4/3	“Informed Consent” Hangs in the Balance	Jim Schneider/ Scott Schara	Scott Schara is the father of Grace Schara. Grace, 19 years of age, had Down Syndrome, tested positive for COVID-19, hospitalized and treated following the protocols that were being carried out in health facilities across the country, and then she was ushered into eternity on October 13, 2021. This <i>Crosstalk</i> is an update on Grace’s story, first heard in January of 2022 on <i>Crosstalk</i> . As shocking as it sounds, there’s more to report. Scott brought listeners an update that included a brief overview of her medical history, the drugs that were not authorized to be administered. Then there was the Do-Not-Resuscitate (DNR) order that was signed, who recommended it, how the American Medical Association views informed consent and if that was the case, the lawsuit against St. Elizabeth Hospital, audio from the recent press conference outside the hospital and more. This case highlights the critical importance of informed consent and what this means for you and your loved ones.
4/4	Military Readiness or Military Wokeness?	Jim Schneider/ Elaine Donnelly	Tensions around the world continue to escalate. Alliances are being formed between America’s enemies and their militaries. As for the U.S. military, look at these headlines from various news sites over the past several weeks: –The Biden administration is now ordering the military to allow male soldiers to shower with females. –Army revamping “Be all you can be” campaign. –Republicans demand answers from West Point over pronoun play acting training session. –Pentagon researchers urge more access to sex change hormones for military kids. –Secretary of State Blinken defends funding drag shows. –Biden aims to shrink the Navy while the Secretary of the Navy focuses on climate change. After reading these you have to ask the question: Are we pursuing military readiness or military “wokeness”? Appearing on <i>Crosstalk</i> to discuss this issue was Elaine Donnelly. Elaine is president of the Center for Military Readiness, an independent, nonpartisan public policy organization that reports on and analyzes military/social issues. The Center for Military Readiness (CMR) was founded in 1993, CMR has advocated for high, uncompromised standards in all forms of military training and sound decision making of military/social policies. What does “woke” mean? Elaine defined it as another name for progressivism/liberalism taken to extreme lengths. It’s a term that if it hurts the institution. That means “wokeness” is affecting and shaping gender policy, environmental policy, and other areas of the subject discussed here, the military. One area where we see “wokeness” at work is in the area of Critical Race Theory (CRT). This involves a theory of racism that divide people into various racial groups. White people are suspected or assumed to be racist, and people of color are assumed to be under-served or oppressed in some way by the racism of other people. So Elaine noted that when you go into a military school and you see a person who is a member of the LGBTQ+ community, how can you expect the same people who accuse each other of racism, or assume the other is a racist, to stand out and fight a war together? This is inherently divisive. Transgender policy and its attendant pronoun usage, the promotion of drag queen events and President Biden’s policies are further advancing racial equity in support for under-served communities through the federal government’s policies on military “wokeness”. 4/28	News Roundup & Comment	Jim Schneider	<p>The following stories from the first quarter hour were part of a much wider look by Jim at news items from the week:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> –President Biden decides to seek a second term announcing his 2024 re-election campaign, ending months of speculation about his future. –Representative Ronny Jackson, who was a White House physician to multiple presidents, is circulating a letter to Congress and Republicans demanding that President Biden take a cognitive test or drop out of the 2024 race. –Despite a pledge to bring transparency and truth back to the government, President Biden has held the press conference since Ronald Reagan. –President Biden brought a “cheat sheet” to a Wednesday press conference that showed he had advanced preparation from a journalist. –The Sudanese military has been working with foreign governments to evacuate diplomats as their country is caught in a massive conflict between the paramilitary Rapid Support Forces and Sudan's armed forces. –White House National Security Council spokesman John Kirby confirmed on Wednesday that a second U.S. soldier was killed in Sudan. –The Taliban has reportedly killed the Islamic state terrorist who orchestrated a deadly attack against U.S. troops during the withdrawal back in 2021. –Two of the most iconic faces on cable news are gone from their host networks as Fox has parted ways with Chris Matthews and Don Lemon has departed CNN. –A bill extending the nation's debt ceiling was approved by the House on Wednesday after days of deliberation by Republican legislators to support the measure. –West Virginia Senator Joe Manchin reiterated his public call for President Biden to negotiate with House Speaker Kevin McCarthy on raising the debt limit. –The White House stood firm Tuesday on its demand for an uncompromised debt ceiling increase, pledging to support the proposal if it should, against long odds, pass both chambers of the Congress. –The West Virginia senate race is shaping up to become one of the most important races in the 2024 election. –Jim Justice is likely to enter the race and join Alex Mooney in the Republican battle to unseat Joe Manchin. –Former Republican Arkansas Governor Asa Hutchinson officially announced his run for president during the 2024 election in Bentonville, Arkansas. –Walt Disney Company is suing Ron DeSantis, alleging that the Republican governor has waged a religion-based war to weaponize government power over the company. –Former South Carolina governor and presidential candidate Nikki Haley invited Disney to move to South Carolina to end a prolonged feud with Ron DeSantis.
