For a month WVIN/WABH took calls from listeners and advertisers who made pledges/donations to Tyrtle Beach. Mike Mishook is the President of the Bath School Board and Tuesday Mishook is a Special Education Teacher for BOCES. This year's total was \$38,559.35. All the money stays local and was distributed to 85 youth organizations in the Central Steuben County area. Local organizations, groups, and clubs apply for funding to the Steuben County Youth Bureau who awards the group money from the Tyrtle Beach Fund raiser. In the 28 years. Nearly 750,000 has been raised to support local youth groups in the community.
