleansing of the 3rd Temple. • Israel is being accused of genocide because approximately 25,000 Palestinians have died in the war. In verse 5 it warns of those “having a form of godliness.” And then in verse 13 Paul warns, “But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived.”</p> <p>There is mass deception going on throughout the world today and it is not limited to the United Nations, the World Economic Forum, or the World Health Organization. 1/3 0	Erwin Lutzer Rally – “We Will Not Bow”	Dalton Windsor	<p>Dr. Erwin Lutzer spoke at the Waukesha Expo for the VCY America Rally on March 18th, 2023. His topic was <i>We Will Not Bow</i>. Dr. Lutzer is Pastor Emeritus of The Moody Church where he served as the senior pastor for 36 years. He’s the speaker on the radio programs <i>Running to Win</i> and <i>Songs in the Night</i>. He is a speaker and an award-winning author on several books. Some of his titles include <i>The Cross in the Shadow of the Crescent</i>, <i>Life Changing Bible Verses You Should Know</i>, <i>We Will Not Be Silenced</i>, <i>No Reason to Hide</i> and <i>The Power of a Clear Conscience</i>.</p> <p>Dr. Lutzer began by mentioning Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn who told an interesting story. Solzhenitsyn said that in 1937 a speech was given by someone who extolled the virtues and the greatness of Stalin. When he finished, everyone rose to clap. Solzhenitsyn described how this went on for several minutes. Under such circumstances, who’s going to sit down first? After 11 minutes of non-stop clapping, the director of a paper factory stopped his clapping and sat down. Everyone else then stopped as well and sat down. That same night the director of the paper factory was arrested and sent to prison for 10 years. During his interrogation he was told never to be the first one to stop clapping.</p> <p>Dr. Lutzer said, “How does freedom die? Solzhenitsyn would say with thunderous applause; everybody clapping at the Soviet system.” Dr. Lutzer then asked if America is being “sovietized”? Victor Davis Hanson asked that question and he indicated that in the Soviet Union it wasn’t merit that enabled people to climb the ladder. Instead, it was loud enthusiasm for the communist system. Today, if you want to teach at a university, you’ll be asked if you’re willing to “sign-on” to the diversity studies, identifying people via multiple pronouns and are you “on-board” with the LGBTQ community. He began his legal career through the Attorney General’s Honors Program as a clerk to an Administrative Law Judge in the Office of the Chief Administrative Hearing Officer at the United States Department of Justice, Executive Office for Immigration Review. Later in his career he was promoted to the Immigration and Naturalization Service General Counsel’s Office in D.C., first as an Associate General Counsel, then as an Assistant General Counsel and Acting Chief of the INS National Security Law Division. In the General Counsel’s Office, he supervised attorneys handling cases involving espionage, terrorism, and persecutors. After 5 years there, he was appointed to the immigration bench serving for eight years as an Immigration Judge at the York Immigration Court in York, Pennsylvania. At the beginning of the 114th Congress, Judge Arthur left the bench and came back to Capitol Hill, where he served as Staff Director of the National Security Subcommittee at House Oversight and Government Reform before taking retirement from federal service in 2016.</p> <p>Crosstalk continues to monitor progress on our nation’s southern border because many believe this to be a national security issue. There were only 2,000 in 2022 and 342 in 2021. This makes them the fastest growing illegal entries.

2/21	The Healing Church – Vicory over Pornography	Jim Schneider/ Sam Black	<p>At younger and younger ages, people are being exposed to pornography. The impact is being carried through the teen years and into adulthood. Many secretly struggle with porn and those inside the church are not exempt. Too often local churches ignore this problem with some not wanting to admit its existence. For others it's a lack of knowing how to deal with it and help those trapped by it.</p> <p>Marriages have been shattered, families have been broken and the vocational livelihoods of many have been ruined by pornography and according to the guest on this Crosstalk, there is great risk in doing nothing.</p> <p>Sam Black is a renowned author and expert in the field of pornography recovery. He is the author of <i>The Healing Church: What Churches Get Wrong About Pornography and How to Fix It</i> and <i>The Porn Circuit: Understand Your Brain and Break Porn Habits</i>. He regularly speaks at parenting, leadership and men's events across the country. He is Director of Recovery Education at Covenant Eyes.</p> <p>Sam began looking at this issue by explaining what Jesus said about lust and what's impactful to our hearts. Jesus said that if you look at another with lust in your heart you've committed adultery. If that's you, you must think what's causing you to objectify someone else because as Christians, that's what pornography is to us.</p> <p>What does Sam believe is causing this great proliferation of porn? He believes we've been on a steady march from the 1950's. In the 80's there was VHS video, the '90's brought us the internet and in 2007 came the iPhone. This means that today, if we have a smart phone, we're literally carrying around the world's largest library of pornography ever created in the history of mankind. As we allow our kids to use these devices, they become exposed to the pornography that's on them in various forms and it infiltrates their lives.</p> <p>Sam noted that depending upon which study you look at, the average age children are at when first exposed to pornography is when they're between 8 and 12. So today, kids can go from not knowing anything about sexuality to hard-core, ugly, abusive, violent and degrading pornography. It's very shocking and confusing to them.</p> <p>Looking at this from the adult perspective, two-thirds of Christian men and about one-third of Christian women say they have an ongoing struggle with porn. Some 69% of pastors say porn has adversely impacted their church. Sam indicated that while it can be easy to think your church is exempt from this problem due to the theology of your denomination or the makeup of your church, such exceptionalism is just a lie and does not make your church immune to pornography.</p> <p>Is the church ignoring this issue? How can those caught in this trap get on the redemptive path rather than remaining on the captive one? How can we stop this problem that's undermining every ministry in the local church while at the same time help guard the next generation? Find out when you review this edition of Crosstalk.</p>