5/1	Beware: SatanCon 2023	Jim Schneider/ Dr. David Brown	<p>Scripture warns us about Satan in areas such as 1 Peter 5:8 and Ephesians 6:11. He's been a resource used by law enforcement on issues pertaining to Satanism at SatanCon was the Satanic Temple's annual meeting but they're located in Salem, Massachusetts. Oddly, they do not believe in or worship a personal Satan, yet they received a religious exemption from the government, a contradiction, since they're clearly embracing the unfruitful works of darkness (see Ephesians 5:11) the following the "wisdom" of their father, the one they claim to reject.</p> <p>Is there any significance to the dates they chose (April 28th-30th)? Dr. Brown noted that these dates were they're following the German occult holiday known as "Hexennacht." This means, "witches night." In "Beltane." 5/2	Dangerous World Pandemic Treaty Draws Nigh	Jim Schneider/ Dr. Michele Bachmann	<p>We've been warning listeners about a dangerous pandemic treaty being orchestrated by the World Health Organization (WHO). Our nation averted that threat a year ago but unfortunately it's back again.</p> <p>Returning to Crosstalk to discuss this latest development was Dr. Michele Bachmann. Dr. Bachmann is a member of the School of Government at Regent University. She previously served in the Minnesota State Senate then in the U.S. House and won as the first Republican woman from Minnesota elected to the U.S. House of Representatives. She has served for multiple years.</p> <p>Later this month (May 21st through the 30th) the 76th World Health Assembly will be held in Geneva, Switzerland, seeking to adopt amendments to the international health regulations and would place the WHO in control. Right now it appears that the Biden administration is "all in" on this matter. If the U.S. becomes a party to the treaty, a "health emergency" is declared, you can say "good-bye" to your personal freedom regarding medical decisions and the sovereignty of America.</p> <p>Dr. Bachmann described how during the COVID-19 pandemic, numerous freedoms were lost. This happened because Biden gave himself emergency powers. This allowed him to simply issue directives such as landlords not evicting tenants who refused to pay rent. There was the paying of people to stay home from work which has led to a high level of inflation, the mask mandates, the shutting down of churches and more.</p> <p>She believes the Biden administration is hoping to give that high level of emergency power over health care to the WHO, the Organization, the United Nations body that governs health care. So rather than Dr. Fauci telling us what to do, she's allowing us to appeal to our representatives if we disagree, we'd lose all that as power over our health care is given to the WHO as they evolve from being an advisory body to a regulatory one.</p> <p>When we tighten the focus on this issue, we see a China connection. Dr. Bachmann described how the Chinese government (that tracks, surveils and traces its own citizens through digital I.D.'s), is seeking to use the technology primarily by the Chinese communist party, as a means to be able to control nearly all people on earth.</p> <p>Is this just "tin foil hat" talk? Not when you hear confirmation from an audio clip Jim played from last year from Indonesia. Also, later in the broadcast is a montage of audio that includes high-level individuals such as Dr. Fauci and Klaus Schwab of the World Economic Forum, and a separate clip of Tedros Gebreyesus, the director of the WHO.</p>

She's been part of the team of frontline physicians treating COVID early at home. With Dr. Peter McCullough, she is the author/editor of the <i>Guide to COVID Early Treatment: Options to Stay Out of Hospital and Save Your Life</i>. She is an Ellis Island Medal of Honor recipient for her national and international educational efforts in health, education, and aging in men and women. She is a past director of the Association of American Physicians and Surgeons. She has an M.D. degree and internship in Internal Medicine at Eastern Virginia Medical School and completed specialties at Johns Hopkins. She spoke on this broadcast as an independent physician, not as a spokesperson for any health care organization, pharmaceutical company, insurance plan or political party. She is a patient advocate.</p> <p>Jim began by noting a news story indicating the FDA, "...has rejected a "petition for administrative action" from medical researchers to order vaccine manufacturers to set the public record straight through revised labeling, clinical trial design, results and adverse events." However, it appears the FDA isn't willing to do this.</p> <p>Dr. Vliet responded that they're not willing to do this because they're, "in the pocket of big pharma and its interests." She informed listeners that one year ago, the FDA announced they would require vaccine manufacturers to disclose modifications of the transfer from traditional vaccines to the mRNA technology. She feels the FDA simply backed away from their regulatory duties and their charter, therefore the public will not know what's in these new vaccines.</p> <p>Another interesting bit of information dealt with programs she was involved with in late 2020 and early 2021. COVID shots could turn off a specific tumor-suppressor gene, one of the major protective mechanisms of our DNA. In success, we have become too self-sufficient to feel the necessity of redeeming and preserving grace, too God that made us.”</p> <p>This description is more relevant today than ever before as America is in desperate need of prayer and revival. Joining Jim to look at the topic of revival was Ben Everson. Ben is an evangelist and musician who is known for his recordings. Ben has ministered in evangelistic crusades, Bible colleges, Christian schools, Bible and mission camp meetings and other settings. He, along with Frank Garlock, have co-authored, <i>We Need Revival: Observations</i>.</p> <p>Is there even hope anymore for America? Ben believes there’s enough hope for God to work in our nation and still rises. Another way he expressed this was to quote someone who said that God sends revival but it’s up to us to catch that wind.