Joliet Man Arrested For Robbery – The Morris Police Department arrested Marquadis Turner on October 1st after he allegedly robbed a woman at Chase Bank in Morris on September 30th. A 26-year-old Joliet man was arrested for his alleged role in a bank robbery. The Morris Police Department worked with the Romeoville Police Department in the case. **Air dates:** 10/1-10/2

44th Anniversary of Cold Case Homicide in Grundy County – The 44th death anniversary of Grundy County's only unidentified cold case was held on Friday, October 2nd. Grundy County Coroner John Callahan spoke with WJDK at the scene of where Jane Seneca Doe was found on October 2, 1976. **Air Dates:** 10/2 – 10/3

Grundy County Welcomes New Judge – Grundy County Circuit Judge Rob Marsaglia spoke with WJDK about his retirement and future goals on October 15th. Marsaglia's last day was December 5th. Morris Man Accused of Burglarizing Several Houses – The Morris Police Department on November 12 arrested Jeremy Goldsberry, 27, of Morris for burglarizing several homes in Morris between October 27th and November 10th. Investigators say they took ten residential burglary and several attempted residential burglary reports that occurred on the northwest side of Morris. **Air dates:** 11/12-11/13, 11/23-12/4

Operation St. Nick Cracks \$2 Million Figure – A major milestone was set during the 38th annual Operation St. Nick Radio auction on Sunday, October 6th. St. Nick President Joe Schmitz said the \$2 million milestone was reached during hour number two of the auction. He said the proceeds from the auction help the less fortunate in Grundy County. The auction has surpassed the \$100,000 mark 12 out of past 13 years including a record-breaking \$152,000 in 2018. **Air dates:** 12/7-12/8
