WSJS PROGRAMS THAT ADDRESS COMMUNITY ISSUES

WSJS is a news-talk station that airs a variety of regular programs that address issues affecting our community and our listeners. The station airs no less than eight hours a day of programs that deal with issues of politics, economy, human relations, morality, and other general topics affecting the community. Following is the weekly lineup of issues oriented programs and a brief description of each:

Regular Programming Monday - Friday

1. The WSJS Early Morning News (Monday-Friday, 5:00 a.m. - 6:00 a.m.)
Locally produced morning news and information show featuring news, traffic, weather, and lifestyle pieces. Hosted by WSJS morning news anchor, Ed Skurka.

2. The Triad's First News (Monday-Friday, 6:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.)
Locally-produced morning news and information show, focusing on local news, weather, and traffic, with interview segments throughout the show; hosted by J.R. Snider. The bulk of this daily program is news, weather, traffic and other information to help listeners get their day started. Program participants engage in conversation about the headlines of the day and accept listener reaction by way of phone calls. The hosts go in-depth with interviews and listener phone calls about issues that affect the Triad and the Triad's reaction to national and international news and events.

3. Everyday Law: (Fridays, 9:00 a.m. – 9:30 a.m.)
An hour weekly on the Triad's First News involving local attorney Joe Schmitz and calls from listeners with legal questions. Range of questions is broad and includes disputes with neighbors, speeding tickets, estate matters, disputes with businesses, etc.

4. The Clark Howard Show (Monday-Friday, 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.)
A nationally syndicated program, hosted by Clark Howard, that features all consumer-based information. There are tips on how to save money,

get the best deals, and ways to protect yourself from consumer fraud.

5. The WSJS Evening News

(Monday-Friday, 6:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.)

The WSJS Evening News is packed with a variety of information for our listeners. The highlights are 30 minute simulcast of the WXII 12 Evening News at 6 and news from the North Carolina News Network, Triad traffic, AccuWeather, sports reports, and other features like Garage Pass and the Clark Howard Minute.

6. Overnight America

(Monday-Friday, 1:00 a.m. – 5:00 a.m.)

A Nationally syndicated overnight radio program covering the current events, news, and pop culture stories of the day. Hosted by Jon Grayson.

Saturday Regular Programming

7. The Yard Sale

(Saturdays, 6:00 a.m.-8:00 a.m.)

Hosts take calls from listeners, who are allowed to list items for sale on air, and on the WSJS Website, wsjs.com.

8. Your Financial Friends

(Saturday, 8:00 a.m.-9:00 a.m.)

A locally-produced paid programming discussing personal financial wealth and investing.

9. Real Estate Radio

(Saturday, 9:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m.)

Locally-produced, paid programming discussing real estate buying and selling.

10. Maestro Wealth

(Saturday 11:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.)

A locally-produced paid programming discussing personal financial wealth and investing.