</p> <p>So what then is the role of the church (true, born-again believers) at a time like this? Ben explained that the Lord and follow the pattern presented by the Bible (both testaments) where we become concerned about the state. In other words, how are we reflecting Christ to a lost world? This requires that God does a deep work in the hearts of people.</p> <p>How should we define revival? Ben noted that you can’t revive what hasn’t been “vived” in the first place. Revival that has to do with political reform and it’s not something we put on the calendar. It’s something that happens when God has not worked up. Later on, callers come in and share their thoughts.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> –Early Monday, regulators seized the San Francisco-based First Republic Bank and agreed to sell its deposits to JPMorgan Chase preventing further spiral of the banking industry. –Shares of the U.S. regional banks PacWest Bancorp and Western Alliance Bank plunged on Tuesday as the First Republic Bank triggered investor concerns about the financial health of other mid-sized lenders. –U.S. Treasury Secretary Janet Yellen gave lawmakers a deadline Monday to raise the debt ceiling by July 15th to avoid U.S. debt obligations. –The U.S. will run out of cash to pay all government bills on time on June 8th. –The U.S. has evacuated its first group of American citizens and permanent residents from Sudan. –Russian officials claimed that Ukrainian forces had conducted a drone attack against the Kremlin target of Vladimir Putin on Wednesday. –A U.S. think tank says Russia likely staged the drone attack on the Kremlin as a false-flag operation. –American officials said Tuesday that the U.S. will be sending about 300 million in additional military aid to Ukraine, including large quantities of artillery shells, howitzers, air-to-surface missiles and ammunition as the Spring offensive by Ukrainian forces nears its start. –The Department of Homeland Security and Department of State announced unprecedented policies to allow more migrants to enter the U.S. while also claiming the border is closed, ahead of the public health authority Title 42 which ends on May 31st. –As many as 700,000 migrants, a foreign population larger than Boston, are currently in Mexico, waiting to enter the U.S. when President Joe Biden ends the public health emergency known as Title 42. –White House Press Secretary Karine Jean-Pierre was eviscerated by Twitter users after declaring that the number of migrants has been down by 90% since implementing President Biden’s immigration policies. –Seattle police can no longer pursue suspects in vehicles. –This week, Washington State’s Governor Jay Inslee called a special session of the state legislature in a bid to pass a bill to prevent fentanyl from being automatically decriminalized as deaths continue to soar from the drug. –The rate of drug overdose deaths involving fentanyl more than tripled in the U.S. from 2016 through 2021, according to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. –Senator Ron Johnson of Wisconsin claimed that Secretary of State Antony Blinken lied to Congress about Hunter Biden and “so much more.”
5/8	Border Chaos about to Worsen	Jim Schneider/ Mark Krikorian	<p>As the Biden administration was put in place in 2021, Biden appointed Vice President Harris to be the “border czar.” The administration assured Americans that she would get to the root causes of illegal immigration and solve our border problems.</p> <p>In 2022 we saw Harris traveling to Honduras. She came back announcing a deal that involved some 500 million in investment to Central America with large U.S. corporations engaging in infrastructure projects. Then evidence of progress being made but unfortunately, the problem has grown exponentially worse. In addition, the border is not fully open as Title 42 is set to end this Thursday, May 11th.</p> <p>Returning to Crosstalk to present an update on the border crisis was Mark Krikorian. Mark is a national expert on immigration issues serving as the executive director of Center for Immigration Studies. They are an independent research organization examining and critiquing the impact of immigration on the United States. He’s testified before Congress and has published articles in many outlets.</p> <p>According to Mark, while the Trump administration wasn’t perfect when it came to the border issue, they were at least fixing the immediate problem that was facing them. The Biden administration, on the other hand, starting in January 2021, reversed nearly every Trump policy. They did this, in spite of the fact that officials in the Trump administration were warned how disastrous the result would be and everything they were warned about has come true.</p> <p>At the core of this debate is Title 42 which as noted, is set to expire on Thursday. Title 42 is short-hand for the “provisional” rule that dates back to COVID. It authorizes the border patrol to send back anyone that’s caught crossing over the border with no hearings and no asylum.</p> <p>This is the only Trump era policy the Biden administration has kept in place but they’ve been applying it more strictly. Numbers of people that they catch. However, even with the exceptions, they’ve been expelling, without a hearing, people from the asylum pipeline, at least one-third of those who come across the border. So even when used in this way, Title 42 is still a tool the border patrol can use to prevent the current disaster from becoming even worse.</p> <p>After midnight on the 11th, all those who come across, especially single men who were being bounced back to Mexico, will claim asylum, and they’ll get placed in the asylum pipeline. There’ll be no detention for any length of time and they’ll end up letting go even more illegal immigrants.</p>

			<p>Mark also noted that since Biden came into office, his administration has taken into custody and let go of illegal aliens. That's more than legal immigration during that same time frame. This makes sneaking a way people now come to the U.S. as an immigrant.</p> <p>What's causing this? Mark communicated that this administration speaks as though this is caused by climate supremacy and therefore they have no control over the problem. It's like the tides or continental drift and accommodate ourselves to it. He disagrees and noted that people are coming because it's worth the money. This broadcast was highlighted by audio cuts from Homeland Security Secretary Alejandro Mayorkas, Kamala Harris and input from Crosstalk listeners.</p>

