KY TZ FM Radio produces several daily newscasts. Three to Five minute 'morning drive' reports air at 5:00, 6:00, 7:00, 8:00 and 9:00 AM. With additional reports 'in brief' scheduled throughout the day.

News Treatments: The nominal length of each of our lead or feature stories is between thirty-seconds and one minute.

News Cycle: Exclusive stories run in each of the daily local newscasts before being archived. As an example: A local story or feature may air up to 4 times in the course of a day. In addition these stories are available to our audience on-demand via our station website for one week from date of first broadcast.
