The series explores all types of wild animals, while providing important information by experts from the San Diego Zoo. For example, in some episodes viewers are introduced to various animal enrichment programs where zoo staff seeks to duplicate a particular animal's habits that are prevalent and unique to that animal in the wild. In each episode Chica develops or encounters a problem that she cannot immediately solve. Usually her issues involve impulse control, distractibility, judgement, and inner personal behaviors. She and Kelly usually work on the problem through an adventure.