Jim Schneider/ Alex Newman	<p>Artificial Intelligence (AI) is becoming an increasingly popular news topic, not surprisingly because of how it can be used to monitor the movement of populations and therefore track your every step. According to Bill Gates, AI will be used to replace teachers.</p> <p>Will this technology ultimately be used for good or evil? It depends on who you look to. The White House has laid out a plan to promote "ethical" AI with Vice President Kamala Harris in charge.</p> <p>Returning to Crosstalk to tackle this issue was Alex Newman. Alex is an award-winning international journalist, author, researcher, educator and consultant. He is senior editor for The New American. He is co-author of <i>Educators</i> and author of <i>Deep State: The Invisible Government Behind the Scenes</i>. He is founder of LifeSiteNews.com. According to Alex, AI is advancing so rapidly that even the people creating it don't understand it and cannot control it. It has been predicted that once this technology gets loose, it can improve itself at such a speed it could leave us behind. Alex referenced a new Reuters article indicating that Alphabet, Inc. (the company that owns Google) is planning to use AI intelligence to have a set of moral values. It draws from several sources including the United Nations Declaration on the Rights and Apple, Inc. data privacy rules.</p> <p>Jim referenced a parental alert from the Child Protection League in Minnesota. They've indicated that the most popular among teens known as Snapchat assigns an AI "chatbot" to each customer.</p> <p>Why should this be of concern to parents? Jim noted a LifeSite News article that referenced Christian C. Miller. Miller worked with ChatGPT (an AI chatbot developed by OpenAI). He told it that he's a 15-year-old trans person in gender transition. The AI celebrated his self-expression and went on to refer him to doctors and therapists, also suggesting hormone treatment and surgery.</p> <p>As you can see, and as Alex summarized, when you have this kind of technological power, unrestrained, it's clear that God has revealed to mankind, you have a recipe for disaster.</p> <p>Other concerns this program brought to light were:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Phone call scams through AI voice replication. AI being used to rewrite a cruelty-free version of the biblical creation account with a vegan makeover in the style of Generation Z. Communist China seeking to use AI to build killer robots to fight the next war and how American investors are helping to finance the effort. <p>Alex explained how all the data you've been sharing/shedding via the Internet could be used by AI to piece together a comprehensive picture/dossier of your life. Will this be weaponized against us?</p> <p>Is there a connection between AI and transhumanism?</p> <p>Find out more, and hear how listeners responded, by reviewing this important Crosstalk broadcast.</p>
5/10	Patient Rights Continue in Limbo	Jim Schneider/ Karen Mueller	<p>Karen Mueller is founder and General Counsel for Amos Center for Justice and Liberty.</p> <p>Last December on Crosstalk, Karen introduced listeners to a pending Wisconsin Supreme Court case titled <i>Aurora Health Care, Inc. v. Wisconsin Board of Medical Examiners</i>. At stake is the issue of patient rights and what are those rights when a hospital's standard of care that the patient or the patient's representative requests.</p> <p>Allen Gahl is the nephew of, and medical power of attorney for, John Zingsheim. John became the focus of the case when he entered the hospital in September of 2021. Aurora Summit Hospital in Waukesha County diagnosed him with COVID-19 and placed him on a ventilator. He wanted to be given Ivermectin, so Allen began requesting that from the hospital, but the hospital refused.</p> <p>Karen then returned to Crosstalk in January of this year after submitting oral arguments to the Wisconsin Supreme Court. She informed listeners that in a two day conference hearing with lawyers, a judge decided that John had a right to be treated as long as it was an outside doctor that the family found that could be credentialed, enter the hospital, and administer Ivermectin. Before the order could be fulfilled, the appellate court intervened and stayed the order on the grounds of Ivermectin.</p> <p>Karen's arguments were not about what treatment is best for COVID-19. Instead, she argued that this case was about the care power of attorney and the rights that the legislature had given to Wisconsin citizens.</p> <p>Last week the Wisconsin Supreme Court rendered its opinion 6-1 against the case presented by Karen. In the majority's merits of the case, they tailored a ruling that says because the appellate court hadn't properly documented the facts of their order, the court had committed discretionary error.</p>

Here's a selection of stories that made the headlines this week:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The House GOP voted to boost border security by finishing the wall and hiring thousands of agents. -Florida attorney general sues the Biden administration to stop the mass release of migrants into the U.S. border. -Prior to the termination of Title 42, Texas Governor Greg Abbott created a new Texas tactical border enforcement strategy. -Less than a day after Mayor Eric Adams announced his plan for New York City to relocate illegal immigrants to Rockland and Orange Counties, elected officials in both areas have rejected the idea and declared a state of emergency. -Kathy Hochul, governor of New York, declared a state disaster emergency late Tuesday ahead of the end of Title 42. This allows New York to mobilize some 500 members of the National Guard that are currently providing operational support at New York City's Port Authority bus terminal and shelter sites, bringing the total number of troops to 1,500 service members. -As Illinois continues to welcome migrants from the Mexican border, officials are now scrambling to find shelter for them. -The Department of Homeland Security released a statement at midnight Thursday as Title 42 was expected to be not open.

