Section A: Newscast Overview

KYTZ FM Radio produces 4 daily newscasts. Three minute 'morning drive' reports air at 5:57, 6:57, 7:57 and 8:57am.

News Treatments: The nominal length of each of our lead or feature stories described below is between thirty-seconds and two minutes-thirty seconds.

News Cycle: Exclusive stories run in each of the daily local newscasts before being archived. As an example: A local story or feature will air 4 times in the course of a day, once in each newscast. In addition these stories are available to our audience on-demand via our station website for one week from date of first broadcast.

The below stories are representative of the local news content we produce on a daily basis:

JULY 2013 Langdon Cluster

JULY 12th

Reported on a reminder from the FSA that producers had until a July 15th deadline to file acreage reports with the Fars Service Agency for the 2013 crop year. Accurate reports for all crops and land uses can prevent the loss of benefits for a variety of programs.

JULY 31st

Reported North Dakota district ten State senator Joe Miller of Park River had revealed a passenger in his car the night he was cited for drunken driving had a marijuana pipe. Miller said the person worked for him. Miller had pleaded guilty in June to drunken driving and has said he will not give up his senate seat.

AUGUST 2013 Langdon Cluster

AUGUST 12TH

Reported that an 18 year old Belcourt man had pleaded guilty to assaulting and resisting a federal officer. Cameron J Gooden assaulted a correctional officer who tried to remove him from a shower and return him to his cell. a sentence date of October 18th had been set.

AUGUST 19TH

Reported that state and local officials were hosting a fossil dig at the Pembina River Gorge near Walhalla that week. Fossils as much as 80 million years old had been recently found in the area. Members of the public were allowed to participate in the dig for free.

SEPTEMBER 2013 Langdon Cluster

SEPTEMBER 4th

Reported that a Walsh county deputy who had shot and wounded a man near Lankin had been placed on leave while state investigators sorted out what happened. The wounded man was in the hospital but was expected to survive.

SEPTEMBER 17th

Reported on the Cavalier County commission meeting. Cavalier County was approved under House Bill 1358 to receive money for upcoming road projects which would be done by Kadmaras Lee and Jackson. Exact plans for upcoming projects were unknown at that time.

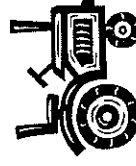
