The affected products were sold in Washington, DC and 28 states, and have various sell-by states between August 30 and September 15, 2024. The recall is out of an abundance of caution and is in cooperation with Schreiber Foods, Inc. Anyone who purchased the products should throw them out or return them for a refund.

Mass casualty drill to be held at the SLO County Airport this week --- 5/15/2024

The primary objective of the drill is to test and enhance the emergency response capabilities of the airport in the event of a mass casualty incident. There will be several agencies and emergency response teams participating in the drill to ensure a coordinated and effective response. Members of the public may notice an increased presence of first responders on and around the airport. This activity is related to the drill and does not indicate any actual emergency. The public may also notice smoke and fire visible during the drill.

>>CA Highway Reopening Ahead Of Schedule After Collapse

(Monterey County, CA) -- Major progress to report on the collapse of a famous California road. Highway One is reopening Friday morning, eight days sooner than expected. Governor Newsom says crews have been working day and night to repair the collapse on Easter weekend. That's when a huge chunk of road fell down a cliff and into the ocean during heavy rain, cutting off access between Carmel and Big Sur. A signal has been installed so traffic can alternate in both directions while crews start work on the next phase of repairs.