			<p>–A federal judge in Florida temporarily blocked the Biden administration from releasing illegal immigrants from the border as the nation braces for a surge of illegal border crossings triggered by the expiration of Title 8.</p> <p>–A key office under New York City Mayor Eric Adams sent an email to a select group of private property owners to request emergency space to house migrants coming to the city.</p> <p>–DHS Secretary Alejandro Mayorkas called the busing of migrants to Vice President Kamala Harris’ home a “tragic day.”</p> <p>–On April 17, the L.A. City Council voted unanimously to pay a dangerous Islamic terrorist organization for representation to immigrants facing deportation.</p> <p>–After Speaker McCarthy canceled Michigan Representative Rashida Tlaib’s Nakba Day event in Congress, Sanders stepped up to the plate.</p> <p>–Islamic jihadists sending rockets into Israel.</p> <p>–The U.S. ambassador to South Africa accused the country Thursday of providing weapons to Russia via a ship docked secretly at a naval base near the city of Capetown for 3 days in December.</p> <p>–A U.S. citizen from Boston was arrested Tuesday and charged with working as an agent of a foreign government for the Communist Party, without notifying the U.S. Attorney General as required by law.</p> <p>–King Charles III was crowned Saturday at Westminster Abbey in a ceremony steeped in ancient ritual.</p>
5/15	Amazing Grace: The Life of John Newton	Jim Schneider/ Bruce Hindmarsh and Craig Borlase	<p>What is the most recognizable hymn of all time? Many of you would likely say, Amazing Grace. We could sing it at a vigil or remembrance service or perhaps played on bagpipes. Regardless of where or how this hymn is performed, it is a test of time for 250 years.</p> <p>Do you know the story behind the song and the man who wrote this testimonial of the faith? Bruce Hindmarsh is the James M. Houston Professor of Spiritual Theology and Professor of the History Department at Regent College in Vancouver. He wrote his doctoral thesis at Oxford on John Newton and it was published as <i>The English Evangelical Tradition</i>. He also edited and wrote an introduction for an edition of Newton’s letters on growth in grace, <i>The Life and Spirituality of John Newton</i>. He is a fellow of the Royal Historical Society and president of the American Society of Church History.</p> <p>Craig Borlase is a New York Times, Sunday Times, and international bestselling ghostwriter of dramatic nonfiction. Over the last two decades, he has written more than fifty-five books, working with a diverse range of authors and an audience.</p> <p>This Crosstalk began as Bruce and Craig described what drew their interest to research and tell the story of the writer of Amazing Grace. From there, Bruce described how the book actually begins with a death, the death of a man who had intended for young John to enter the ministry. He also didn’t fit very well into the family when he was remarried. So early on, John’s life was marked by trauma.</p> <p>As his life moved on, he was press-ganged (forced into His Majesty’s Navy—a type of legal kidnapping) and spent this time as impulsive and cocky which got him into trouble time and again. Eventually he had to reckon with his role in the slave trade. She is an OB/GYN who has delivered more than 5,000 babies over a long career in Texas. Unfortunately she has had a lot of experience in treating women for complications of the abortion pill.</p> <p>Jim and Dr. Skop opened this edition of Crosstalk with discussion concerning this controversial pill, also known as Mifepristone. There are conflicting rulings in the lower courts, with the Supreme Court allowing the use of this case works its way up through the court system.</p> <p>What's important to note is that Mifepristone is not the same as emergency contraception or Plan B. The purpose of Mifepristone is to avoid fertilization after intercourse. Mifepristone is taken when a pregnancy is known to exist with the intent of killing the unborn human life.</p> <p>Mifepristone blocks progesterone receptors and cuts off support of the embryo or fetus and kills it. This is followed by Misoprostol that then induces labor.</p> <p>While Mifepristone (The French name is RU-486) has been said to be safer than Tylenol. Dr. Skop noted that even their own studies say 1-2% complications. However, they don't know all the complications because they aren't mandatory. She indicated that when you do quality studies, you determine that about 1 out of 20 women will need surgery, and that surgery will be 4 times more complicated than a surgical abortion. That makes it a one that frequently injures women.</p> <p>Review this segment of the broadcast and you'll learn more including how the Mifepristone process came to be at the heart of the current lawsuit, the FDA's thoughts on removal of this drug from the market, when to expect a ruling from the 5th Circuit Court and more.</p> <p>As this Crosstalk moved along, Jim also looked at some weekly news items. There's been significant devastation, air strikes, artillery bombardment, hunger, displacement, families separated and more.</p> <p>According to Paul, over the past 15 months, 3 to 4 million people have been able to leave Ukraine, heading to Germany, Sweden and other nations. The Ukrainian death toll currently stands at about 100,000.</p> <p>Typically, summer is a time for youth outreach by DOHI in Ukraine. However, the places to do this have been closed nearby, so obviously it would be irresponsible to bring children to such places.</p> <p>Regarding believers in general, Paul reported that Ukraine is a Christian nation, with even the leadership being Christian. Currently, many churches are experiencing revival, and since the first invasion by Russia in 2022, using these uncertain times to lead many to faith.</p> <p>Learn more about this amazing work of God amidst the devastation of war, whether Paul feels if there's a prayer you can pray, and hear how listeners responded, when you review this Crosstalk broadcast.</p>
