### I Youth Development

Director Jennie Weber told us about the YWCA/YMCA "Reach and Rise Mentoring Program". Reach & Rise pairs qualified adults with area at risk youth ages 6 and 17. A Supportive, consistent mentoring relationship is developed through recreational play and paraprofessional therapeutic techniques. The mentor becomes an extra parent for the child to rely on. This interview was aired on all five Townsquare Media radio stations in Dubuque. A listing of the times and dates this interview was presented is included with this report.

Every Friday afternoon at 4:40 during the school year, (September), WDBQ-FM presents a program, approximately two minutes in length, recorded by students from Galena, IL High School. The program contains high school news, lists coming events, and mentions accomplishments by outstanding students.

### II Welfare of Animals

Every Tuesday Morning, Cumulus of Dubuque presents interviews with Jane McCall of the Dubuque Regional Humane Society. The interviews contain information about proper animal care, upcoming fundraising events, and descriptions of animals available at the Dubuque Regional Humane Society. The interviews are heard on WDBQ-FM at 8:40 am, WJOD at 8:50 am, and Y-105 at 8:40 am.

### III Service to the Developmentally Disabled

Pat O'Hay is a member of the Iowa Chariots, our own wheelchair basketball team. It's a tough sport, and fun to watch. Tom Brenner interviewed Pat O'Hay about who the Iowa Chariots play, how they play, and how they raise funds. The Iowa Chariots also teach children how to deal with their own disabilities. Townsquare Media stations of Dubuque aired the broadcast to help them raise funds for their organization, and invite other organizations who would like to take on the Iowa Chariots in a wheelchair basketball game, and raise funds themselves. A list of times the interview was broadcast is attached to this form.

### IV Alzheimer's Disease

Alex Barton is the Program and Event Coordinator of the Dubuque Alzheimer's Association. Alex told our listeners about different symptoms that could indicate that persons have Alzeimers, but do not necessarily mean that they are affected. ### V Welfare of Women and Children in the Tri States.

Maria House and Theresa Shelter gives women and children a place to stay in times of duress to escape a bad marriage or relationship. Executive Director of Opening Doors Amy Schauer gave us an insight into what services Maria House and Theresa Shelter provides. Amy Shauer also told our listeners that her organization is not a handout, but a hand up. Her clients are expected to learn how to manage their lives, raise their children, and get back into the workforce. This is the purpose of Opening Doors.

### VI Keeping Tri Staters Healthy

The Granny Basketball League accepts women, 50 years of age and older. Micki Marolf and Bed Brewer stopped by our studios to tell us about the health benefits to older women of Granny Basketball. Any woman, 50 or older is invited to join. The games are non contact, no jumping, are only intended to increase exercise for senior women. The League starts practice in October, and the season starts in January. The interview was featured on all five Townsquare Media radio stations of Dubuque and were a minute thirty in length.

Hillcrest Family Services operates over thirty programs for over twenty four thousand people in the Tri States area. They include housing, health care, and help for those who need it due to physical disabilities, poverty, or if they are victims of many other problems. One of Hillcrest's major fund raising efforts is "Reflections in the Park", a lit, drive through, Christmas display every year in Murphy Park in Dubuque. The purpose of the "Out of the Darkness" event is to help people who are considering suicide find help, and educate people about the signs of suicide. The fund raising walk took place Saturday, October 25<sup>th</sup> in Dubuque. The interview appeared on all five Townsquare Media of Dubuque, and the time it was aired appears on the attached log. Our stations also ran many public service announcements promoting the event.

Again this year, Townsquare Media with Dubuque partnered with Dupaco Community Credit Union to sponsor "Coats for Kids" In the fall, there are many needy kids that need coats and tri state residents are encourages to donated new or slightly used coats to the cause. Our stations ran several interviews and many public service announcements about the drive.

### **OTHER SERVICES**

NEWS: All Townsquare Media of Dubuque stations carry news of the American Broadcasting Company and six local newscasts each weekday. In addition, WDBQ-AM carries Iowa state news from Radio Iowa.

WEATHER: Townsquare features full access to satellite and radar transmissions of current conditions. WJOD is associated with Weathertime, a private weather service that has a much better track record than the National Weather Service, is faster with their reports, and is especially valuable to the Dubuque area's extensive agricultural community. PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS: Cumulus / Townsquare of Dubuque stations average well over 20 locally oriented public service announcements per day for various non-profit groups in the tri states.
