## Section II: Programming

### A. Biblical Education

***Daily Light for Daily Living*** is a program that runs for one minute Monday through Fridays that provides insight for personal application, making the life changing discovery that God's Word works.

***Diamonds in the Dust*** is a one minute program airing Monday through Friday that encourages listeners that the grim of life with God can be turned into a sparkling gem.

***Encouraging Word with Susanne Bouchard*** is a three minute teaching that airs twice Monday through Friday and encourages the listener with Bible teaching.

***Empowered with Kelley Latta*** reveals through scripture how God constantly pursues us.
