4/1/18: McMahon/Ryan Child Advocacy Center (Part 1) – Guest: Colleen Merced – discussed that April is child abuse awareness month and their mission is dedicated to ending child abuse through prevention, intervention, and education by facilitating a coordinated multidisciplinary team approach. Discussed upcoming events: Annual Go Blue 4 Kids Breakfast, Pinwheel Ball 2018 and Step Up 4 Kids.

4/8/18: McMahon/Ryan Child Advocacy Center (Part 1)— Guest: Colleen Merced — April is child abuse awareness month (repeat of 4/1/18 program)

4/15/18: McMahon/Ryan Child Advocacy Center (Part 2) – Guest: Melissa Wenham and Nadia Tsai – April is child abuse awareness month. Discussed the month's events: Go Blue 4 Kids Breakfast and Step Up 4 Kids, a certified 5K race and family fun run – the details and how to get involved.