6/2	Farm Land/Food Supply Under Attack and the CO2 Pipeline	Jim Schneider/ Tom DeWeese	<p>Tom DeWeese is the president of American Policy Center. He is one of the nation's leading advocates for free enterprise, private property rights, personal privacy, back-to-basics education and American sovereignty, protecting our constitutionally-guaranteed rights. He is author of <i>Sustainable: The War on Free Enterprise and Individuals</i> and the political novel, <i>Erase</i>.</p> <p>America's farmland is under attack and with that comes an attack on our food supply. Jim brought up the issue for Tom to comment on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Farmland has been coming under attack as it falls into the hands of communist China. Chinese companies, some linked to the communist party, have been purchasing land in South Dakota and elsewhere in the U.S. According to the USDA, estimates of Chinese holdings of U.S. agriculture lands in 2020, that increased more than 25 times to 352,000 acres. <p>Tom noted that Texas Congressman Chip Roy has introduced the Securing American Land from Foreign Ownership Act (SALFOA) (H.R. 344). The purpose of the legislation is to block communist China from purchasing American farmland.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In Arizona, a Saudi owned dairy company is growing alfalfa for the purpose of feeding their camels in Saudi Arabia. Also, the ground water has been under attack. Until recently they were drilling for water, pumping up to 3,000 gallons of water per minute to irrigate those crops. <p>Why are we allowing a foreign owned company to pump out huge quantities of water for free for crops in Saudi Arabia when the area is under an epic drought? According to Tom, this highlights the force of global capitalism on sovereign nations by having a global economy because examples like this point to that very thing.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Bureau of Land Management, along with leftists, are locking up the land to prevent it from being used for drilling and grazing purposes. <p>Tom followed up this point by mentioning a plan whereby 50% of all the land in the U.S. would be locked up in 10 years.</p> <p>Next up was this news concerning food consumption:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> New York City will begin tracking the carbon footprint of household food consumption, particularly red meat can be served in public institutions. Part of this initiative seeks to achieve a 33% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions from food by 2030. <p>Tom indicated this is all coming from the Great Reset and Klaus Schwab. In Schwab's book, <i>Covid-19 and the Great Reset</i>, comes right out and says that capitalism is the target. They have ESG rules (Environment, Social and Governance) and everything under the heading of "sustainable development." This is a trigger term to get you to voluntarily give up your rights in order to be sustainable. So what the Great Reset is saying is that on Wall Street, corporations that can't produce products and processes are sustainable won't be invested in.</p> <p>This just covers the discussion from the first quarter hour of the broadcast. As the program progresses, we'll continue to discuss carbon capture pipeline and hear comments from listeners nationwide.</p>

6/3	Central Bank Digital Currency Concern	Jim Schneider/ Rebecca Terrell	<p>According to a column written by the guest, “You won’t be able to buy anything without permission from government. Every dollar you earn, spend, or save will be monitored by autocrats, who, with the click of your earning, spending, or saving potential at any time. You’ll be forced to buy food, clothing, shelter—need or want—according to tyrannical dictate. Or you will be prevented from purchasing by the same of only what you buy, but when and from whom you buy it.”</p> <p>What would ever give any government such power? We’re speaking of the Central Bank Digital Currency. Rebecca indicated that if this is not resisted, this programmable money could signal the demise of financial freedom. Joining Jim to outline this issue was Rebecca Terrell, senior editor and regular contributor to The New York Times. Central Bank Digital Currency (CBDC) is programmable money. The reason it’s different than transactional money like debit cards is because under CBDC, each dollar can be turned on or off.</p> <p>One example of this might be the government putting an expiration on your money so that you have to use it by a certain time. How would the government know this? Some of the information would come from a person’s payment history.</p> <p>This may sound like science fiction and we may want to believe that will never happen here. However, it is happening in China. They’ve incorporated a social credit score that labels a person. Rebecca cited examples of someone’s score such as purchasing cigarettes and alcohol or maybe they were caught “jaywalking.” Score determines what they can do with their funds such as renting an apartment, where they send their kids to school, business, etc.</p> <p>Exactly where does this stand worldwide? Rebecca noted how the BRICS nations are talking about it. Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa. On the first of April, China and Brazil announced they were bypassing the American dollar and creating their own currency between themselves. Russia has announced this year they will have launched their own CBDC as well.</p> <p>Rebecca described how the catalyst for this actually goes back to 1913 and our Federal Reserve. Then it moved along, she also looked at whether or not CBDC demands a digital I.D., the E.S.G. (Environmental, Social, and Governance) factor, involvement of the Bank for International Settlements in Switzerland, states that and more.</p>
