



JUNE 1, 2006 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2006

Attached is a listing of broadcasts or broadcast segments that, in the Station's judgment, reflect the Station's most significant programming treatment of ascertained issues during the preceding three-month period. The Station produces and airs a weekly half hour show called **AROUND OUR TOWN**, which focuses on issues affecting the community of Palm Beach County.

AROUND OUR TOWN – A half-hour weekly public affairs broadcast hosted by AnEta Sewell featuring interviews and discussions with guests from our community focusing on important issues of local concern. Broadcast dates and times as indicated in the report.

COMMUNITY ISSUES: Topics in this category included: Preparing for the 2006 Hurricane Season.

AROUND OUR TOWN : 06/01, 8 AM. Guests included Karen Vissepo and Amy Albury, both spokespersons for Florida Power & Light. Topics of discussion include the FPL Storm Secure Program. Tips for preparing before and after storms, what to do if you come across a downed power line and important contacts at FPL.

FAMILY/EDUCATION: Topics in this category included: Free resources available to families and caretakers in Palm Beach County from the Children's Services Council of Palm Beach County Parenting Center.

AROUND OUR TOWN: 06/06 & 06/08, 8 AM. Guests included Marlene Passell from the Children's Services Council of PB County and Maggie Dante of the Children's Services Council of PB County/Parenting Center. Topics of discussion include educational training services for parents and other caregivers, the services provided by the county such as support, advice, and networking with other caregivers, and how to become a Florida Parent Educators or Certified Family Life Educator.

AROUND OUR TOWN: 06/20 & 06/22, 8 AM. Guests included Marlene Passell from the Children's Services Council of PB County and Jennifer Karlson of the Children's Services Council of PB County/Mentor Center. Topics of discussion include the expansion of youth mentoring, resources for mentors and mentoring programs providing training, consultation, and networking opportunities throughout Palm Beach County.

ENVIRONMENTAL: Topics in this category included: The recreation, nature and things we see and do at the Grassy Waters Preserve in Palm Beach County.

AROUND OUR TOWN: 06/13 & 06/15, 8 AM. Guest includes Bob Nichols of the Grassy Waters Preserve. Topics of discussion include protecting the 20 square miles of the Everglades and to create a state of the art environmental educational center.

PUBLIC SAFETY: Topics in this category included: The MADD Chapter of Palm Beach County discuss drunk driving from victims and law enforcements perspectives.

AROUND OUR TOWN: 06/27 & 06/29, 8 AM. Guests include Lynnsey Eakin of MADD of Palm Beach County, Darlene Fernandez, a victim of Drunk Driving and D/S Jason Karlecke and CPL Greg Croucher of the Palm Beach Sheriff's Office. Topics of discussion include the MADD non-profit grass roots organization and MADD's mission to stop drunk driving, support for victims, prevention of underage drinking, program funding, and volunteer programs.
