Included is a list of program issues responded to on WLLV July, August, September 2011:

Crime – the City of Louisville now has a Citizens Review Board in place to monitor behavior of police officers as well as implementing a plan to combat crime. The Chief of Police, various City Officials and Kentucky Law Makers held discussions regarding the make up and objectives of the Board.

Housing – The city of Louisville aired PSA's and paid commercials which relates to the opportunity for a person to own their own home and the availability of new housing in our community.

Voters Rights – Several shows including Justice Resource Center and The Kentucky Legislature have expressed the importance of eligibility to vote and the need for people to get out and vote and the importance of registration so you can exercise your right to vote.

Education – Several PSA's and informational pieces about various Back to School Programs providing school supplies and assistance with uniforms and books for older students were aired.