6/4	Terrorism Bulletin Warns Churches	Jim Schneider/ Michael Letts	<p>On May 24th, the Department of Homeland Security issued a national terrorism advisory system bulletin as a summary of terrorism related threats to the nation. Listed among the likely threats of potential violence were religious institutions. According to the Family Research Council, before this heightened alert came out, 2023 was recorded the largest number of anti-Christian church attacks of any year that expert researchers have tracked.</p> <p>Joining Jim to look at this issue was Michael Letts. Michael is founder, president & CEO of In-Vest US, a non-profit organization that is helping hundreds of communities provide thousands of bulletproof vests through educational, public relations, sponsorship and fundraising programs.</p> <p>Why is there a staggering number of church attacks? According to Michael, these attacks aren’t about terrorism, they’re midnight to spray-paint your sign. These statistics represent actual physical violence, including the killing of church members.</p> <p>Michael described this as an epic spiritual battle between good vs. evil. He encouraged listeners to be vigilant and to resist the serpents. We also need to understand what kind of protections we need to take and how we are to respond. What’s brought about this change? Michael believes that the church sat back and put its faith in the government. We allowed them to come and educate our children and make sure that life is good for us. However, if we have faith in anything other than God, you’ll suffer the consequences.</p> <p>What are those consequences? There’s our education system that divorced the education of our children from biblical principles. These would include protecting life and respecting authority. As these individuals have grown up, no surprise that they have no basis or standard on how to live without being offensive against their fellow citizens. We’ve demonstrated as a government that absent consequences, crime pays.</p> <p>A key point to this broadcast is Michael’s comments concerning the manifesto of the gender-confused students at the private Christian school in Nashville. Why is that manifesto being withheld? Michael noted that the school used transgenderism as a propaganda tool to move a liberal agenda forward. 6/12	A Christian Look at Immigration	Jim Schneider/ Sam Rohrer	<p>Sam Rohrer is the president of American Pastors Network and the Pennsylvania Pastor's Network. He's the Gap.' Sam is a former state representative in the Pennsylvania Legislature as he sought to apply biblical principles to areas of legislation. He was often referred to as the 'Conscience of the House' because of his consistent public policy.</p> <p>Why is immigration such a hot topic amid the current political climate? Sam believes it's only because our nation have walked away from God's simple understanding of what constitutes a nation, the purpose of government leaders (Romans 13).</p> <p>Sam defined a nation as an area defined by a common language, worldview, and identifiable boundaries. These boundaries so they've been with us since the beginning of time.</p> <p>God works through nations for the fulfillment of His plan of redemption. America, on the other hand, has walked away from God's plan expressed in the biblical worldview. So what used to be of no controversy now is a hot topic, look at how this nation views human sexuality or marriage. Sam believes boundaries fall into the category of, hence, that subject is now controversial as well.</p> <p>Is there a difference between how a government should respond to immigration compared to how the Church should respond? Sam referred to what he called the 'jurisdictional approach.' What is the purpose of government from a biblical perspective? It's to praise those who do well (protect those who follow God's moral law) and to punish those who do not. It's to uphold moral law and the law of the land.</p> <p>You may wonder what borders have to do with government. A government has leaders who have a responsibility to protect the lives of its citizens. So you can't define 'citizen' unless you have borders. This means the fundamental principle of government is to maintain borders.</p> <p>As 'the church' we are to carry the gospel to all people regardless of whether it's our next door neighbor or a person from another nation. However, as Sam noted, '...the church and the individual should never be in violation against the boundaries established for government which is to protect its people and its borders.'</p> <p>What is the believers responsibility in all of this? How should our nation proceed as we navigate this complex issue? Doesn't the text at the Statue of Liberty demand open borders? Are spiritual and political leaders responsible for such as Leviticus 19:34 and the story of the Good Samaritan when they try to apply them to the subject of immigration? These and other questions are examined, and callers weigh in as well, during this critical edition of Cross the Line.</p>