Pastor Hibbs responded by noting that initially the warning was meant for the church, but then the publisher noted that people were buying multiple copies. As he explained, you don't have to be a Christian to figure out that what's in this book is happening in your living rooms, neighborhoods, state and world.</p> <p>He believes the elements of deception are everywhere. In other words, evil knows no limits. So if it's in church, politics or business, evil needs to be exposed and deception is the key tactic within evil.</p> <p>One point this broadcast discusses is global deception (often taking the form of agendas) because of modern communication methods. This can be seen by how easy it is for people to be gripped by fear because they read a headline. This situation was certainly leveraged as the world was basically shut down due to COVID-19. He was born and raised in Portugal, was saved at the age of 9, and at the age of 17 felt God's call into vocation ministry.</p> <p>In 2001, the Supreme Court decided by a 6-3 vote, in favor of Child Evangelism Fellowship in the case of Good News Clubs v. Milford Central School. The court said it was constitutional for CEF to hold Good News Clubs in public schools after the last bell rings and that they could not be discriminated against because of their religious content.</p> <p>Each child must have a parental permission slip in order to attend. The gatherings run for an hour to an hour and 15 minutes after the school day has ended. During this time children are taught a Bible lesson, they sing songs, there are games, and sometimes there's a missionary story.</p> <p>In the past year in the U.S., CEF ministered to 102,000 children, although they're still rebuilding post-COVID. 3/18	History of the Income Tax	Jim Schneider/ William J. Federer	<p>April 15th is a day that has gone down in notoriety. On April 15, 1865, President Abraham Lincoln died. He was shot the night before in Ford’s Theatre. On April 15, 1912, the Titanic sank, having struck an iceberg the night before. April 15, 1927, was the Great Mississippi Flood where some 15 inches of rain fell in 18 hours causing the river to break out of its levee system at well over 100 locations and caused flooding in 10 states. In 1954, April 15th became the deadline for filing income tax returns. No doubt you’ve heard the familiar quote of Benjamin Franklin who said, ‘Our new Constitution is now established, everything seems to promise it will be durable; but in this world, nothing is certain except death and taxes.’</p> <p>We have all come to realize the impact taxes have upon us, but are you aware of the history of the income tax and how it came about? What was its purpose? Is today’s modern system of taxes a breach from what was originally intended?</p> <p>Joining Jim to look at this issue was William Federer. William is a nationally known speaker, historian, best-selling author, and president of Amerisearch, Inc, a publishing company dedicated to researching America’s noble heritage. He’s the speaker on <i>The American Minute</i> daily broadcast. Tariff taxes allowed American industries to improve and they began to produce steel to build railroads, steamboats and appliances for farms. In fact, the standard of living was raised faster than at any other period in world history.</p> <p>This growth caused large amounts of wealth to be amassed by industrialists. They began to pay for the campaigns of politicians, so Theodore Roosevelt tried to limit their power through the inheritance tax.</p> <p>William kept the history coming as he moved on to discussion concerning William Howard Taft and his tax on corporate profits, Woodrow Wilson who pushed through an emergency 1% tax on the top 1% of the richest in America, the beginning of tax exempt charitable foundations, as well as FDR who pushed through the largest tax increase in American history where everyone would pay taxes to help smash the Axis powers during WWII.</p> <p>William has more and you’ll hear it all as he brings another great history lesson to listeners of Crosstalk.</p>

In the lawsuit, Scott has a wrongful death claim, a medical malpractice claim, a lack of informed consent and a declaratory judgment for both the illegal DNR and illegal medicine combination. This takes Grace’s claim outside of state statutes because such statutes attempt to shield doctors and nurses so they cannot be sued.</p> <p>At stake are factors such as informed consent and whether health care workers should have the right to unilaterally, with limited liability, be able to label patients as DNR.</p> <p>Scott has been granted a trial date of November 6th in the Outagamie County Court system.</p>

Mat is an author and the host of the radio broadcasts <i>Faith & Freedom</i> and <i>Freedom's Call</i>.</p> <p>This program dealt with a number of issues, but the primary focus concerned recent Supreme Court cases. The first one dealt with the court's hearing of oral arguments on March 18th in the case of <i>Murthy v. Missouri</i>. At issue was the Biden administration's pressuring of social media platforms to remove posts that they believe are falsehoods dealing with topics such as the COVID pandemic or the 2020 presidential election.</p> <p>The next item discussed involved the court's hearing of oral arguments over two cases that were consolidated: <i>FDA v. Alliance for Hippocratic Medicine</i> and <i>Danco Laboratories LLC v. Alliance for Hippocratic Medicine</i>. Some say that this could have the potential effect of stopping mail-order abortions. That's because, as Mat explains in detail, these cases deal with the FDA's approval of Mifepristone, a drug that's used to terminate pregnancies during early stages.</p>
