

We've had about 70 of our team members who have been evacuated and I'm sure are just learning news about their homes. Many of you are in the same boat and our heart goes out to you. Know that we have been praying for you and we have been interceding on your behalf to our heavenly Father. I want to thank all the local radio stations for the great work that they've done, keeping us informed regarding the fires. For FOF, please know that we're here for you. If you need help or counseling, uh ... give us a call at 1-800, the letter A and the word FAMILY. We want to stand with you. I know you're going through devastation. Uh ... if it's not you, it may be a family member. My own sister was evacuated and we are standing with her. So, we know that there's a lot of pain in the community right now. If we can help, give us a call. I'm reminded of Psalm 119, verse 114: "You are my refuge and my shield; I put my hope in Your Word." We want to remember today that the Lord is our refuge. There's nothing that can separate us from his love. And *although* we're feeling perhaps alone and desperate even, please know that God is here for you. Transcription: Hi, this is Jim Daly, president of FOF. Before we go into today's program, can I take just a moment to say thank you for your prayers and concerns for FOF and for Colorado Springs. As most of you know, we have faced incredible wildfires that have taken out hundreds of homes here in our community. We have probably about 70 team members whose homes are in the evacuated area. Thank you for your prayers for them. Uh ... the things that we treasure most, family heirlooms, pictures or other belongings have been left behind in their homes or lost in the blaze. In a time of crisis, it's our nature to forget that God is in control. And uh ... we do believe that as Christians, even in the face of great adversity. Even with the evacuation of over 30,000 people, uh ... we are not aware of a single loss of life and that is a praise to Almighty God. We have stood by, ready to help the city and others in our community with our facilities and any help we can provide. Our counseling team has provided some help, as well. Some ministries that have been evacuated are now using facilities here on the Focus campus until they can regroup.