6/13	Dinosaurs, Dragons, and the Bible	Jim Schneider/ Bodie Hodge	<p>Over the years, it's been easy for secular thinking to creep into the beliefs of Christians. This is particularly true when it comes to the subject of origins where belief in millions of years, the Big Bang and evolution are all too common. It's easy to be accused of being a "science denier".</p> <p>The result? In order to not be laughed out of science classrooms, we're told that we must believe that dinosaurs existed millions of years before man. Not surprisingly then, when was the last time you heard about dinosaurs in church? Perhaps in a sermon? After all, the Bible offers truth and clarity on the matter.</p> <p>To show us why this is true, Jim welcomed back Bodie Hodge. Bodie is a speaker, writer and researcher on the book of Genesis. He has a master's degree in mechanical engineering. He has authored numerous articles and books on the book of Genesis and has served as general editor on the World Religious and Cults books among other things. He speaks at the Creation Museum and Ark Encounter on topics such as dinosaurs and dragons, the dispersal of man, and a biblical response to racism. He is an avid genealogy fan who has traced his ancestry back to Adam. He has a newly released book, <i>Dinosaurs, Dragons, and the Bible</i>.</p> <p>Bodie defined the term, "dinosaur" as a land reptile that stands upright (erect) on its feet. In other words, it's like a Komodo dragon where it's legs protrude from the side and its body naturally rests on the ground. By this definition, creatures like Plesiosaurs, or flying reptiles such as Pteranodons or Pterodactyls, are not considered dinosaurs. Bodie brought up one point in particular that's very important to remember. It's the Bible's reference to dinosaurs as creatures within their "kinds." This doesn't correlate with our modern word "species" very well. A "kind" is a group of creatures that can interbreed with each other.</p> <p>The term "dinosaur" means "terrible lizard". It was coined in 1841 by a Christian man who was integrated into the Natural History Museum in London. His name was Sir Richard Owen. Since this term was new as of 1841, you wouldn't find it in the Bible. However, there is a term used by the Bible that would have included creatures like dinosaurs that's the term, "dragon".</p> <p>That sets up this fascinating, information-packed program that also answers the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Were dinosaurs always flesh eaters? • With their massive size, how could dinosaurs have been on the ark? • Are the dinosaur bones we see today from those who died during the flood? • Is it possible there are still some dinosaurs today? • Did man and dinosaurs exist at the same time? • Why are many Christians readily accepting the evolutionary worldview? • How can dinosaur bones be millions of years old when we've discovered soft tissue within them?

The Bible or Christianity should have no part in our government as they scream, “Separation of church and state.” This so far as to believe Christians should have no voice whatsoever in government. Still others claim Christianity is at all since the Bible teaches that believers are citizens of heaven.</p> <p>So what about God and country? Are they compatible with one another? Does a believer in Christ have a duty to patriotism and Christianity? What is the responsibility of believers to our nation?</p> <p>To answer such questions, Crosstalk welcomed Dr. Byron Foxx. Dr. Foxx is the founder and past president of the God & Country Music serving many thousands of churches across the country. Dr. Foxx is also an evangelist who travels the country for God & Country Rallies.</p> <p>Dr. Foxx noted that there’s four ways that God judges nations—by pestilence and disease, war, natural disasters, and bad leaders. He believes there’s no doubt that there’s a measure of God’s anger and wrath being currently poured out on our nation and you’ll see that God hates pride. He warned listeners that we need to humble ourselves before God, and get thoroughly right with God. It’s important to note, however, that he also said that as he travels, he’s seen a lot of people who are not his people.</p> <p>Dr. Foxx referenced the year 1900 as the time when things began to unravel in America. Up to this time, things were good to grade schools, high schools and even the colleges. Then you move to 1962-63 when we quit reading the Bible and then prayer was stopped. In 1969 the Church of Satan obtained tax exempt status. In 1972, the unmentionable was reclassified as something other than deviant behavior, and in 1973 we had the Roe v. Wade decision. In 1973 we had a harvest.</p> <p>In spite of all this, can Christians be patriotic while at the same time give honor to God? Dr. Foxx answered that he worked his way through things to consider like the examples of Daniel and Nehemiah, how we should pray, and how we should participate in government, the 5 principles that determine your vote, and more, including input from listeners.</p>
6/22	“Gender Affirming Care”	Jim Schneider/ Dr. Jane Orient	<p>Dr. Jane Orient is the executive director of the Association of American Physicians and Surgeons, a non-profit association of physicians in all types of practices and specialties across the country who are dedicated to the highest standards of the Oath of Hippocrates and to preserving the sanctity of the patient-physician relationship in the practice of private medicine. Dr. Orient is a medical doctor obtained her undergraduate degrees in chemistry and nursing from the University of Arizona in Tucson, and her M.D. from Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons. She completed an internal medicine residency at Parkland Memorial Hospital and University of Arizona Affiliated Hospital, and was an Instructor at the University of Arizona College of Medicine and a staff physician at the Tucson Veterans Affairs Medical Hospital. It means something like something good. I mean, it’s trying to affirm a lie.”</p> <p>What’s causing the explosion in the number of people that are seeking such affirmation? Dr. Orient sees a growing number of things that are being done to destroy our traditions, our culture, our faith; to create chaos and confusion, and distressed and confused and susceptible to being ruled by those who consider themselves to be our better angels. These comments set the stage for this information-packed program that brings answers to questions such as: What is the cause of this confusion? When is biological sex determined? Is sex fluid like some claim? What is the long-term effect on the child who receives puberty blockers or hormones of the opposite sex?</p>
