QUARTERLY ISSUES AND PROGRAMS FOR:

January, February, March 2015

The following is a compilation and sampling of key issues and programs that were broadcast on the Worship Radio Network and specifically on WWWA during the reporting period:

Local Weather: A 30-second daily local weather forecast reporting area weather conditions and alerts.

20 Countdown Magazine: A weekly national program reporting on the top 20 Contemporary Christian songs of the week and reporting entertainment news featured in the CCM Magazine.

The Breakfast Show with Ron and Tabi: A daily three-hour daily program featuring music, contests, local events and interviews, and inspirational commentaries.

The Mid-Day Show with Bill Wade: A daily three-hour show with contemporary Christian music plus interviews with area and national guests plus regional public service announcements.

The Afternoon Show with Cilla Jones: A daily afternoon drive show featuring music, PSA and live mentions of community events.

An Encouraging Word with Susanne Bouchard: an 8-minute spiritual commentary offer biblical insight and spiritual encouragement.

A Ministry Moment: A periodic feature and interview spotlighting area churches and Christian organizations for service provided the community. The broadcast generally is 5-10 minutes in length.

Sunday Morning Drive: A 60-minute music magazine featuring contemporary Christian music plus encouraging commentary and inspirational thoughts.

Public Service Announcements

The Proverbs 31 Woman: A daily two-minute commentary encouraging women to live in accordance with Proverbs 31. The feature airs several times a day Monday through Friday.

Women of the Word Conference: A 20-minute interview with Kim Warf, chairperson of the Women of the Word Conference scheduled for April 10-12, 2015 over-viewing conference topics and speakers.

The Community Calendar: A daily report of community activities and events. 60-seconds and airs multiple times throughout the broadcast day. The announcements inside the calendar are comprised of information provided from area organizations, churches, schools and government agencies.

All other times are music and announcer comments and commentaries, and underwriting announcements.
